GOD Speaks Through SCRIPTURE

JESSE DUPLANTIS

Have you ever listened to the radio and heard that static as you dial between the stations? A lot of believers are trying to hear God's voice, but there's so much static going on in their minds that they can't hear a thing. That static comes from not being in tune with the Holy Spirit of God within you.

Some people say, "God never talks to me." I say, "He wrote an entire book to you. Read it!"

How do you get in tune and get rid of the static so you can hear God's voice? One way is to meditate on what God has already spoken in His Word. I believe the most important way God speaks to His people is through the Holy Scripture. His book is His Word to you. As you read, God can reveal Himself to your mind.

How many times have you read a familiar Scripture and all of a sudden, one day, it just leaps off the page? Or you may hear someone quote a Scripture and, although you've heard it many times before, suddenly, it makes sense to you. It makes you think, *Whew! Glory to God!* Something clicks and you have an understanding of what God was saying like you never had before. That is one of the ways God speaks to His people.

That's why He believes that all of us should be reading His Word, even devouring His Word, on a regular basis. It's a way for Him to talk to you! It's a way for Him to talk to me. As we read the Word, God will reveal certain passages to our mind that way. Some people call that getting a revelation, and it simply means that God spoke to your mind by way of a certain passage of Scripture.

There have been so many times I have had this happen to me. I may have read the same verse

fourteen thousand times it seems like, and then all of a sudden, one day I read it and *bam*! It's like I just heard it with my ears for the first time!

God's speaking! I'm listening and suddenly I understand. *Whew!* It makes me want to grab a pulpit and kick! I say, "Man! God, that is what You were saying all that time! I get it!"

I love the Word of God. I thank God that I was educated enough to read. Being able to read is a phenomenal blessing I never take for granted. It's a beautiful way God uses to talk to me.

Flying and Reading

God has blessed me with a jet that I use to travel around the nation. It's sort of like my church building, a tool to reach my congregation—except my congregation is spread all over the world! That's the call of the evangelist, and I'm so blessed to have that plane because it helps me do more than I ever did when I had to use the airline's schedules.

Before I had this plane, I flew for fifteen years on the commercial airlines. I flew so much that I had enough Frequent Flyer miles to bring my staff to Hawaii for free. Now, that's a lot of miles! The pastor of the church on Maui found us great condos at a really low cost, and we ended up going to Hawaii for the cost of driving to Biloxi, Mississippi. And we're based out of New Orleans, Louisiana! So that is only an hour and a half up the road! I flew *that* much. I had *that* many miles. I practically lived on a plane.

After so many years, I had a routine that I regularly followed. After I boarded the plane and put my bag in the overhead bin, I'd either grab a magazine or the *USA Today* from the plane's selection of reading materials. Once in a while, I'd get out my Bible and start reading.

Now, when I read the Bible, I don't just try and get in as many chapters as I can. I hear some people brag, "I read five chapters from the Bible every day." I think, Well, whoop-tee-doo! So what! How many do you remember? How many do you really understand? How much is God talking to you?

What is the purpose of a person whizzing through reading the Bible? Is it just so they can say, "I've read that book from cover to cover"? Great! But remember that it's what you understand that matters. It's what you apply that is going to make a difference in your life.

There were many times when I was on a plane that I'd read my Bible and the pages wouldn't turn very often. I'd read a story or a teaching, and then I'd just think about it for a while. I'd read it again and again.

"God Just Created Earth!"

Once I was sitting in the window seat, and there was a man sitting in the middle seat. I picked up my Bible, and I turned to the book of Genesis because that is my favorite Old Testament book. My favorite New Testament book is the book of Ephesians. I love Ephesians because it encourages me and tells me who I am in Christ. Man, I see myself all over that book!

So on the plane that day, I opened to the first page of the first book and started reading to myself,

"In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

"And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

"And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.

"And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness.

"And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.

"And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.

"And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so.

"And God called the firmament heaven. And the evening and the morning were the second day.

"And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry land appear: and it was so.

"And God called the dry land Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called He Seas: and God saw that it was good."

Genesis 1:1-10

I read that and remembered my study of the original Hebrew text of that passage. The interpreters

of the English Bible wrote that God said, "Let there be light," but the original Hebrew is more accurately translated to a simple, "Light be!"

