The GREAT COMMISSION

JESSE DUPLANTIS

Have you ever had a week start out really good? I mean, everything is going great. You're happy. The wife's happy. The kids are doing alright. Even the dog looks like he's got a smile on his face. It seems like everybody is optimistic and going in the right direction.

Then, somewhere around the middle of the week, something changes in the house. Suddenly, joy is thrown out the window. The wife is snapping. The kids are going crazy. The boss is getting on your case for no reason at all. Even the dog turns on you and starts tearing up the furniture just for fun. Have you ever had a week similar to that? You know, one that starts out great but ends like the worst week of your life? If so, you're in good company. The same thing happened to Jesus.

Jesus had a bad week that we're still talking about today. At the beginning of the week, He was riding into town on a donkey. People were praising Him and waving palm branches in front of Him in complete adoration of His life and ministry. They had nothing but good to say about Him. They loved Him and wanted nothing more than to hear Him speak and watch Him do miracles.

By the end of the week, everything changed. Those same people were gnashing their teeth at the very thought of Him. They criticized Him, made fun of Him, and railed accusations at Him. In fact, they begged the authorities to kill Him! Now, how's that for a bad week?

It began well, but by the end Jesus was being punched, spit at, beaten with whips, and nailed to a cross. At the end of His week, it all went to hell literally. Jesus took on the sins of the world when He went to the cross. The physical suffering was excruciating, but can you imagine the mental and spiritual weight of bearing the sins of the world? We're not talking about a few people here; we're talking about the weight of the world. Yet Jesus did it. Why did He do it? Because He fell in love with the world.

Did it hurt? You better believe it! Did He like it? No, would you? But He did it anyway because He knew the end result was worth it—Jesus knew that *you* were worth it.

Now, Jesus had the power to come off of that cross. He had the power to call legions of angels to the scene to whip everybody, but He didn't. Jesus hung there on the cross by choice. Even as they railed insults at Him, He didn't hold it against them. He prayed, *"Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do"* (Luke 23:34). Buddy, now that's real love!

Jesus freely gave His life for mankind—for those who hated Him and for those who loved Him. He took a tongue-lashing from His critics and a whip-lashing from the authorities, but it was not without purpose. Jesus wasn't in the dark about it either. He knew what was coming. It was for that very purpose that He was born—born to die. And He didn't leave His disciples in the dark about what would happen that week either. In fact, He started warning them about it long before the tide turned and that week began.

Yes, that week was horrible for Jesus, but He went through it all to redeem you and me. Through His suffering and His sacrificial death, He redeemed us. He may have had to take on the sins of the world, but He enjoyed the fruits of that when He conquered hell, death, and the grave and rose again! Our eternal life and our earthly success were purchased with His life, death, and resurrection.

That's pure love and mercy in action, but it wasn't over just yet. Jesus had something to say *after* His death. He came back to give His disciples a command that we are still fulfilling today:

> ... Go ye into all the world, and preach the Gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

Mark 16:15-16

This scripture passage is called the Great Commission because it's a call to ALL believers to be God's workmen. It's about believing in Jesus and in the things that He said enough to *do* something about it—to tell others about His life, death, and resurrection; to share the mercy and grace of God with others so that they might be saved.

You Can Be a Proclaimer

The Great Commission—not everybody is excited about it. When I first heard God calling me to "Go ye," the first thing I thought was, Not me! I'd gotten saved and thought that was good enough. I read that verse and thought it was only talking about pulpit ministry and I didn't want that!

I was satisfied being saved, paying my tithes, and donating my time to my church, so I thought the "Go ye" scripture wasn't for me, but I was wrong. Do you know what preaching really is? It isn't about whooping and hollering. It's not about being an eloquent speaker. It's not about having some big spiritual revelation that nobody's ever heard. Preaching is proclaiming. Proclaiming what? Proclaiming the truth that you know—the testimony of what God has done for you. Preaching is simply *proclaiming* the Good News of Jesus Christ, and anybody who is saved can do that.

