



In life, seasons come and go. The Bible says there is "A time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up that which is planted" (Ecclesiastes 3:2). After many years of trying to grow beautiful and healthy houseplants, I have finally conceded that this is just not the season of my life for it. I seem to be continually living in the season to "pluck up that which is planted!" It's just not right.

Now I really do care about those plants, but the fact is that God has called me to the ministry and that means traveling. When I'm on the road with Jesse, we're seeing people's lives changed. They're getting saved, healed, and delivered. I don't even think about the plants until I arrive home from a ministry trip. I walk through my door, and there they are...begging for water and about ready to bite the dust. Every time I come home, it seems as if I am reviving them from yet another near-death experience.

Although my plants can miraculously survive weeks of neglect, they will never live up to their full potential this way. They will never thrive under this type of treatment. Even though I faithfully remove their dead leaves, add more fertilizer or replace potting soil again and again, I know that it's not

right for my houseplants to keep existing in "survival mode." I want to do right by them. I want them to *thrive!*

God feels the same way about you. You don't need to spend your life on a treadmill, going through the motions and sweating up a storm but never going anywhere. God desires for

you to *thrive* instead of continually living in survival mode. You were created in His image and given dominion over the works of God's hands. You were made more than a conqueror in this life by Jesus Christ. You are anointed to win and impossible to curse!

The definition of *thrive* is: "To make steady progress; prosper. To grow vigorously; flourish." That sounds like the very thing that God had in mind when He created Adam and Eve and placed them in a beautiful garden home. He told them to be fruitful and multiply—in other words, *thrive!* But they never did live up to their full potential. They never

flourished. Although God had a plan for them to thrive, all they ever did was survive.

Their story is the oldest in the world, but we can still learn valuable lessons from Adam and Eve's failure. If we listen to God's Word and refuse to accept the lies of the devil, we can thrive. It is possible to "make steady progress, prosper, grow vigorously, and flourish" in any area of life. King David learned that lesson and, under the inspiration of the Holy Ghost, he wrote:

Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in His law doth he meditate day and night.

And he shall be like a tree planted by the

rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper. PSALM 1:1-3

In the first three amazing verses of this Psalm, we can see God's three-step plan for us to

thrive in whatever we do in life. If we 1.) choose not to hang with the wrong crowd and 2.) crave God's Word and feed on it, we shall 3.) live a fruitful, long, and prosperous life!

THE DEFINITION OF THRIVE IS: "TO MAKE STEADY PROGRESS; PROSPER. TO GROW VIGOROUSLY; FLOURISH."

Don't Hang with the Wrong Crowd

That first word, "Blessed," in verse one should really catch your attention. One definition of blessed is: "empowered to prosper." If you want to move out of survival mode and begin to thrive in life, you can gain tremendous insight from this verse.

The Amplified Bible, Classic Edition says,

"BLESSED (HAPPY, fortunate, prosperous, and enviable) is the man who walks and lives not in the counsel of the ungodly [following their advice, their plans and purposes], nor stands [submissive and inactive] in the path where sinners walk, nor sits down [to relax and rest] where the scornful [and the mockers] gather."

This verse should be a warning flag. It is difficult

to thrive when you are continually surrounded by ungodly sinners that mock God. It may be possible to survive in that environment, but you may never reach your greatest potential. Hanging continually with the wrong crowd will stunt your growth and rob you of the power to succeed.

You may know people like those described above. They may even live in your house or work with you on the job. You are called to love them, pray for them, and lead them to Jesus, but they should not be influencing your daily life. Your blessed, thriving life should attract them to the Gospel. You are blessed and empowered to prosper by the Creator, God—anointed to win and impossible to curse!

Your thriving, fruitful life and intimate relationship with God should be a beacon of light to the world, guiding them to safety.

One of the trademarks of a blessed person is the company they keep. A blessed person is attracted to those who are serious about their walk with God—

they cultivate good relationships. A blessed person is a leader and not a follower—they don't follow the advice of the ungodly and don't make decisions that are influenced by ungodly plans and purposes. They don't choose the path of least resistance—they refuse to hang with those who are scornful of God's Word.