Now, that wasn't the creation of the sun. That came later. Original light was God releasing Himself into nothing. And out of nothing, He would hang something called the earth. So it's God Who is light. First John 1:5 says, "*This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.*" I remembered that in Him there is no darkness, "...no variableness, neither shadow of turning" (James 1:17).

I thought, God releases Himself into nothing, and out of Him, everything I see, touch, smell and eat begins to come into being. But first He has to release Himself because He is the Creator.

I was sitting in my window seat contemplating that. Now, I can't even count how many times I've read this passage, but I decided to read it again. Suddenly the passage leaped off the page at me, and God began to talk to my mind about His creative power and how the Holy Spirit moved over the deep, doing exactly what God said to do.

The Hebrew text really translates "fluttered." So He was fluttering there over the deep, and when God spoke, He moved and things got done! This was hitting me as so amazing that I turned to the man next to me, looked at him and said, "Wow. Glory."

He just looked up at me.

"What is the matter?"

I couldn't contain myself. I said, "God just created the earth, look!" I pointed to my Bible.

Now, I didn't mean to say that it had just happened, but it came out that way. God was speaking to me through the Scripture, but it didn't come out of my mouth the way it was going into my mind.

Amazed, I said, "It wasn't evolution."

He replied, "Wow, man, you're really into this."

"No," I insisted. "It's into me."

"You seem excited."

"Yes, I am. I am possessed with it!"

He looked at me like I was a freak and said, "Whoa."

"Mister," I said, "I am possessed with a Holy Spirit. It's in me!"

He just froze and looked at me. You see, I had gotten a revelation on a passage I'd read more times

than I could count. Suddenly I knew that the same Holy Spirit that lived inside of me because of my salvation was the very same Holy Spirit that fluttered over the deep, acting on behalf of God the Father. The same creative force dwelled in me. It just leaped off the page at me, and I couldn't contain myself.

Fluttering over Mankind

Suddenly, more understanding started to come, and I knew that was how salvation happened too. Before a person gets saved, their life is void. The Holy Spirit is on the outside of them, fluttering over them, waiting for the command to enter and re-create "a new creature in Christ Jesus." It was a revelation of how the Holy Spirit brings light into the life of a new believer.

I understood how salvation would look in the natural and in the spirit realm. In my mind's eye, I saw the Holy Spirit fluttering on top of a man's head, waiting for Jehovah to, in essence, say, *"Light be."* In the natural, the man is reaching out to God, believing in his heart and confessing with his mouth that Jesus is Lord. He's doing it by faith because he sees nothing and he may feel nothing.

But in the spirit realm, the instant he releases his faith, it all starts happening instantaneously: the blood of Jesus comes gushing in, washing away the man's sin; the Father is watching and accepts the sacrifice Jesus made on behalf of the man. He watches as the man becomes a clean vessel. He signals to the Holy Spirit, Who moves from fluttering to inhabiting and *bam*! The Holy Spirit flows from his head to his feet, re-creating the man with His very presence. He is filled with light on the inside, instantly becoming linked to God as family and is a brand new, born-again son of God. Glory!

I believe with my heart that God uses His Scripture to communicate with His children, and that this day, He illuminated the creation Scriptures in order to communicate with me and let me know the magnitude of His regenerative power. And it began with simply reading an old, familiar passage of Scripture.

If you've got a family member that is spiritually lost, I want to share something with you that my mama always said to me when I was unsaved and as lost as a goose in the fog. "Jesse," she'd say, "it's just your tough luck you're related to me, boy! You're

getting saved whether you like it or not! I've got the promise of my family down to a thousand generations!" Mama was serious about my salvation, and she was a quick-tempered woman who didn't mince words.

But she had a point. The Bible tells us that God is a faithful Father who keeps His covenant down to a thousand generations of your family! "Know therefore that the LORD thy God, He is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love Him and keep His commandments to a thousand generations" (Deuteronomy 7:9).

All you have to do is accept that and say, "God, I know You said that all Your promises are yeah and amen, which means yes and so be it!" Then pray for God to surround them with people who know God. Pray that God sends them someone they can personally relate to who will show them the love of Jesus without being threatening.

In your heart, you know that the Holy Spirit is the One Who does the work. As you pray, the Holy Spirit is fluttering around that lost one, waiting for them to call on the name of Jesus so He can get His command from God to move in!

