JESSE DUPLANTIS

When I got saved, God not only washed away all my sin, but He also gave me a new outlook on life. He opened my eyes so that I could see myself as He sees me.

Salvation made me realize that I am more than just a bunch of body parts. I'm more than just a set of passed down genes. I am a spirit being, made in the very image of God, and there is nothing that is impossible for me if I "only believe."

I believe that the Apostle Paul felt the same way—but he said it in a different way. To Paul, accepting Christ's sacrifice was like dying to himself and being reborn through Jesus Christ. He identified with Christ so much that, to him, getting saved was sort of like being crucified on the cross with Jesus and dying to all the sinful ways of his old life. He said it this way.

I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, Who loved me, and gave Himself for me.

Galatians 2:20

Paul's old ways died when he accepted Jesus' sacrifice on the cross. He said, and this is my paraphrase, 'People, you're looking at a dead man! I've been crucified with Jesus. That person you knew before is gone. I'm new. I'm different. Jesus has saved me and now, He's the One who is living through me. My life is a life of faith! My faith is in the One who loved me enough to go to the cross and die for my sins—Jesus Christ. My flesh is dead to the old ways and my spirit is alive!'

Paul decided that he didn't have to cater to the desires of his old flesh like some animal roaming through the desert. He had climbed up a notch when he accepted Jesus. Of course, Paul was encased in a body of flesh and bone just like you and me. He had a mind, a will and a set of emotions just like we do. But, Paul realized that he was more than just the sum of his physical parts. He knew that he was a spirit being first, and the flesh he inhabited wasn't supposed to rule his life.

I've decided to adopt Paul's mentality and put myself in the scripture. I like to say, "I'm a dead man too! It's not Jesse that lives anymore; it's Christ who lives through Jesse. I'm living by my faith in the Son of God, who loved me enough to die for me. I'm not going back to where I was before. I'm a new creature with a new feature—alive in Christ and dead to my old way of living."

Your Body Is Secondary, But Your Spirit Is Eternal

A friend of mine often shares that when God breathed the breath of life into us, He created what she calls, "speaking spirits." We are spirit beings made in the very image of God, with the authority and the ability to rule over our own body.

The more you realize that you are a speaking spirit, made in the image of God and able to command your flesh to get in line, the more you'll understand that you don't have to be swayed by everything your physical body wants to do.

Your body will pull you to do all sorts of stuff! But you don't have to listen to it.

It's not the "the real you" anyway. One day, your body is going to die and return to the earth from which it came, but your spirit is going to live forever. Of course, the better you take care of your body, the longer you get to live in it. But, make no mistake, when it bites the dust, your reborn spirit is going to move to Heaven where you'll live in the presence of God for eternity. Think about that.

Get a revelation of yourself as eternal. When you do, you'll start to realize that it's just not right to let your physical body govern your life. It's wonderfully made and a gift of God to you, but it's secondary to your spirit.

I meet a lot of people who think that they have to obey every inclination of their flesh, but they don't. They operate their lives according to how they feel that day. If I obeyed my feelings and listened to my mind every time it said, *Eat that cake, Jesse*. I'd be nine hundred pounds! Sure, leftover chicken legs may call me in the middle of the night, but I don't listen to them. I crucify my flesh and leave the bird's legs alone at three in the morning!

Sinching Doesn't Happen in the Spirit

Sinching doesn't happen in the spirit; it happens in the flesh. So, if you crucify your flesh daily, instead of just on Sunday, you're going to be more successful at avoiding the subtlety of sin.

There is always going to be a tug of war going on between your spirit and your flesh. Your fleshly body pulls on you to do whatever it wants to do and your spirit says, *'No, this is the best way. This is what the Lord says.'* So, you have a choice at that moment. The only time you can really sin is if you are in the flesh—if you've decided to do things your own way instead of His way.

