

The doctor told us that day that they didn't have all of the results and they needed to run more tests. God continued to give her confirmation through scripture that her mountain was dissolved. The doctor said the long story was that the pathology report was wrong, and don't listen to it because you are free of cancer. Angels Exist to Serve GOD

ngels could be anywhere they want to be. The faithful ones that didn't fall with Satan remain true to the Father—they only follow God's Word and God's will. The word angel means "messenger" in both Hebrew and Greek, because the angels here have been given the duty to be messengers for God. They visit God's people to deliver words from God. They help to move God's will and the Church forward from behind the scenes. They warn God's people of danger. They save God's people from situations they don't even realize are about to happen. Some are positioned in certain places in the world. Some are assigned to individual people. They do all sorts of things, and many things we simply do not know. They're most often hidden, unless God wills that they reveal themselves.

The angels of God can take on human forms to

look like us or reveal themselves exactly how they were originally created by God—materializing in and out of our sight at God's will (Genesis 19:1-3, Hebrews 13:2, Revelation 10:1-3). Angels were part of our Creation (Genesis 2:1, Job 38:1,4,7; Colossians 1:16, Jude 6). There are many here and, like always, they continue to assist God. They are supernatural beings, and along with supernatural strength and abilities, they also have great discernment and wisdom (2 Samuel 14:17,20).

Angels can and will do completely impossible things in order to fulfill God's sovereign plan. They will be major players in the end times, too. They'll be with us to the end of the world and beyond. God's angels are powerful beings with incredible capabilities and great intelligence—and they are holy and sinless before God.

So, why would these heavenly angels *help* us? Why would these beings, capable of so much, even *speak* to us? Why would they have *anything* to do with us humans here on earth at all? There's only one reason: GOD. The faithful ones do what God wants done. They aren't just carriers of messages for God, but they take on varying rolls to advance the Church.

In the Bible, when angels didn't take on a human form to interact with someone—when they revealed themselves in their own form—they shocked the socks off of people! When they appear as themselves, they are flat overwhelming to our natural eyes. There's a reason they had to say, "Fear not!" to so many people in the Word. Being scared is a pretty natural reaction. We're just not used to seeing huge, bright, lit-up-likethe-sun beings speaking the Word and will of God.

These beings have power and ability beyond what we yet know. All we know is what God's Word says. Beyond that, the details of how they were made, how long they've been in existence, or what each and every one is capable of is just plain unknowable. What we do know is that God created them all to *serve* in one way or another—I want you to really understand that. No matter how majestic, no matter how powerful, and no matter how extraordinary we think they are, God created them to serve.

We serve too, but God created us for a different purpose than the angels. We were created to be God's family. God loves us and considers us like children. We are something special to the Father. A unique triune creation made in His image and likeness. A mix of the dust of the earth and the breath of Almighty God. We aren't like the angels. We are sons and daughters who serve, and in the order of His creation, that makes us different.

From the dust our bodies were made, but from the breath of God we were given life. One breath set this all into motion. One blast of breath from God and we began. That breath made us eternal spirit-beings, housed in temporary, corruptible mortal flesh—and, apparently, that combination is unique in all of creation . . . and very, very precious to God. So, we are fragile by comparison to the angels, weaker physically, and learning as we go in life, but because we are God's family, we are favored even above the highest of angelic beings. Still, we are all working together and unified with the angels under this: We ALL love and

serve God, and we know He deserves all the glory and praise. God loves us, and we are distinct in His creation.

Love. That's not just what God does; it's Who He *is*. God *is* love. He is also holy beyond our comprehension—pure, holy, and both merciful and just. The angels He created? They are in awe of Him. They reverence Him. They exist to serve Him, and they do it with true honor and often joy, which makes them break out into praise or song. The angels defer to God and speak of Him in glowing terms. Angels also speak on behalf of God to us with a capacity for duty we can't grasp. They're not human. Their capacity for dutifulness seems to be on a whole other level. It's just how they were made. More than anything, they know they were made to do the works of God and serve His will.


Powerful servants. Powerful messengers. Powerful supernatural beings that innately know that we are favored by God and called His children. We are what God created us to be: His family. You see, we weren't created to just be servants. We were created to be sons and daughters who serve. There's a difference! Even in our fragility, the angels recognize us as different to God and higher ranking than they are.