Christian Meditation

Have you ever heard of meditating? Other religions do it all the time. To get some clarity they might chant something in another language or use some words that don't mean much but give them something to concentrate on while they're sitting there on the floor being quiet and breathing. It's a lot of huffing, puffing, and relaxing to calm the mind and body.

That's not the kind of meditating I'm talking about.

Christian mediation doesn't concentrate on the physical body as much and isn't about deep breathing and repeating some mantra to relax. The focus is on the actual words, and those words are God's Words. The Bible says that God's Word is a living thing.

It's active.

It's powerful.

And it has the power to change circumstances.

Christian meditation will calm your mind and emotions down. Your body will naturally respond to it, but its focus is on renewing your mind to what God's Word says. It's about focusing your mind, will, and emotions on the living, active, and powerful Scriptures. And you can do it anywhere or anyway you want.

I meditate on the Word while I'm jogging. Sometimes I just talk to God but a lot of times I'll run over a certain Scripture or series of Scriptures in my mind while I'm exercising. The exercise cleans out my body; the meditation clears my head and feeds my spirit with truth.

Setting aside a portion of time in the day just to pray and meditate on God's Word is a good thing to do. But if you don't have a portion of time to set aside for this, just start wherever you are. If all you have time for is meditating on a few Scriptures during your morning commute, do it. If you can pray and meditate on a Scripture while you're cutting your grass, washing your dishes, doing your laundry, or sitting in traffic, do it then. Thinking about God's Word will help you to clear out the mental and emotional static so you can hear God's voice more clearly.

Chewing, Swallowing, and Digesting

God made us, so He knows what's best for us. That's why He gave us a Bible. The Bible has practical messages to help you out in life. Some people think that they're mature Christians because they've been in church for so many years. But maturity comes by how much of the Word you receive and apply in your life—not just by how much you hear or read. There are a lot of people who've heard Bible teachings for forty years and are still babies when it comes to the things of God. They don't ever let it digest and become a part of their daily living.

Sunday sermons are like food that they put in their mouth, chew a little bit, and then spit out once they hit the door. They never swallow it. Others may swallow it and then throw it up after a few days! Those are some bulimic Christian babies! They never give the Word a chance to digest before they're sticking their fingers down their throat, vomiting up what they heard. Consequently, their lives never really change.

That's why some religious people seem to know so much about the Bible, but they are lost and confused when it comes to really knowing God. The Pharisees you read about in the Bible were like that—a bunch of religious, pious, hard-hearted know-it-alls! Jesus called them "snakes, hypocrites, and vipers" because while they were dogmatically religious, they'd completely lost the spirit of the message. Maybe they never had it! Either way, they weren't digesting much from God! They were just swallowing religious rules and throwing up the heart of God's message.

Getting a Healthy Soul

It just isn't healthy to vomit. It doesn't do your soul a bit of good. The best thing is to hear the Word, chew on it, swallow it, and let it get down on the inside of you so that you can do it! Every Christian really does want to do the right thing. They just get confused within themselves. When their untrained mind takes over, they spit up whatever Word doesn't fit their mind's criteria. This isn't healthy.

First, it's important to know that the "real you" is the combination of your spirit and soul. The Bible says nothing can separate this but the living Word of God. The real you is encased in a flesh body. Salvation happens when your soul (which is your mind, will, and emotions) decides to accept Jesus as your Redeemer. Then God's Holy Spirit moves in and re-births your spirit so that you can hear God's voice.

The spirit part of you has no problem with the things of God. It's your soulish part (mind, will, and emotions) that you're re-training when you read the Bible. Your mind, will, and emotions are what you use to make decisions in everyday life. Your potential in life is so great, but if your mind is messed up, you aren't going anywhere! Nothing works out when your decisions in life are guided by a messed up mind, will, and an out-of-whack emotional state. The teachings of Jesus help you straighten out your mind, will, and emotions so you can live how God wants you to—in peace, joy, and love.

Jesus' teachings are right there, ready to help you out in life. So eat that Word! Swallow it down, even if it doesn't taste so good sometimes! And as you eat it, swallow it, and digest it, you'll see that it's a better life. Listen, I understand that it's not easy. People think that easy and better mean the same thing. They don't. Sometimes what's easy isn't what's best. Sometimes it's harder to do what's best.