Proverbs 2:6-9 says:

"GLORY IN HIS HOLY NAME: LET THE HEARTS OF THOSE REJOICE WHO SEEK AND REQUIRE THE LORD [AS THEIR INDISPENSABLE NECESSITY]. SEEK, INQUIRE OF AND FOR THE LORD. AND CRAVE HIM AND HIS STRENGTH (HIS MIGHT AND INFLEXIBILITY TO TEMPTATION); SEEK AND REQUIRE HIS FACE AND HIS PRESENCE [CONTINUALLY] **EVERMORE.**" **PSALM 105:3-4 (AMPC)**

For the LORD giveth wisdom: Out of His mouth cometh knowledge and understanding.

He layeth up sound wisdom for the righteous:
He is a buckler to them that walk uprightly.

He keepeth the paths of judgment, and preserveth the way of His saints.

Then shalt thou understand righteousness, and judgment, and equity; yea, every good path.

God wants to reveal every good path to you. He has laid up sound wisdom that will enable you to live up to your full potential. Proverbs 3:5-6 reveals how you can find your pathway in life: "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and

lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths."

Crave God's Word and Feed on It

Let's look again at Psalm 1:2 (AMPC): "But his

delight and desire are in the law of the Lord, and on His law (the precepts, the instructions, the teachings of God) he habitually meditates (ponders and studies) by day and by night."

A strong desire for God's Word is a dominate characteristic of the person that is blessed. Psalm 105:3-4 (AMPC) says, "Glory in His holy name; let the hearts of those rejoice who seek and require the Lord [as their indispensable necessity]. Seek, inquire of and for the Lord, and crave Him and His strength (His might and inflexibility to temptation); seek and require His face and His presence [continually] evermore."

Once you taste and see that the Lord is good, you will forever crave Him and seek out ways to continually feed on His Word.

I'll never forget the look on my daughter's face when I fed her that first bite of "real food." Until that day, Jodi was content with strained carrots and bland rice cereal. She had no idea what she had been missing until I placed a spoonful of mashed potatoes and gravy in her mouth. Her beautiful blue eyes were so expressive as they locked on the dish in front of her. Before she could swallow her first bite, she grunted for more spoonfuls until it was all gone. After that day, Jodi wasn't satisfied with bland baby food. She had developed a craving for "real food" and refused to eat anything else.

In order to thrive in life, you need to understand the value of regularly feeding on the Word of God. A blessed person understands that regularly feeding on the Word of God is vital to their success in life. Craving God's Word, feeding on it regularly, and declaring it with your own mouth will empower you to thrive in life. Psalm 19:14 says, "Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my Strength, and my Redeemer."

Live a Fruitful, Long & Prosperous Life

If you refuse to hang with the wrong crowd and are determined to feed on God's Word, you can expect to thrive in life. Psalm 1:3 (AMPC) says,

"And he shall be like a tree firmly planted [and tended] by the streams of water, ready to bring forth its fruit in its season; its leaf also shall not fade or wither; and everything he does shall prosper [and come to maturity]."

If you are planted firmly in God's Word and tended by His refreshing, living water, you are primed and ready to bring forth fruit. Instead of fading out or withering away, you have God's promise that everything you do will prosper. This is your season! You have moved out of survival mode and are on your way to thriving.

Today, I want to encourage you that your future is not bleak or weak, but strong and mighty. God's plan is for you to thrive, flourish, and live a fruitful life. You can be like those described in Psalm 92:12-14:

The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree:
he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon.
Those that be planted in the house of the Lord
shall flourish in the courts of our God.
They shall still bring forth fruit in old age;
they shall be fat and flourishing.

Notice that this promise is for the righteous—that's you, if you have received Jesus as the Lord of your life. Regardless of your background or age, you can thrive and live a long, fruitful, and prosperous life. It may not come to you overnight, but if you plant yourself in the house of the Lord and are faithful to live by the Word, God has promised that you "shall be fat and flourishing." So don't let the little things steal God's good plan for your life. Decide today that you are going to do what it takes to thrive and be successful in every area of your life.