If you wait until Sunday to fill-up on God, then you're going to be dry a lot of the time and far more vulnerable to the tug of your flesh. That's why committing your day to God first thing in the morning is a good idea. Praying every day and taking time to put some of the Word into your mind is crucial.

It will just drive you nuts if you do your own thing all week long and then suddenly get spiritual on Sunday. That flip-flopping back and forth won't give you the strength, faith or character you need to avoid sin.

Hit and miss Christianity just doesn't produce the best results. The principles of God's Word work, but in order for your faith to be effective, you have to give God more than just one day a week to help you out!

It Isn't Just Fire Insurance

When Jesus came into my life, He delivered me from Hell and a hellish life. Once I made a decision to accept Jesus as my Savior, I felt there was no other option than to let Him be the leader of my life too. Why would I want to keep on doing things the old way? They were killing me! So, I accepted that God's way worked better than my way. There was nothing in my old life that I wanted anymore.

It's always amazing to me when I hear about a Christian who turns his back on God. I wonder, *Maybe they didn't get saved the way they should have. Man, when you see the glory of God, what does the world have to offer?* It amazes me that people would turn their back on God after years of being in the faith. Why would anyone deliberately choose to go back to a lost and dying world? I mean, what in Hell do they really want?

When I got saved, I wasn't just trying to purchase "fire insurance." I needed a complete turn around because the devil was beating my brains out. Sure, the life I lived before brought me a little happiness here and there, but, overall, it was doing nothing but dragging me further and further into a pit of emptiness, misery and pressure to succeed at whatever the cost. I had no true happiness and no true peace in my mind.

If you would have asked me, "What in Hell do you want?" when I got saved, I would have hollered, "NOTHING! I got a glimpse of Hell when I was living for the devil and I don't want anymore of it!" So, when I see that someone is getting away from God and reverting to their old lifestyle, I want to shake them and ask, "What in Hell do you want? What does Hell have to offer you? Don't let the devil lie to you and steal everything you've got, because if you let him, he will do it!"

Pluck It Out, Cut It Off!

If you give the devil a little place in your life, he will keep taking a little bit more. Before you know it, you'll be headlong into sin—sick, sad and disgusted about it, but too embarrassed to let anybody know about it.

The devil works on pride and there is nothing he has to offer you that comes without a steep price tag. Sin will always cost you something, but God will always give you something. I know that in the beginning, sin doesn't seem to cost too much, but in the end, sin will always charge you more than you ever wanted to pay.

Knowing that the devil steals but actually avoiding his thievery are two different things entirely. You can know something in your mind, but if you aren't willing to let it seep into your heart and change you, then nothing is going to get better.

God created you in His image and likeness and wants to see you overcome sin and become the strong person He created you to be in Him. If you're being tempted, I want you to know right now that it isn't God's will that you give in.

Jesus was adamant about teaching us how to walk upright and avoid sin. He said, *"And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire"* (Matthew 18:9).

In other words, Jesus said, 'If you're struggling with something that is bringing you down into sin all the time, it's better for you to completely cut yourself off from it than to stay around it and fall again and again. It's better for you to cut yourself off from that sin and get into Heaven, rather than continue in that sin and burn in Hell.' (my paraphrase)

This parable isn't meaning that you should go around lopping off body parts! It's meant to show you the importance of doing everything you can to live right and avoid what makes you stumble at all costs. It's best just to pluck out the sin while you can and go about living the good life that God has destined for you to live.

Nobody is perfect and God will grant you grace and mercy at every turn, but Jesus wants you to aim at making sin a black-and-white issue—not a stumbling gray area. He wants you to develop a "what's right is right, and what's wrong is wrong" attitude when it comes to sin. The more you allow the devil to distort your view, the more gray area you'll get into and the more trouble you'll find yourself in too.

Choosing to Give It Up

The devil will usually try and get you to be compulsive or obsessive in some way. God doesn't want you to live like that—it's hellish! Any vice taking His place in your life is no good. But, thank God, *"From the Lord comes deliverance..."* (Psalm 3:8 NIV).