I know some of those Scriptures are hard to hear. Take for instance the Scripture in Matthew 5:44, "But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you."

Let's just face it. Sometimes you might just want to knock the fire out of somebody! It's hard to bless somebody who is cussing you out. It's hard to do good to those that hate you! And when they are acting like idiots, well, who really wants to pray for them? But you're the better person for it, even if it's tough. It is like a bad tasting vegetable. It stinks and it doesn't taste good, but it's the best one for your body.

Don't ask me why that's the way it is, it just is. Like food is nutritious to your body, the teachings of the Bible are nutritious to the soul. Your mind, will, and emotions become a whole lot healthier when you've been applying what you read in the Bible. Plus, you start hearing God's voice a lot easier too.

LIVING by the WORD

CATHY DUPLANTIS

I have grown up hearing the yearly "hurricane survival" guidelines. Although I don't know when the drill became second nature to me, I can spout off the emergency checklist at the drop of a hat. If the weather center issues a warning for the New Orleans area, I don't have to hunt through my kitchen junk drawer for the "what to do in case of a hurricane" brochure they gave me at Popeye's Fried Chicken. I know exactly what to do and can spring into action at a moment's notice.

For instance, I know I'll need batteries for the radio and flashlights, just in case the electricity goes out, and I'll need to fill the bathtubs with water so that we can flush the toilets in case the water is cut off. I'll also need a hurricane tracking map, candles, matches, and plenty of non-perishable food and drinking water. And, because hurricane-force winds can turn garbage cans and lawn chairs into flying torpedoes, I know that everything that is not nailed down outside will have to be brought inside and all of the windows will be taped or boarded up.

I also know that I'll have to put gas in the cars and have cash in my purse, should evacuation become

necessary. Jesse and I don't have a problem with leaving town. We figure that Joseph was warned in a dream to evacuate his family to Egypt after the birth of Jesus, so if the Holy Spirit says we need to leave our town, we leave. But long before that, Jesse and I establish our personal plan of action—spiritually *and* practically. We pray against the storms, but we also keep ourselves prepared to do whatever needs to be done.

Prepare Yourself in the Word

This same practical wisdom can be applied to overcome *any* attack of the devil. You should be establishing your victory plan by searching God's Word for promises *before* the storms of life. God's Word is filled with promises concerning healing, protection, and favor. It's filled with words of wisdom that will lead you to peace, prosperity, and anything else you need in life.

To prepare yourself spiritually, you must feed on the Word and hide it in your heart. Let it go into your ears and come out of your mouth until God's unchangeable, unbreakable, and undefeatable Word becomes second nature to you. The Bible tells us that we should "watch and pray" – which means we are to be in a state of readiness. Prepare yourself in advance. Watch and pray so that you can readily detect the "warning signals" and spring into action when the devil tries to throw a storm your way. No matter what circumstance or situation the devil can brew for your defeat, remember that God has given you the Word and His power to overcome every attack of the enemy. He's also given you instructions to *speak* your testimony.

Revelation 12:11 says, "And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death."

The word of your testimony should be something like this: "I thank You, God, that Psalm 91:10 promises me that no evil shall befall **me**, neither shall any plague come nigh **my** dwelling." Put yourself in the Word and boldly declare scriptures. Recite Isaiah 53:4-5 and put yourself in there! Say, "Surely He hath borne **my** griefs, and carried **my** sorrows...He was wounded for **my** transgressions, He was bruised for **my** iniquities: the chastisement of **my** peace was upon Him; and with His stripes I am healed!" If you want to replace the "my" with your own name, do it!

But don't stop there. Remember that the Bible is full of promises and examples of God's willingness and power to heal and help all that will obediently follow Him. Psalm 103:3 reveals a God *"who healeth all thy diseases,"* and Exodus 15:26 declares, *"I am the LORD that healeth thee."* Dig in and get what you need.