Don't you enjoy a good flavor? I do. I'm a Cajun from South Louisiana and we're all about the "flavor." Just thinking about the magnificent flavor of Cathy's gumbo makes me hungry!

Flavorful food is wonderful, but there's nothing like the *favor* and *flavor* of God. I've learned that when I seek the Lord and walk in His righteous favor, I can't help but exude His amazing flavor in every area of my life. Now that's what I call magnifying the wonderfulness of Jesus everywhere I go, and that's exactly what I want for you, too!

Let's go to the Word and see what the Lord has to say about the concept of favor. Psalm 35:27 says, "Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of His servant."

In the first part of this verse, I want you to notice how it says that we should shout with *joy* and be *glad*. Joy is a fruit of the Spirit, and it means more than happiness. Happiness is an emotional feeling that you can lose really quickly. But the joy of the Lord is your strength (Nehemiah 8:10), and

you can have it all the time no matter what your emotions have to say. What I love about God is that He doesn't want you to just be joyful; He wants you to be glad, too!

So how do we receive that from Him? The answer to that question is in the next part of that verse: Favor. Favor is God's feeling towards your welfare. The truth is that He cares deeply about your entire existence—your well-being—and His Word reveals that it pleases Him when you prosper. God delights in *your* prosperity. Do you realize what that means?

Very often, when people think of the word "prosperity," they think it means money and things. That's true in one sense, but there's so much more to it. Think about it: If you had all the money and material things you wanted in life but were too sick to enjoy any of it, what would be the point of that?

The life God wants for you is a flourishing one. He wants to bless you with His favor and He wants you to *receive it*. When you do, His favor will produce peace, joy, and contentment in your life—spiritually, physically, *and* financially. God loves to

see you blessed and flourishing in every way. Your life will shine with God's glory and people will say, "Hey! God sure is good to you!" They'll see that His hand is on you and they will want to taste His goodness in their lives, too. Glory to God!

People always tell me, "Brother Jesse, you are such a blessed man. You always seem so happy." Well, I've tried "sad" and I didn't like it. I tried "sick" and that hurt. I don't want any more of that. I tried "broke" and I'll never go there again! Poverty isn't God's brainchild. That lie came straight from the devil. Poverty is a curse and it's bad news. But the Good News is that Jesus and His blood have redeemed us from every curse. Doesn't that make you want to shout?

After I asked Jesus into my life, I began learning about how to walk in the favor of God. I discovered that when I do, He makes me a flavorful person. His continual blessing on Cathy, me, and our ministry always gets people's attention. So whenever I receive a compliment, I always say, "Thank you. The Lord is gracious." I never make excuses for His blessing on my life. Rather, I magnify Him continually and I take time to glorify Him every chance I get.

Maybe you're thinking, "How do you keep God's favor flowing continually in your life, Brother Jesse?" Well, I give Jesus my whole time, energy, and strength to do His work. I enjoy the presence of God, and He enjoys my presence, too. I love studying His Word and spending time with Him in fellowship. I don't do much praying per se, but He and I do *a lot* of talking. I found out that when I'm having conversations with the Lord, I can really taste the flavor of all the dimensions of Who He is. And that's how revelation comes to me and ministers to me continually.

I want you to know that God is no respecter of persons—He wants to reveal Himself that way to you, too. God wants you to taste His goodness in your life every day. I encourage you to take the time to fellowship with Him. He wants to spend time with you and wants to bless you. God is always

looking for ways to give you favor and help you out in life. He will show you the way to good success. Believe it! Because that's what it's going to take for you to receive it.

I'm always putting my faith on the line for favor with God because I know that when I do, whatever He's calling me to accomplish for Him *will* come to pass. See, when you have favor, God will open doors that no man can shut, and He'll close doors that no man can open. His favor will protect you, your family, and everything He calls you to do for Him (Psalm 5:12). This is the kind of success and blessing that He wants you to enjoy.