The Good News is summed up in this scripture:

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved John 3:16-17

That is not a "beginners" scripture; it's the core of all scripture. Without this, you can't have a good concept of healing, joy, peace, or prosperity. This scripture shows you the love of God in a way that will amaze you, if you let it sink in. If you don't know that God loves you and has your best interests at heart, how can you believe Him for anything?

Listen, if you think that what I do from the pulpit is the only real preaching there is, you are mistaken. You don't need to be an apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor, or teacher—but you definitely need to be a proclaimer! Why? Because the only Jesus some people may ever see is the Jesus in you or the Jesus in me.

Anytime you tell somebody about Jesus, you're proclaiming truth. Anytime you are a light in a dark place, you're preaching. You're fulfilling the Great Commission to "Go ye" regardless of whether you talk to your friend about God or you preach to thousands from a pulpit. The Great Commission is a call to ALL believers, not just some people.

The Bible says the world is like a giant field of wheat that is ready to be harvested. People are the "wheat" and the message of "Go ye" is about "harvesting" souls. Evangelism is about falling in love with the world and harvesting the field for God—presenting the Gospel to the world. What is the reward? Every person that receives salvation! Nothing is more rewarding than helping people. It just makes you feel good.

Signs Follow Believers

Your life is a proclamation of what you believe because what's happening on the inside of you will always spill out and others can sense it. Jesus said there

are "signs" that can be seen in the lives of those who believe, which He talked about right after He gave us the Great Commission.

The first sign is **authority** over the enemy. The power of Jesus and His work on the cross is very real. When it's settled in a Christian's mind, they will think, talk, and act with greater authority-especially when it comes to dealing with God's enemy. Jesus said, "And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My name shall they cast out devils" (Mark 16:17). Now, Jesus wasn't talking about mothers-in-law, Jesus was telling us that even demons recognize faith in God. They go when we say so because with God on our side, we have authority.

The second sign is a **heavenly prayer language**. Jesus continued, saying, "... they shall speak with new tongues"

(Mark 16:17). New tongues means new languages. The Word says in Acts chapter two that those in the upper room on the day of Pentecost spoke in "other tongues," which were actual earthly languages that they'd never learned. That was a miracle and it enabled them to witness more effectively.

But, here, Jesus is talking about "new tongues," and He uses a different Hebrew word and described the type of tongue.

It's not some other kind of language, it's a brand new language-a heavenly language. Who receives it? Those who believe-those who not only believe in Jesus, but also in His promise to grant us a new prayer language.

The third sign Jesus talked about was concerning protection: "They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them" (Mark 16:18). Jesus said believers wouldn't have problems with harmful things like snakes or drinking anything poisonous. It's a promise to those who believe-those who believe not only in Jesus, but also in His promise to grant divine protection.

The fourth sign is **healing**. Jesus continued, "...*they* shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover" (Mark 16:18). Healing is also available to those who not only believe in Jesus, but also in His promise to heal the body through our hands. He is the Healer, but He requires us to act on our faith by laying our hands on the sick.

Notice that none of these things are automatic to those who only believe that Jesus is the Son of God-

Jesus freely gave His life for mankind—for those who hated Him and for

even the devil believes that! Dramatic signs like these manifest when people believe in Jesus-not only in who Jesus is, but in what Jesus has said.

After Jesus shared the Great Commission and told the disciples about the signs of those who believe, the Word says, "...He was received up into Heaven, and sat on the right hand of God" (Mark 16:19). What did the disciples do then? They went to work!

Mark 16:20 says, "And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following." Immediately, they got up and started telling others about Jesus. What were they doing? They were sharing what they believed. They were going ye!

You Can Share His Love

People need Jesus. If you don't think so, you just haven't been looking around. This world is tough and it's getting tougher every day. It's been that way since sin entered the earth and broke the connection between God and mankind. The closer we get to the return of Jesus, the tougher it will be for those who are not living for God. So, we should be stepping up our efforts to reach the lost, and it's going to take

all of us working together to reach the world for Christ.

Religion comes with lots of baggage, but Jesus is the One Who sets you free—free from sin and all its effects, including people who are so religious that they've lost the true message of Christ. Jesus taught faith. Jesus said what we sow, we're going to reap. Jesus said He came to give us life, and give it to us in abundance. He taught us how to live and how to react to problems—by speaking words of life. He told us to simply believe and "Go ye!"