We're always going to be kids. Really, you can think of it like that. God never calls us His adults. He calls us His children. And what do children need? They need guidance. They need instruction. They need help! As servants of God, as beings who do what God loves, they choose to obey the Father when it comes to us. You see, the angels have seen God in a way we have not seen Him yet—in all His glory and power. They *know* there is nothing and no one above God.

So, if God Himself calls *us* His sons and His daughters, if He has created *us* to be His family, then the angels know it, too. The faithful angelic beings know it. The fallen angelic beings know it. Everything in Heaven and in hell knows it.

You've got to ask yourself if you know it.

There's an epidemic in this world of people walking around with no clue of who and Whose they are—but I have a feeling that if you're reading this, you have a clue! The angels have no such dilemma when it comes to us. Like I said, they *know!* So they offer help to us from time to time, and likely more than we will ever know until we get to Heaven,

because they *know*. They know we're children caught in the crosshairs of a war that started in Heaven when Satan wanted to be like God and rebelled. They know we'll continue being in the middle of that war until Jesus comes.

Angelic beings also know that once we accept Christ, once we are forgiven and are made righteous through Jesus' sacrifice on the cross, we are children with immense power—because with salvation through Christ, we get authority. God gave us the power to use His name and His Word to defeat anything that rises up against us, even angels in rebellion. It's almost funny that we, as children of God, can stand up to and defeat fallen angelic beings simply with our faith in God, His name, and His Word.

When believers don't know that God made them His family, when they don't realize their position and authority in Christ, they can easily feel as if supernatural beings have a higher position with God than they do. The reality is that angels do not have a higher position than the children of God. If they were to be confronted with something so jaw-dropping as an angel, they just might do something crazy like fall on their face in praise of them. Let me tell you

something, praising angels is totally against the Word of God. We must *always* put God first over anything He's made, whether natural or supernatural.

God alone is worthy of our praise. After all, everything was created by Him and everything is held together by Him (Colossians 1:13-17). And we are specifically told not to worship angels in the Bible. We can never forget that God is the head of everything. God holds the Body of Christ together, not signs, wonders, visions, or angels. God is the Head, not His created beings (Colossians 2:18-19). So, when thinking about angelic beings or even if we have experiences with them, we have to remember that God's angels assist Him and help or give messages on His behalf.

The faithful angelic beings always point us to God—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—they never go against His Word or His will. If they intervene in the life of a human being, it's just because they know God wants it done. Period. That's because the Hidden Help and every other angelic being have been created to serve God's will, not their own will—or ours, unless our will lines up with God's will. God's Word is His will. That's why it's so important for us to fill our mind and heart with the Word of God. If we are speaking the Word and our will is in line with it, then God's angels help us—but they are under no obligation to help us if we aren't.

So, if you ever do happen to see an angel manifested and have a knee-jerk reaction to praise them, they will let you know quick, fast, and in a hurry to stop doing it. The faithful ones will refuse to allow you to take them out of their God-given position. They will correct and redirect all your praise to God. They will not accept your praise. They will not step out of God's created divine order.

If you think you'd never fall for praising an angel, think again. In the book of Revelation, the apostle John was having vision after vision, and they were coming to him from an angel on God's behalf—and it overwhelmed him so much, even he messed up and fell into worship. Read how he puts it. "Now I, John, saw and heard these things. And when I heard and saw, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel who showed me these things. Then he said to me, 'See that you do not do that. For I am your fellow servant, and your brethren the prophets, and of

those who keep the words of this book. Worship God" (Revelation 22:8-9 NKJV). Notice how the angel stops John, and quick! Notice how the angel tries to get it across to John that they are in it together, and that he is not above John or God.

If an angel *does* accept your praise and even tries to illicit more of it from you, well . . . that's how you know you aren't dealing with the faithful. You're being deceived by the fallen. Those angels follow Satan, and they're prideful just like he is. Satan rebelled because he wanted to be like God—he wanted glory and praise. The fallen ones want it, too. They're quick to let you do it, and feed lies to give you even more reasons to praise them. They lie all the time, sometimes using truth and twisting it, and their only loyalty is to themselves—if they talk about God at all, they will twist His words and lie some more. They're masters of deception.