Maybe there's something in your past that is holding you back in life, and the idea of God wanting to give you favor seems far out of reach. Let me remind you what His Word says. His favor is a righteous cause and, as a believer, you've been made the righteousness of God. So it's disobedient to *not* accept His Word and *not* accept His goodness in your life. Think about it like this: If you or I say that we are not worthy, that's like a slap in the face to God Almighty, Who sent His Son for us! Jesus shed His blood to give us righteousness. We might not be worthy in our own righteousness, which is like filthy rags, but through Jesus' blood, we are *made* righteous. And, buddy, His righteousness is supreme!

So are you ready to walk in the favor of God and magnify Him continually? With His favor, your life will be flavorful and people will notice. They will want what you have and will want to taste God's goodness in their lives, too. You *can* find favor with God and magnify Him in every area of your life.

As a born-again child of God, there's no time for sadness. Do what the Word says and be *glad* and shout for *joy* today. Start walking in the favor of God and be flavorful to the world around you. Dedicate your time and energy to Christ—seek Him with all your heart. Believe in His unconditional love for you and receive His blessing of favor. He delights in *you* and desires for you to be happy and ever-growing in His grace.

JESSE DUPLANTIS



Never be afraid to let yourself dream. God gave you that mind for a reason, not to think up a disastrous future, but to imagine and use your faith for a good future, to focus on what is good for you, for your family, and for the world at large.

I believe in progression. Out of progression will come possession—this is God's way. You believe it, say it, and do what is in line with the Word, then possession comes. Patience is a part of the process. The Scripture says it was only when Abraham patiently endured that he received the promise.

It doesn't matter if it takes one day or ten years. Stand and having done all to stand, stand therefore, letting patience have its perfect work. In the end, you will be perfect and entire, wanting nothing (James 1:4). Notice the Word went beyond saying we would need nothing and into the realm of desire. Again, want is not a bad thing.

I pray that you have even more people to join with you and the Holy Spirit and say, "I'll pray. I'll agree in faith with you. I'll be your 'two.' I'll 'stand and having done all to stand, stand' with you." Look for people who will lift you up in your quest for God's best, not for people who spend all their time tearing down the messages of Jesus and trying to take what's good away from God's people. This is foolish and damaging—don't be a part of it. Be a part of what's good. Faith in God is good!

Never forget that the world is full of people who want to tear down God's goodness towards His children, who look for ways to doubt and tear down truth and replace it with a controlling lie. Jesus told us that He only spoke what God told Him to speak, and so "the faith message" that Christ taught is from God.

When somebody tells me, "That faith stuff doesn't work," I think, Well, either Jesus is lying or you are lying!

I pick YOU.

Let their hate roll off your back, don't let a word of it redirect your thoughts to what is not good. God is love, and you've been called to love even the unlovable doubters of this world. Trust God day by day. Lean on the Holy Spirit and know that living at the top is nothing if it's not faith and love! Nothing works in the spirit realm without those two things (Galatians 5:6). Faith works by love, so let it work.

There is a reason for everything. While there are many who will say, "That faith junk doesn't work," you must always remember that it took faith to save your soul. Go and see in your Bible how many times Jesus equated miracles to the person's faith. Faith is the currency God requires in order to make exchanges from the spirit world to the physical world. Abraham needed faith. Jesus needed faith. You need faith, too, to get anything out of the spirit to manifest.

CARD GAMES, GOOD FOOD, AND FAITH—I AIM TO WIN!

It makes no difference how many times you may have thought, "It didn't work." I mean, how many times have I played a card game with my friends and lost? Not many! That's a joke, but the point is that I didn't stop playing because I lost once. I'm Cajun and my wife and I play this card game called Pedro with family and friends. It's always the women against the men. We like the competition and it's fun.