He'll help you, if you ask in faith, but He won't force Himself on you. If you want to resist the devil, He'll help you. You just have to make a clear-cut decision that it's what you really want. There is no need in playing games. Just ask yourself, "Why am I struggling with this? What do I really want? What does the devil have to offer me? Do I want to listen to his lies or follow the Lord Jesus instead?" Be honest with yourself. Make certain that you are serious about making a change in your life.

You don't have to worry about doing it on your own. Just admit to yourself that you need Jesus to help you resist sin, and He'll help you. He will tap your spirit as long as you ask Him to do it. He'll bring scripture back to your memory and give you the strength to say "no" when the devil comes with his devices.

It doesn't matter whether you're tempted with drugs, alcohol, pornography, adultery, gambling, food or anything else, you can overcome temptation. With God's help, you can overcome *anything* the devil throws your way. 🌐

Pray this prayer with me now:

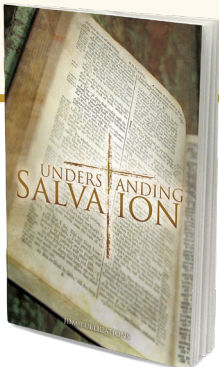

GO DO THE WORK

JOHN 14:12

JESSE DUPLANTIS

Every year I seek the Lord for the direction of this ministry, and what He spoke to me for us to focus on this entire year went off inside of me like a shotgun. It's very simple and yet so profound. What He told me is based on the words of Jesus in John 14:12, which says, "*Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on Me, **the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto My Father.***" Jesus has gone to His Father, and it's our job to pick up the mantle and go do what He said to do—"**Go Do The Work.**"

There is so much revelation in that scripture, I know I'll be preaching and talking about it till the day I meet the Lord face-to-face. What I want to emphasize to you today is that when Jesus spoke those words in John 14:12, they were prophetically spoken with you on His mind. Any person who believes *on* Jesus can take this as a personal Word from the Lord, because it is!

Notice that Jesus said, "*He that believeth on Me.*" He didn't say in me, or around me, He said "*on Me.*" So that means you need to know Him personally. Then He said, "*the works that I do shall he do also.*" He didn't say work, He said "*works.*" So, I went through the scriptures and found the works that Jesus did, and that got me shouting! But Jesus didn't stop there. He continues, "*and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto My Father.*" He's talking about me and He's talking about you doing greater works!

Think about it. The works that Jesus did were confined to a certain amount of time—and yet from the time He went to the Father until the day He comes back for us, the works that He did will continue to be done...and greater. How? Through us! Greater works are happening every day through God's children. Just think about the countless number of people that ministers like myself are able to preach to through modern technology that Jesus didn't have access to. That's a greater work, right? But you know, all the people that have come to the Lord through my broadcast, social media, internet, this magazine, and all the many outreaches we have at JDM, I didn't save even one of them. Jesus saved them all! But see, He needed someone to work through, and He's still looking for someone to work through. Will it be you?

So maybe you're thinking, "How do I do the work? I'm not a preacher." You don't have to be! Before you were even born, you were specifically chosen for such a time as this and prophetically given a divine job to do. Maybe God wants you to share the Lord with your children, to shine your light at your workplace, to get involved with a ministry or with your church. Whatever it is, He picked you specifically for a divine work, and He'll give you everything you need to get it done when you seek Him first.

It's important to realize that in order for each of us to do what God is calling us to do, we must never

let God's words just be words; they should become works in our own lives. When I speak a word from God to you, that word should be a work in my life. How can I tell you something if I don't do it myself? How can I tell you not to sin if I've allowed sin a place in *my* life? I can't and I won't. I stay focused on the work and I stay busy. Because you see, if we get this Gospel preached, just maybe next Sunday we'll be having church together in Heaven in the presence of the Lord!