If you believe in Him, then you're called to say so. Jesus didn't tell us to isolate ourselves, He told us to reach out to people and get involved in their spiritual lives. Why should we bother with others? Because the answer to the oldest question, "Am I my brother's keeper?" is YES! We are connected to each other whether we like it or not. We're God's hands in this earth—and there are people coming across our path in life that need our help.

People need help. They needed it back in Jesus' day, and they sure need it now. But remember that nobody

those who loved Him.

can help people the way that God can. We can share our earthly wisdom all day long, but if God isn't involved, it's not going to change the condition of a person's heart. It'll just be empty knowledge. When God gets involved, lives change. People need to *know* the One Who *created* them so that they can learn how to *live* the life He gave them.

Everybody needs Jesus, they just don't know it. Some are in the dark. They've either never heard of the true power of Christ or never decided to make the step and become a true believer. They need somebody to show them the way to salvation.

Others have accepted Jesus but have fallen back for some reason or another. Maybe they've been hurt in some way by other Christians or they were swayed away from their faith through life's circumstances. They need somebody to love them and show them the way back home. They need to be restored. But how will it happen if nobody will "Go ye" and reach out to them?

The world has seen Jesus as a religious figure, but we need to show Jesus as a *personal* Savior. Jesus is approachable. He is the only real answer for the human condition. What has He done for you? Share that with others.

Remember, people don't need a Jesus that is far away. They need a Jesus they can talk to—and that's the kind of Jesus you and I serve. I like to say, "I call Him Jesus and He calls me Jesse!" We're on a first-name basis and it's great! I believe that Jesus wants to have that kind of easy-flowing relationship with everybody, whether they live next door or clear across the planet.

When you share Jesus, it's an act of love—you are tapping into the same love that caused Jesus to endure the cross. Think about it! The only reason you can love is because He first loved you. Now, you don't have to go to the cross because Jesus has already paid that price, but you *do* have to tell others about what He's done. That's part of being a Christian and it's only right to honor the Lord by sharing His message with others.

Jesus came for those who are sin-sick. He didn't try to clean fish before He caught them. As believers, we should see people who are confused, lost, and living in sin as Jesus saw them—like sheep without a Shepherd. They're out there wandering around, trying to live on their own and make their own way. People need Jesus, they really do. And our job isn't to condemn them but to show them how to get saved and be led by the Good Shepherd. That's what falling in love with the world is all about.

I'm One of the "Some"

When I got saved, I changed dramatically. I knew

what God had done for me. He turned my life around and there was nothing unsettled in my heart about His ability to do miracles or perform His Word. He'd already saved me and delivered me, and that was a miracle in itself. I was bad, and I knew that if God could change me, He could do anything! So, I had no problems witnessing to people. I did it all the time. I considered it part of being a Christian to tell others about Jesus. After all, the Bible tells us in 2 Timothy 4:5 that everyone is called to do *"the work of an evangelist."*

But the Bible also says that only "some" are called to actually *be* evangelists—you may be one of the some. If you are, you know that there's a vast difference in being in this type of ministry. There is a special anointing on each one of the offices in God's five-fold ministry. Ephesians 4:11-12 says, "And He gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ."

When God called me, I didn't know how to preach. I didn't even *want* to preach! I didn't want to be a part of the "some" group. That was the last thing I wanted to do. I was a good Christian and I didn't mind sharing my testimony and witnessing, but I had some mixed-up ideas about preaching. I thought you had to be a certain type of person to be a preacher, and I knew I wasn't the type!

When I accepted God's calling to *be* an evangelist, I was very hesitant—not because I was unsettled about what I believed, but because I didn't like how I talked and was insecure about how I came across. I was very aware of my grammatical shortcomings as a preacher. I'm Cajun and I know how I sound! I wasn't a theological-sounding preacher and I knew that Cajun English wasn't exactly respected.

So, when God called me, I said, "Listen, You've made a mistake. I'm not going to tell anybody! I'll just keep it to myself. You can just change Your mind."

He said, "I didn't make a mistake."