The angels of God are pure and are fiercely loyal to Him. They understand their position and are thrilled to be in it—and they love the pure words of God. The faithful ones aren't prideful. Only a fallen angel would let you keep praising him and giving him the thanks that belongs to God. Remember that. The Word tells us they can take on the form of an angel of light (2 Corinthians 11:13-15). Don't let their fake light fool you. In the last days, some will do that—they'll be influenced by the fallen. The Word says some will end up following the doctrines of demons (1 Timothy 4:1). As they say, all that glitters is not gold.

All praise and glory belong to God alone—I can't emphasize that enough. God is our supreme Creator; not the angels who help Him, no matter how magnificent they are. Even today, some well-meaning people claim they've been told by beings from the heavens that *they* created everything we see. That means those beings are claiming to do what God said *He* did. That's called deception.

If God said He created this world, then He did. If angels contradict God, they are trying to deceive mankind, and they lie because they are the fallen. They are in league with the author of lies himself, Satan—and just remember that the reason he fell in the first place was because he wanted to be like God (Isaiah 14:12-14). So, it's no big shock that he wants to take credit for what he didn't create. He's a liar and a thief who comes to steal, kill, and destroy. Anything he says that seems "good" is just being used

to deceive you, because twisting the truth is what he does. He's wicked, and that means twisted.

I'll get to more about Satan later, but just remember that God's Word tells us that even if a being shows up like "an angel of light," if they deny Christ, they are not good and not God's! They are just lying, stinking, fallen angels and demons trying to deceive you with a fake cloak of bright light and words that make you feel good.

So, don't be fooled by false light. Don't be led astray by anything that does not recognize Jesus as Messiah, God's Son, and point you to salvation from sin by His sacrifice on the cross. Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life—nobody's getting to the Father unless they go through Him, no matter how much they rationalize their erroneous thinking. They can look good and sound good and still be pushing totally false doctrines that have nothing to do with God.

Don't let that scare you off from admiring God's faithful angels, though. God wouldn't have allowed us to know about them if He wanted us to ignore them completely! He wouldn't send them if He didn't want us to know them or even meet them. Angelic beings are wonderful creations of God—a species apart from us, but still united with us in love for God and all He says and does.

As long as you don't praise them, you are doing nothing wrong by learning about them and admiring them for their role in God's work—because they are totally worthy of that! I love the world God created—the people, the animals, and all of nature is magnificent to me. I don't feel guilty admiring any of it. I don't feel guilty praising God for any of it either. I hope you get my point.

I believe God enjoys it when we think what He made is wonderful. I think He just loves when we admire what He's done—because it blesses Him to please us with the work of His hands. God creates beautiful things, astounding things, and He creates majestic beings of all sorts, too. The angels are God's handiwork, and they're worth being amazed by. All you have to do is avoid putting anything, including God's creations, above *Him*. That's it. And that's easy!



Indiana: I'm watching your sermon "The Wrong Man with the Right Stick" and just wanted to tell you thank you! Thank you for going after God. Thank you for being a man who believes God. Thank you for being faithful to Him all these years. Thank you for continuing on through persecution. Thank you for sharing your life (stories) to show us God's love, power, His truths, and His ways. I've learned so much through your teachings in the few short years I've been watching, and wanted to let you know how much I appreciate you. Blessings like rain to you and your precious wife, Cathy. Thank you too, Cathy!

Email: I fractured my foot several months ago, and while the doctors were saying it was healed, it felt like a constant crushing pain in my foot. Even while driving to your Nashville meeting, I was experiencing pain. During the service, if I would move it a certain way, I would experience pain. Then at some point during the service it was healed, because I have been up on it constantly without pain ever since.

Georgia: We came to the 2022 Visionary Conference. I invited my 20-year-old daughter to attend so that she could get prayer for healing. It did not work out and she did not come. I told her, that's ok, I will go up for prayer for you. I know God can heal you through me. The first night at the conference, you walked right up to me out of everyone in the crowd, and you laid hands on me and everyone prayed for me. I fell down, and I just knew things would never be the same again. My daughter had been plagued with a disease called PANDAS. The next day after you prayed for me, SHE'S HEALED. She is fine! No symptoms. She is going on with her life and actually able to do things! She is happy and healthy EVERY DAY! Thank you so much for praying for her!