I love the words of Peter's testimony in Acts 10:38 because he wanted the world to know, "*How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: Who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with Him.*" This was Peter's sermon everywhere that he went. And, faith in the fact that Jesus is *still* anointed, *still* going about doing good, and *still* healing all that are oppressed of the devil is what healed that paralyzed man at the gate called "Beautiful." Acts 3:6 says, "*Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.*"

There's something wonderfully peaceful about establishing a victory plan based on the Word of God. Stormy times may come, but Jesus told us that we should be of good cheer—courageous and optimistic —in times of tribulation because He has *overcome* the world (John 16:33). Think of something that is in the world right now that is causing you to tribulate. Jesus has already overcome it! And because He overcame it, you can too. Remember that Jesus went to the cross—died and rose again—so that you could inherit salvation, healing, peace, prosperity, and the power to overcome *any* attack of the enemy.

I like to say it this way, "Don't give up, Cheer UP!" Realize your position as a blood-bought child of God and, by faith, release the *force* of joy—it is the strength of God for you. Make a decision to be of good cheer and rejoice to know that Jesus Christ has given you power!

The Word Is Your Map

When Jesse and I took road trips on our motorcycle, I was always in charge of the map. I loved that job because I could tell Jesse where to go and he *had* to listen—and that's not something that happens every day.

Interstate Highways are easy to figure out. When we drove through little mountain towns with winding roads, it would get a little hairy. It was my responsibility to study the map and pay attention to the road signs so that I wouldn't send us on a wild goose chase. Of course, the few times that we were lost, it was officially my fault. Even if the map *was* wrong, it took a lot of explaining before Jesse would trust my navigational skills without repeatedly saying, "Are you *sure* about this one, Cathy? Are you *positive*? I haven't forgotten the last time you led me astray!" I studied every detail of the map the entire trip so that I could be *a workman that needeth not to be ashamed*, *rightly dividing* the map of the USA!

The Word of God is your map for success and victory in this life—trust in it and apply it, and it will *never* lead you astray. If you invest time in studying God's Word, you will know *what* is available to you as a blood-bought child of God. In Hosea 4:6, God says, *"My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge."* The Word gives you the spiritual knowledge you need. 2 Timothy 2:15 tells us that we should "*Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.*"

The devil practices *wrongfully* dividing the word of truth, which is why you need to be keen about the Word. Remember when that rat came to Jesus in the wilderness to tempt Him? Three different times the

devil twisted the Word in an effort to trap Jesus into doing what he wanted. And three different times Jesus quoted the Word and defeated the devil at his own game. Jesus knew how to rightly divide the Word of Truth and could spot deception a mile away.

Luke 4:4 tells us, "And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God." You see, Jesus had established His victory plan in advance and it was based solely on God's Word. Jesus was victorious over every temptation of the devil because He rightly divided the Word of Truth. The devil was so confused and frazzled by the Word being rightly divided that he had to take several months off to regroup! Luke 4:13 says that he left "for a season." That rat was worn out!

The Word Is a Lamp

The best guidance comes from the Word. Psalm 119:105 says, "*Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.*" Putting the Word first place in your life turns on the lamp so you don't have to stumble around in the dark places of life. God has a path for you that will transform a dead, meaningless existence into a life filled with joy, peace, and purpose.

Of course, I would like it if God revealed His path all at one time, sort of like the way the airport lights up a runway to guide the airplane to a safe landing. But, instead, I've found that God usually lights my path only one bulb at a time. Then, I walk in faith as, light by light, the next one appears. Eventually, I discover that His way was never hidden in darkness *from* me, it was hidden *for* me, ready to be revealed at the perfect moment in time as I applied my faith in Him. *"But the path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day"* (Proverbs 4:18).

When Jesse and I knew that God was calling us to full-time ministry, we carefully considered the cost. We had heard about some ministers who had loaded themselves down with debt and were swallowed up before they could fulfill the call of God on their lives. We recognized that they had made the wrong choices, and we were determined to not make the same mistakes.

Every choice had to be led by the Spirit of God and not by the dictates of our flesh. This was not a baby step, it was gigantic. We couldn't afford to take advice from people in the boat. We were walking on water and only the voice of God would do. Only God knew the path that we had to take to complete the calling on our lives.

Some people thought we were crazy. We heard things like, "What will you live on?" and "Where will you go?" Many people couldn't believe that Jesse would walk away from a great job to travel around the country preaching the Gospel. Although we didn't really know where we were going, we knew Who was leading and, like many that came before us, we chose to answer the call of God by faith.