Doing the work matters because it is what will usher in Jesus' return. When the Gospel is preached to all the world "*as a witness*," then and only then the end shall come (Matthew 24:14). So the work matters, and it's time for all of us to realize it and get to work! This truly is the most exciting time for the Body of Christ, and I personally believe that we can be the generation that sees Christ coming in the clouds. Glory!

But clearly the end is not yet—because as we just read, the end of this age can't come until the Gospel is preached to all the world for a witness. Listen, Jesus didn't say they all have to accept it, but it has to be preached; it has to be taught. So we don't have time to get tired, depressed, or despondent. We don't have time to be offended with people or worry if we will offend them. Remember, you and I have got a job to do, so we must do our part and let our light shine!

The Lord had me realize that in order to do the work, we must have an outbreak of personal energy. I'll be 73 years old this year, and I feel the same as I did when I was 26 years old. I feel exactly the same! That's what an outbreak of personal energy does. You can have that, too. How? It's called fellowship. I spend quality time with the Lord every day, studying His Word and just talking with Him. That's how you will have the faith, strength, and joy to do whatever He's calling you to do.


I've been preaching the Gospel since 1976, and I don't plan on ever retiring. But this mandate to "Go Do the Work" is not just for evangelists like me. God gave me this word for all Christians. He's calling all of us to be a part of the greatest work that will speed up the time and usher in Jesus' return sooner. That means each and every one of us letting the work of God come out of our lives, and letting our lights shine in the dark places.

So the question is, are you willing to go to work? Are you ready to do the work God's assigned you to do? It's about using your faith and belief in Jesus. You

see, faith is something we keep. It's something we use every day—not just some days or on Sundays, but every day. When you keep the faith, as the Bible says, the work will flow—always letting your light shine somewhere and somehow to do the work.

Sometimes when a waiter or waitress comes up to me to take my order, when they walk away I ask the Lord, "Did they see You in me? Did I let Your light shine through me?" I do my best to focus on being a reflection of Christ everywhere I go instead of casting a reflection upon Him. You see, faith is something we keep and use all the time, but not just to get "stuff." Sure, you can use faith to believe for the desires of your heart, but it's so much more than that.