Vermont: Your ministry's prayerful support has impacted our family for Christ in amazing ways over the course of 41 years. Although time constraints and lack of paper prevent me from writing the many of a multitude of testimonies our family has personally had as a result of your ministry and Prayer Team, I personally want you and your staff to know two things: Never undervalue even the smallest kindness in the work you all do, and know that lives have been phenomenally, profoundly changed through your work in Christ.

Minnesota: I have been tithing into your ministry for some time now. I had what I feel is a word from the Lord a while back that I should not just expect a return financially, but that blessings should coat every area of my life. I have been claiming this 100-fold blessing and thanking God for it. I wasn't paying attention when making jam one afternoon. I reached over to move a pan without realizing it was hot. God reminded me (while I was admiring my beautiful skin) that I'm a tither! I don't know if I even asked Him to heal my hand or take the pain away... I was loopy. He keeps His promises because He's a good Parent and He cares for us. Thank you for providing the opportunity for people to share in the anointing that is on your ministry. May God continue to pour out His blessings on your household and your ministry. Thank you for being a blessing.

Texas: I want to tell of my testimony that God is using Jesse Duplantis Ministries to break heavy bondages from my body, mind, and soul. I have been through a very intense and very painful healing process of spiritual and physical afflictions from years of past trauma and abuse. Jesus told me to register for your conference, but several weeks before, though, I had no money to go. Georgia: MIRACLES DO HAPPEN! Thank You for praying for my granddaughter, who was diagnosed with cancer. Well, she has gone thru chemo, physical therapy, a stem cell transplant surgery, and post chemo. As of Monday, her report is that she has ZERO cancer cells and the medical findings: NO TRACE of cancer is found in her body. The stem cell transplant was 1000% successful! TO GOD BE ALL GLORY AND HE HAS ALL POWER! God gave her such great inner strength. She never withdrew from college, and she took online classes while going through all of this. I also thank God that her only brother stepped up to be her stem cell donor. He even shaved his head when she lost her hair. GOD IS STILL PERFORMING MIRACLES, HIS WONDER TO BEHOLD! Thank you, thank you, thank you, and may God continue to richly bless you!



o you realize that when God created you, He created you to be a success, to succeed in every area of life, all the way to the end? Unfortunately, there are too many Christians who start off great in their walk with the Lord but, ultimately, don't reach their destiny or get to their destination. Well, let me encourage you right now: That's not going to be *you*, and that's not going to be me, bless God!

So how do we achieve our full purpose and have a solid ending? Jesus addressed this very issue in the book of Matthew, chapter 10. After calling and commissioning His 12 disciples, Jesus prepared them with instructions and warned them about the hostility that would come. Let's pick up at Matthew 10:17 and continue through to verse 22:

But beware of men: for they will deliver you up to the councils, and they will scourge you in their synagogues;

And ye shall be brought before governors and kings for My sake, for a testimony against them and the Gentiles.

But when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what ye shall speak.

For it is not ye that speak, but the

Spirit of your Father which speaketh in you.

And the brother shall deliver up the brother to death, and the father the child: and the children shall rise up against their parents, and cause them to be put to death.

And ye shall be hated of all men for My name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved.

Think about the end of verse 22. When you know the end from the beginning, it's a lot easier to walk in God's will for your life to the end. I know people want instant gratification instead of waiting on God's timing. But I'm going to teach you a few things that I know will help you to stay your course and finish strong.

I often say that, throughout my life, I've had many opportunities to fail, but I refuse to take any. Some people think that's arrogant. It's not. It's called confidence. I've got confidence in my God and I know that He is more than able to finish the good work that He began in me. You see, the Holy Spirit is working with me and I am never alone.

The same is true for you. I'm not saying life is always easy or fun. Sometimes there are mental struggles, tears, temptations, bonds, and afflictions—that's a fact of life for those of us who are sold out

for Jesus. For instance, lots of people hate me. But Jesus said, "ye shall be hated of all men for My name's sake..." (Matthew 10:22). They don't like me, and maybe some people aren't too fond of you either, but it's because they don't like the Christ in us.

Difficult circumstances come in life, but God always rewards and blesses us through our difficulties. Problems may come and people may fight us, but the devil is a liar and God is good! God is faithful to keep His Word, and we should keep our faith in Him, too. Afterall, Jesus is the One Who gives us everything we need to accomplish what He's put on our heart to do.