Now, I know some of you don't like cards, but I'm sorry! This is my Cajun culture and there isn't one "Thou shalt not play Pedro" in the Word. Cajuns have played this game since we were kids. Now, on the off-chance, odd day that I actually lose a game, you will never catch me saying, "These cards don't work! The game is rigged!" No, there were other factors at play.

So, what do I do? I release the disappointment, remind myself of the rules, and start a new game with success on my mind. Every single time is another opportunity to win, to have patience, and progress until I possess the land. I look at a losing game like maybe "somebody" (Cathy) hindered my success that time. Or maybe it was me...maybe I got distracted and didn't play as well as I could that day. Maybe I

didn't stay vigilant and keep my mind in the game. Or maybe I grew weary and got up from the table before I could win and get the glory. This analogy is a joke in a way, but I hope you get the point I'm trying to make. There are many factors in why one loses or wins. I never throw away my faith.

If that analogy doesn't work, how about this one? How many times have you ordered something at a restaurant and ended up saying, "Awwww, man! I don't like this at all! Yuck!" It might have put a bad taste in your mouth, but that didn't stop you from going out and eating again. There are a lot of reasons why believers don't get what they want. The spirit world is a lot like a restaurant, and many believers try to get food without consulting the menu. Many just complain to the waiter instead of saying what they want. If they didn't get food, it might be because they sat down at the table and never once opened their mouth. Maybe they just wished and hoped for food, and then got angry that the cook didn't bring them anything, and then said, "This doesn't work!"

Words matter—Jesus wouldn't have told you to "say to the mountain" if speaking wasn't part of the process of faith. Put in your order! Faith speaks and expects the food to come, knowing that the cook is God and He's faithful to deliver what He promises in the Word.

Maybe you opened the menu of the Word and didn't ask for what you desired in your heart; maybe you shrunk back in fear and doubted that you could have it or that God even wanted you to have it, even though He put it on the menu. Then, when you didn't get what you desired, you got a little upset.

Faith doesn't work if you don't look at the menu. How can you know what's available? Faith doesn't work if your mouth is asking for one thing but your heart wants another. Your heart and mind need to be on the same page.

God will not agree with your confusion. He won't do it! You'll starve while He waits for you to decide. Remember, you can't get what you don't know that

you want. And you can't get what you don't ask for. The door will never be opened if you don't knock. This spirit world is built on words and faith. The natural world is built on words and actions. They both make waves in different ways that create change, and you live in both places, so you need to function in both well. The Holy Spirit will help you.

THE WORD IS DESIGNED TO DISCERN YOUR HEART

I've never been the type of person who has trouble knowing what he wants. I find it easy to know, and I go about the process of implementing what I want to produce both in the spirit and in the natural.

Not everybody is this way. Some people spin and don't really know what they want. In other words, they don't know what is in their heart, so they feel unsettled. If you find yourself not knowing what is in your own heart, here is what to do: Turn to the Word. Hebrews 4:12 gives great insight into the heart of man: "For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."

The Word of God can divide your SOUL (mind, will, and emotions) from your Spirit (the part of you that is perfectly in tune with God). The Word of God is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of your heart.

So, who needs this information most? YOU. You are the one who needs to know, and God is the One Who will reveal it to you. God put desires in your heart for a reason, so don't go through life ignoring what will bring you the most satisfaction and joy. Your destiny will be produced in reality by walking out the desires of your recreated, born-again heart.

The Holy Spirit helps you rightly divide the Word of truth on a personal level, exposing thoughts of the mind that need to go and showing you the innermost

thoughts and intentions of your heart—the things that need to stay, fill your mind, and become goals for the moment, for the day, and for your future.

Remember that the devil is the author of all confusion, so confusion is not for you. Double-mindedness brings instability in every way. Clarity comes when the heart and mind are on the same page. If you've been ignoring your heart, you might be surprised at just what is revealed when you meditate on the Word and let the Holy Spirit lead you. He will create a clean heart and renew a right spirit in you like Psalm 51:10 says, so let Him do His work. And if your heart is troubled, give those troubles to the One Who is capable of hearing them, doing something about them, and settling your soul.