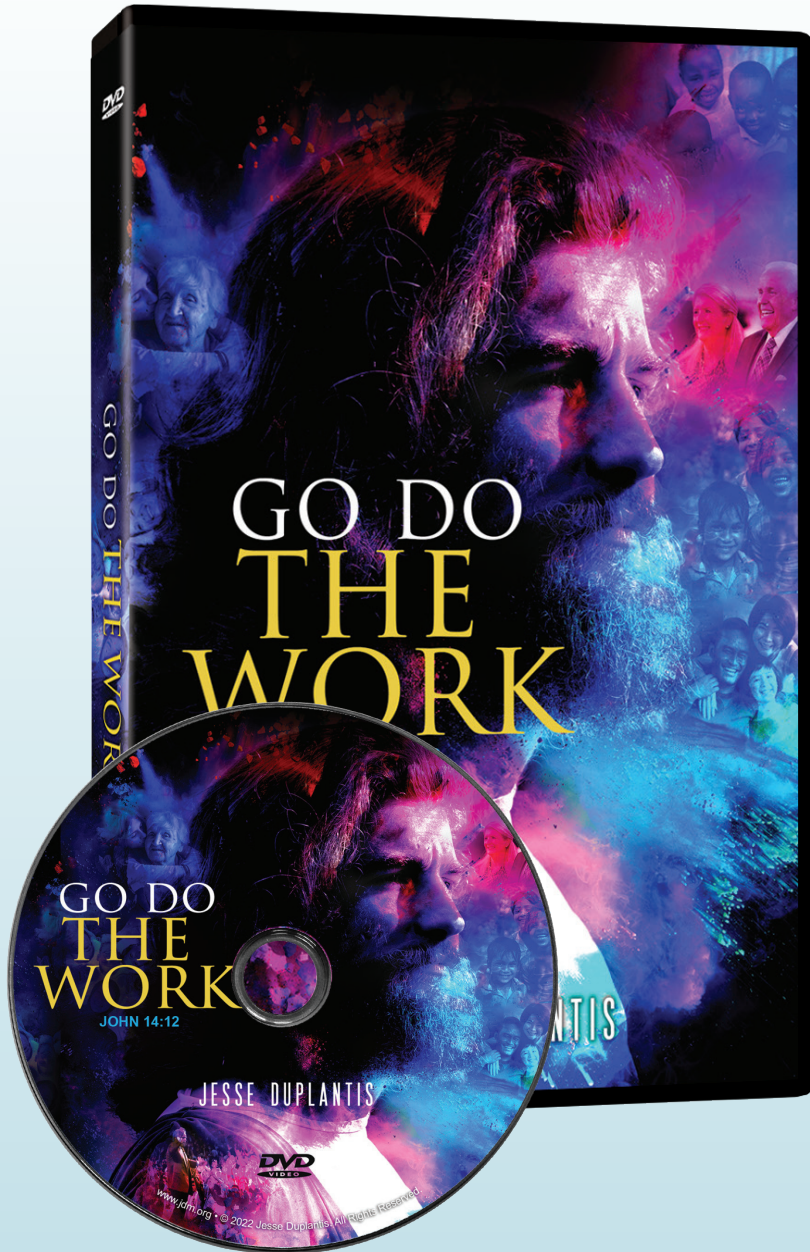
So why did Jesus say, "*He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto My Father*"? Because God wanted it said. Jesus only said what God wanted and only did what God wanted. And so that means that God's plan depends on the works of Christ being continued, and you are a part of that great plan. God has given *you* the ability from Jesus to produce a new heavenly power in this life and throughout eternity. Are you ready to use it? The greatest job God has given us is the Great Commission—it's the cornerstone of God's plan for mankind. Remember, the light and love of God in you will produce the greatest things and produce the most powerful effects for the cause of Christ. If each of us will answer God's call to do our part, we can speed up the time. It is you and I who bring life-giving life—we bring salt, we bring light, we bring Jesus! Let's do exactly what Jesus said we could do—let's "Go Do the Work!"