People often ask me, "How do you know what God wants you to do in your life and ministry?" I simply ask the Lord, "What will You have me to do?" He may show me a project that will help us reach more people for Him, and all I do is walk the trail He's set before me. I've been doing this for over 46 years now and, believe me, God's Word is true! Jesus said He's the Author and Finisher of our faith. But remember, He's under no obligation to finish something that He hasn't authored. So I just let Him do all the authoring, and then I walk the trail. He always honors my faith in His Word and helps me to bring His projects to completion.

So how do we walk the trail of God's will for our lives and endure to the end with the seal of success? It takes steady character, a staying power, and a moral power to get us to a good conclusion.

Now when you start succeeding, there may be persecution—but "Percy" ain't cute! "Percy's" going to be there to mess with you. People may get mad at you and try to destroy your character. They may try to destroy your moral and staying power. But if you remain steady and loyal to yourself, you will come to a good end, glory to God!

Let me give you some great spiritual advice: No matter what, just don't give up. Don't let anyone or anything steal your passion for your calling—it's too precious to waste and too important to let go of. Like I said, God is *with* you and *in* you always, making the way for you to complete the great work He began in you (Philippians 1:6).

Maybe you're saying, "Yeah, Brother Jesse, that's easy for you to say. You don't know how bad my situation is." What I want to say to you is to keep steady faith because it will always produce steady hope, long outlooks, and wide horizons. You have to be willing to endure. Never break faith with yourself and always keep

your honor bright in your eyes. When you do, the devil will think you're enjoying whatever tactic he's using to get you off course. He'll think, "Oh, this isn't working," and he'll quit harassing you.

When you think about it, our salvation demands our keeping on to solid endings where the seal of success is placed. That means salvation in its purest term means "soundness." You just keep on keeping on to a good, solid end. Always tell yourself, "I'm a success going somewhere to succeed!"

Really, you don't have to fail when trouble comes your way. It's only when you give in to those circumstances and accept them that you can't overcome them. I learned that when trouble comes at me, I don't have to give in to it. I can turn the situation around by believing God to help me capitalize on that trouble. Jesus capitalized on trouble all of the time! The more that people persecuted Him, He would get even more people to follow Him. When He was being doubted for Who He was and attacked for the miracles He was doing, even more people would get healed and touched.

You see, everything I'm telling you today is what Jesus did. He endured all things. He never broke faith with Himself—He was loyal to Himself. He had the seal of success on Him and He knew He could bring people to a good conclusion. He knew His Word could not be broken, and people followed what He said and believed.


That's true for you and me, too. But maybe you think it's too late for you to accomplish everything God has called you to do. I like to say that as a bornagain believer, you have no shelf life. It's never too late! It doesn't matter how beautiful or terrible one's beginning is. Nothing matters in human life without a good ending. Look at Jesus' ending. It was far greater than His beginning. Yes, His beginning was the miracle virgin birth, but in His ending, He opened the doors for *you* to come boldly to the throne of grace whenever you're in need.

Whatever God has called you to do, remember Philippians 1:6 (NKJV): "Being confident of this very thing, that He Who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ." Learn to look at your answer rather than your problem. You have a Gospel right to believe God's Word for your life. Stay faithful to yourself and remember to keep your honor bright. Believe in yourself...because God believes in you!



It is awesome to realize that one brief moment in the presence of God can so impact your entire life that you are never the same again. Many years ago, that's what happened to me. I turned on the television and watched Billy Graham preach to thousands of people in one of his crusades.

I can't explain the feeling I had that night, but for the first time in my life I knew that God was real. I was in awe of His great love and realized my need for Him in my life. Although I didn't physically see God or audibly hear Him, I knew I was in His presence as I reached out, and I was gloriously changed as I asked Jesus into my life.

The Word of God is full of testimonies of lives that were dramatically transformed by being in God's presence. My favorite is in chapter six of the Book of Isaiah, which records his call to the ministry after seeing a spectacular vision of the Lord sitting upon His throne in all His glory. It changed his life forever.

In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and His train filled the temple.

Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly.

And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord of hosts: the whole earth is full of His glory.

And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke.

Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts.

Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar:

And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged.

Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us? Then said I, Here am I; send me.

Isaiah 6:1-8

The account of Isaiah's vision begins with the phrase, "In the year that king Uzziah died." This was

not just a casual introductory phrase, nor intended to simply give the approximate date of his vision. It reminded him and his people of the uncertainty that prevailed during that time.