Hebrews 11:8-10 (NASB1995) says, "By faith Abraham, when he was called, obeyed by going out to a place which he was to receive for an inheritance; and he went out, not knowing where he was going. By faith he lived as an alien in the land of promise, as in a foreign land, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, fellow heirs of the same promise; for he was looking for the city which has foundations, whose architect and builder is God."

Although Abraham didn't know where he was going, he knew that God was leading him. His eyes were focused on the promise and he did not allow obstacles and difficulties to stop the plan of God for his life. There was no going back. He had made the right choice and was committed to walking in it.

Although you may not have a blueprint or a table of contents, you can know that God is directing your path. When you don't know what to do, you can stand on Proverbs 16:9 (NASB1995): *"The mind of man* plans his way, but the Lord directs his steps." When you make the choice to live by the Word, the Holy Spirit will light your path. He will guide you every step of the way. Even if you have missed a few steps and gotten off track into a cloudy or dark place, Jesus is always ready to forgive you and shine a fresh light for you...to put you on the perfect path for your life.

Fill Up with the Word

When I pull up to the gas pump, my mind is made up: I am going to fill up my car with as much gasoline as possible. I understand that the pump is designed to stop automatically when the tank is full, but you'll never see me stop at that point. I know there is always room for more and I am determined to keep pressing the pump a little at a time until the tank is filled to the brim. It has almost become a challenge! Jesse's the same way. I have known him to shake the car as though he is leveling off the gas tank and start pumping again until the fumes are all out and the tank is completely filled up.

This should be our attitude when it comes to getting filled up with the Word of God. Never be satisfied with just enough. Move into an overflow mentality. Remind yourself that your spiritual growth is directly related to the time and effort that you put into prayer and reading God's Word.

You've probably heard the saying, "Seven days without God makes one weak." God always has more insight for you, and His ways and purposes are what He wants to develop in you. God has deep things that can only be revealed to you when you study His Word. It's the key to steadily growing in the knowledge of God and bearing fruit.

Paul prayed that the Colossians "...may be filled with the full (deep and clear) knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom [in comprehensive insight into the ways and purposes of God] and in understanding and discernment of spiritual things—That you may walk (live and conduct yourselves) in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to Him and desiring to please Him in all things, bearing fruit in every good work and steadily growing and increasing in and by the knowledge of God [with fuller, deeper, and clearer insight, acquaintance, and recognition" (Colossians 1:9-10 AMPC).

Before I was saved, I never read the Bible. But soon after I was born again, the Word of God became a vital part of my life. I was thrilled about the wonderful things God had written to me in His Word. It wasn't just words on a page to me; I recognized that it was Holy Ghost-inspired words that were alive and powerful, and able to help me change my own life. I couldn't learn fast enough. I wanted to know all that God had for me.

No matter what situation came up in my life, I would always think, *What does the Word say about that?* Then, I would search the Word for my answer, write it down, and meditate on my promise until it was rooted in my heart. I quickly learned that real Bible faith sees the invisible, believes the incredible, and receives the impossible.

Live by the Word

I want you to know today that God's Word is not a far away, unreachable thing for you to take hold of. Romans 10:8 tells us, "*But what saith it? The Word is* nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach."

Put the Word in your heart and mouth, and it will work miraculously for you. No matter what you are going through, regardless of the lies of the devil, God can be relied upon to bring His Word to pass. In Luke 21:33, Jesus said, "Heaven and earth shall pass away: but My words shall not pass away." There is nothing more secure, nothing more powerful, and nothing more enduring than God's Word.

Hebrews 4:12 (AMPC) tells us that the Word of the Lord is "alive and full of power." Isaiah 40:8 (AMPC) says, "...the Word of our God will stand forever." And 1 Peter 1:25 says, "But the Word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the Word which by the Gospel is preached unto you."

I love that! The Word lives and abides forever! It has the power to transform failure, lack, and confusion into victory, abundance, and peace each and every day. Not only will the Word establish a victory plan that will overcome any storm in life, but it will also reveal warning signals and keep you prepared for action.

Make a quality decision to daily live by the Word. Make it your first priority and you will begin to see the effects. You'll move into an overflowing life—a life of peace, joy, and guidance from on High. You'll be someone who sees the invisible, believes the incredible, and receives the impossible!