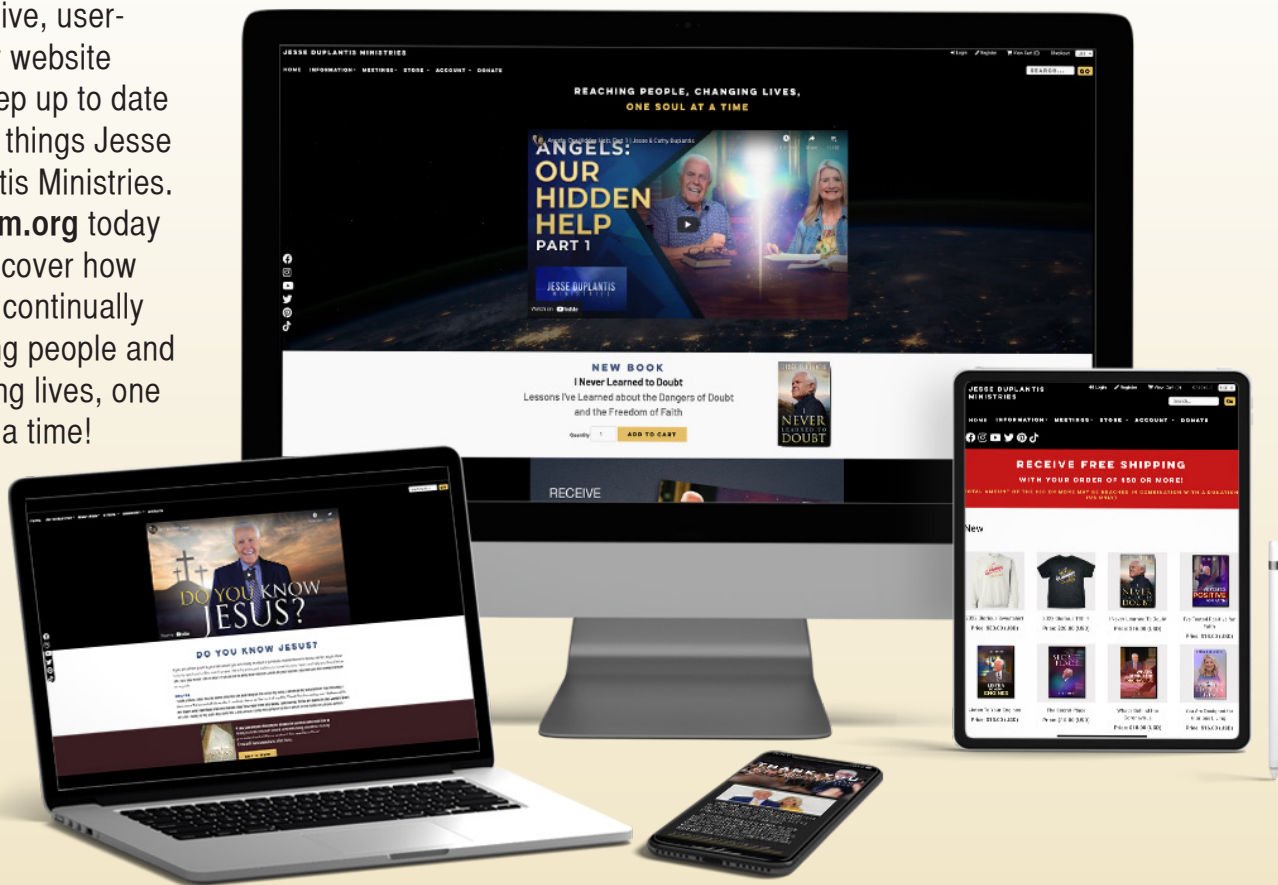

Get Stirred UP!

When we learn to keep God first and focus on seeing His plan completed, our lives will be enriched and fulfilled. However, the opposite is also true. If we put ourselves first and ignore God's plan, the result will be a life of frustration and lack. One of the best examples of this principle can be found in the book of Haggai.

A Wake-up Call

Haggai was a prophet of God who lived in a day when the nation of Israel had completely given up on God's dream of rebuilding the temple. At one time, they had really worked diligently on His project. It was after they'd just returned from captivity in Babylon when they were still so grateful for His hand on their lives. But, as time went on, they lost their resolve and gave up on the project. In other words, they got weary in well-doing. Haggai was

God's "alarm clock" to awaken His people.

Haggai 1:5-7 says, *"Now therefore thus saith the Lord of hosts; Consider your ways. Ye have sown much, and bring in little; ye eat, but ye have not enough; ye drink, but ye are not filled with drink; ye clothe you, but there is none warm; and he that earneth wages earneth wages to put it into a bag with holes. Thus saith the Lord of hosts; Consider your ways."*

This was a wake-up call, and it hit those people straight between the eyes. The message painted the perfect picture of their lives—everything was falling apart and they never had enough to make ends meet. It was time to consider their ways.

Suddenly, they realized their disobedience to God's plan had completely cancelled out His blessing on their lives. They'd spent all of their time, money, and energy on themselves and their own desires without thinking about God at all. They

had neglected God's house in favor of their own, and everyone in town knew that it was high time to wake up.

The Bible says that the entire nation “. . . obeyed the voice of the Lord their God, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the Lord their God had sent him, and the people did fear before the Lord. Then spake Haggai the Lord's messenger in the Lord's message unto the people, saying, *I am with you, saith the Lord. And the Lord stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people; and they came and did work in the house of the Lord of hosts, their God*” (Haggai 1:12-14).

The word *stir* means “to awake, open your eyes, raise up,” and that is exactly what happened that day. The Lord stirred up the spirit of everyone, from the Governor on down, and they worked together to complete God's assignment for their nation.