Up until this point, Isaiah had known only one occupant to the throne of his people. That man, King Uzziah, had taken the throne at the age of sixteen and reigned for fifty-two years (2 Chronicles 26:3). As soon as he took the throne, he set himself to seek God, which began a period of remarkable prosperity. He waged war with the enemies of God and regained lost territory. However, in the last stage of his life, the king was lifted up in pride and died of leprosy.


Suddenly, the throne was empty. The terrible news traveled quickly from house to house, village to village, and hopelessness grew as the people questioned the future of their nation. What would happen to their lives? With a history of notorious kings that had plunged them into sin, it is understandable why the people were concerned about the man that would succeed the king and fill the throne. This was Isaiah's motivation for seeking God's face and interceding for his nation.

During these precious moments in the presence of God, Isaiah's life was totally transformed. His vision of a filled throne brought strong encouragement and hope during a time of uncertainty and despair. While beholding the awesome glory of the Lord, Isaiah was compelled to offer worship to God, repentance toward God, and service for God.

Worship to God

When faced with the Holy presence of God, all creatures are compelled to react in one way or another. Some become angry, like the demons that came into Jesus' presence and demanded to know why He had come to torment them before their time. Others are resentful, like one of the thieves who was crucified alongside Jesus. The soldier at the cross was amazed by Jesus' compassion for the people that had persecuted Him. When the crowds saw Jesus' miracles of healing and feeding the multitudes, they reacted in wonder.

However, when confronted with the reality of the presence of God, worship is the only reaction that will change our lives. When we keep our eyes fixed on Heaven and spend time in true worship in the presence of God, we are empowered to rise above the circumstances of life.

Repentance Toward God

The result of being in God's presence is a revelation of God's glory, which reveals the condition of the heart and the need for repentance. When faced with the awesome holiness of God, Isaiah cried in verse five, "Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts." Isaiah recognized the need for repentance.

This was Jesus' message in Mark 1:15: "... The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the Gospel." Later, when He sent forth the twelve in Matthew 10:1-7 and the seventy in Luke 10:1-9, Jesus sent them forth with the same message of repentance.

Many years ago, I watched an interview with the pastor of the largest church in the world, Pastor Cho from Seoul, South Korea. They wanted to know what he considered to be the reason for the tremendous growth he was experiencing in his church. I know they were expecting him to outline various programs, but instead he simply answered, "I just preach the Kingdom."

In that small statement hangs the essence of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. In Colossians 1:9-13, Paul reminds us that as born-again believers, God has delivered us from the kingdom of darkness and translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son.

Membership in this unshakable kingdom brings

tremendous privileges and benefits. The Bible declares that we have already been granted everything pertaining to life and godliness through the knowledge of God. We have precious and magnificent promises that grant us the privilege to become partakers of the divine nature.

Repentance toward God is the only requirement for entry into this glorious kingdom. Repentance is simply turning from your way of running your life and giving your life to Jesus. He alone can open the door by cleansing you from sin and purifying your heart.

Service for God

Isaiah's motivation for service was born out of time spent in God's presence. It was during those precious moments that God was able to reveal His heart to Isaiah and impart vision.

Isaiah wrote in verse eight of chapter six, "Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us? Then said I, Here am I; send me."

Your success in serving God and fulfilling His vision for your life depends upon your obedience to the call, boldness to relate the message, and perseverance to complete the vision.

When confronted with opposition to the call of God on their lives, the disciples prayed to be filled with boldness to relate the message. "And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto Thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak Thy Word" (Acts 4:29).

The apostle Paul never forgot that moment on the Damascus road when he was knocked off his donkey. In an instant, Paul was changed from a persecutor of the Church into a persecutor of Satan. Paul persevered to finish the race that was set before him. At the end of his life of service to God, he could confidently say, "I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith" (2 Timothy 4:7).

God desires to reveal Himself to all that will seek Him with their whole heart. Draw near to the Lord today in prayer and He will draw near to you (James 4:8). I must warn you, though: one moment in the presence of God will spoil you and change your life forever. You won't be satisfied with empty religion. You will hunger for more of God and your desire will be to serve Him continually. You may even respond to the Lord the way that Isaiah and countless others have: "Here am I; send me."