1. Obedience Is the Foundation for Every Dream

The foundation for receiving anything from God is always obedience. It is the foundation of every dream that has ever been fulfilled. Once you commit to do what God tells you to do, He will be with you every step of the way, stirring up your spirit and equipping you to fulfill His plan.

When you willingly serve the Lord with all of your heart, Deuteronomy 28:8 says, “*The Lord shall command the blessing upon thee in thy storehouses, and in all that thou settest thine hand unto; and He shall bless thee in the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.*”

Abundance is promised to the obedient in Isaiah 1:19 (NKJV): “*If you are willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land.*” And Job 36:11 makes the very same promise when it says, “*If they obey and serve Him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures.*”

Jesse and I are no longer surprised when God gives JDM impossible projects. In fact, we have learned to stop reminding God about our bank balance or our ability when hearing instructions from Him. We know that our resources or skills—or lack

of them—have never affected God's will for our life and ministry. And we know that multi-million dollar assignments are no problem for a God Who owns the cattle on a thousand hills and all the silver and gold in the world (Psalm 50:10; Haggai 2:8). All He asks for is our obedience and our faith.

As project after project have been supernaturally completed, Jesse and I have learned the importance of staying stirred up for God through an entire project. Everyone knows that it is easy to be stirred up at the beginning or the end of a project, however, the challenge comes when the project is in full swing and all the forces of hell are coming against it! That's when it is vitally important to stay stirred up and obedient to the vision.

Do you want to accomplish great things for God? Then get determined to do what God tells you to do. Commit to be obedient and stay stirred up through the entire process. It's the only way to remain focused and accomplish all those “impossible” projects with excellence.

2. Remember His Promise—He Will Be with You Always

In Haggai 2:4-5, the nation of Israel was promised: “. . . *I am with you, saith the Lord of hosts: According to the word that I covenanted with you when*

ye came out of Egypt, so My Spirit remaineth among you: fear ye not."

God's covenant promise to the obedient is always the same: "*I am with you.*" This promise continued into the New Testament. When Jesus commissioned His disciples to spread the Gospel, He promised them that they wouldn't do it alone. He said, "*... I am with you always, even unto the end of the world*" (Matthew 28:20). They knew that regardless of the opposition, they could depend on His promise to always be with them to empower them for their assignment.

Jesus wants all of us to know that He will always be with us, too. As His obedient disciples, we will never be expected to do any of His work alone or by ourselves—Jesus is with us!

When we choose to believe and hold onto that powerful covenant promise, it will bring a fresh boldness into our lives. Even when obstacles arise, you can confidently proclaim, "Greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world, and I'm more than a conqueror through Christ."

Everything that you want to do in your life is possible with God. So, be determined to stay stirred up and rely confidently on the promise that the Lord is always with you.

3. Renew Your Passion— Be Strong & Work

When God created mankind, He gave them work to do. Adam and Eve didn't sit around all day staring at butterflies and peacocks. They went into the landscaping business—the first and oldest job in the world. God placed them in a beautiful garden and told them to "*dress it and to keep it*" (Genesis 2:15).

God always has work for His children to do. In Haggai's day, God saw that His people had stopped working towards their corporate goal of completing the temple. Instead of coming together and doing what was right for God and for their community, they went in different directions and were busy attending to their own lives.

Once God spoke to them through the prophet Haggai and told them to consider their ways, the people immediately realized their error and God was

able to stir them up and renew their passion for the work. Immediately, they got focused! They started working together to get God's temple done. The Bible says that everyone "*came and did work in the house of the Lord of hosts, their God*" (Haggai 1:14).

Not long after, the Bible tells us that God commanded both the leaders of the community and all the people to be strong and work. Haggai 2:4 says, "*Yet now be strong, O Zerubbabel, saith the Lord; and be strong, O Joshua, son of Josedech, the high priest; and be strong, all ye people of the land, saith the Lord, and work . . .*"

Notice that God did not ask them if they *felt* strong enough to work. His command was to *be* strong. I believe that there was an actual creative force that empowered them with supernatural strength to do what God called them to do. The same is true for us today. I believe that God will empower us to do everything that He calls us to do.

Another example of this is the entire nation of underfed and overworked Israelites that came out of 400 years of slavery in Egypt. Forget about Hollywood's recreation of Exodus with blind, crippled, and half-dead people being carried out on stretchers. No, every one of them walked out strong, healed, blessed, and ready to serve the Lord! Psalm 105:37 says, "*He brought them forth also with silver*

and gold: and there was not one feeble person among their tribes.”

Remember, these were the same people that were stirred up to build a tabernacle in the wilderness in Exodus 35:21: *“And they came, every one whose heart stirred him up, and every one whom his spirit made willing, and they brought the Lord’s offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all His service, and for the holy garments.”*

In this instance, the Bible tells us that all of the people worked together on God’s tabernacle project in some way. Read Exodus 36:1-7 and you’ll see that they gave their best offerings, ideas, and handiwork toward His work. I believe that these “heart-stirrings” by God on His people will always give us the divine ability to finish the assignments He has given us—and finish them with excellence.

In the case of the tabernacle in the wilderness after the exodus from Egypt, not only did God supply the cost for all the materials, but He also imparted *wisdom* and *understanding* to every one of the laborers so that they would get the job done exactly as He had commanded. After it was all said and done, Exodus 39:43 tells us that *“Moses did look upon all the work, and, behold, they had done it as the Lord had commanded, even so had they done it: and Moses blessed them.”*

4. Fear Not

To accomplish anything for God, you have to put a stop to fear. The devil will try to sidetrack you with fear, worry, and anxiety. Don’t let him.

God encouraged the children of Israel to avoid fear when He said, *“According to the word that I covenanted with you when ye came out of Egypt, so My Spirit remaineth among you: fear ye not”* (Haggai 2:5). In Haggai’s time, the children of Israel had come out of the bondage of Babylon. So when they heard the words *“fear ye not,”* they knew that God was reminding them about their ancestors—those who had been led by Moses out of Egyptian bondage.

They all knew what God had done in the past, and they all knew the famous words of Deuteronomy 31:6: *“Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the Lord thy God, He it is that doth go with thee; He will not fail thee,*

nor forsake thee.” They recognized that God was using the same terminology He used with Moses’ generation, and this gave them a jolt of confidence and faith. They knew that the same God that was with Moses and Joshua was also with them.

You see, God knows the fear tactics of the devil and so, in this case, God exposed the fear before it got a chance to poke its head up. Suddenly, the children of Israel knew that *now* was the time for them to obey God and get to work on their temple project—and to not let fear get in their way, especially when it came to the cost of the project. God let them know that, *“The silver is Mine, and the gold is Mine, saith the Lord of hosts”* (Haggai 2:8).

If you want to accomplish great things for God, you’re going to have to realize that the devil really doesn’t have any new tricks. The same tactics that he used on the children of Israel in Moses’ generation are the same tactics that he used on Haggai’s generation, and also on the disciples of Jesus Christ. He’ll try to stop you from doing what God has called you to do, too. Don’t let him!

It’s Your Time


This is your time to accomplish great things for the Lord. Today, you can do some of the same things that the nation of Israel and the disciples of Jesus did and see amazing results.

Remind yourself that God’s Spirit is in you and that 2 Timothy 1:7 says, *“For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.”* You have what it takes to get the job done. The “impossible” projects that God calls you to do are always possible with Him.

I want to encourage you to believe in God and in yourself. Determine in your heart that *this* is your time to live your glorious life. You have *strength*. You have *provision*. You have *peace*—nothing missing, nothing broken. This is your time to accomplish what God has laid on your heart. You *can* do it! 🌍