"Lord, I don't know how to preach," I said.

"I know you don't know how to preach," He said, "that's why I'm calling you."

"But, God, I can't do that!"

"Do you know why I'm calling you, Jesse? If you made a mistake, you wouldn't know you made a mistake because you don't know what you're doing." That's what He told me!

"But, I don't know how to preach!" I said again. "That's good!" He said.

You see, there is no use in arguing with God. You

can't win! Obviously, He wanted me to just trust Him, to just do what He said when He said it. So, I eventually agreed and I went into the ministry. God opened up the doors for me in a miraculous way, and within six weeks, I was booked for a year—and I've been booked solidly ever since. I knew that God was leading this thing, but I still felt uncomfortable preaching.

So, in the beginning of my ministry, I mainly sang and played the piano. I'd speak for just a few minutes. It was my way of hiding behind the music, where I felt strong. But that wasn't what God wanted. God wanted me to preach the Gospel. He wanted me to stretch and do what He called me to do. And as a result, I have fallen in love with the world, just like Jesus, and I want everyone to have the opportunity to know my Friend, too.

What happened? God showed me the value of evangelism. Romans 10:14-15 says, "How then shall they call on Him in Whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in Him of Whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the Gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!" Preaching is what has to be done in order for people to be saved.

When you share Jesus, it's an act of love—you are tapping into the same love that caused Jesus to endure the cross.

God can use you, even in an area that you feel insecure about. He actually likes the fact that you can't do it all on your own because that gives Him room to work. The Great Commission isn't about your own pride or policies, it's about God and what He wants said and done. God knows what you can and cannot do. All He asks is that you believe.

Just look at what He's done through me! Back in 1976, I started out in ministry not wanting to speak, but the minute I decided to just do it, God took over. He's been running me all over this world ever since, proclaiming His Gospel as an evangelist. All I do is preach, preach, and preach—and everywhere I go, God reaches into the lives of people. I see people getting saved, healed, and changed every day, and that's

> something that only God can do. God uses me and I watch as He brings joy and faith into the room. His work is being accomplished and that is what's important.

Today, you might be looking at yourself thinking, *What can I do for God?* You can do a lot! You could lead someone to Christ today who may become the next Billy Graham. You could lay hands on someone today and see the power of God heal their body. You could support the work of the Gospel and send the Good News through the television

airwaves to a place that you'll never go.

You don't have to be a preacher to be a proclaimer of His Word. You may be in business, but God can use you in every transaction you make. You may be in the arts, but God can use you to show His amazing creativity. You may be a homemaker, but God can use you to raise your kids in the admonition of the Lord and impact a future generation. Whatever you do, God can use you.

People need to see Jesus in your life. They need to hear you proclaim Him as Lord. So, don't say "Not me!" the next time that God asks you to "Go ye." Decide today to accept the Great Commission of Jesus. Decide today to open your mouth, share your story, and be bold in proclaiming the Good News of Jesus Christ. Give God the opportunity to use you to love the world.

You Can Be a Conduit

All God is looking for are conduits—people that He can use to proclaim His thoughts, feelings, and purposes to the world. You see, it's not man's job to make policy—that's God's job. He wrote the Book; we just follow it and share the information it contains. We shouldn't guess at the truth, we should simply proclaim it. The Word of God is something that must be settled within our own heart so that we can be free to share it with others.

He's not looking for a certain "type" of person to do His work; He's looking for ALL types. We serve a multi-faceted God Who created a world that is filled with different types of people. You have something that God needs. I have something God needs. Together, we *can* reach this world for Jesus.

GOD Wants to Use You!

God is reaching out to *you*. He's longing to demonstrate His supernatural power and love in and through you. Will you receive Him in your life today? He wants you healed, delivered, prospering, and set free from anything that could be keeping you from the life of joy and purpose He has for you. If you don't know Jesus, or if you already know Him but you've fallen back for some reason or another, He wants you to come back home to Him and be restored.

Are you ready to make a change and discover the great plan God has for you? He wants to wash away your mistakes and give you a fresh start right now. All you have to do is turn to Him, open up your heart, and say this simple prayer. When you say these words and believe them with your heart, you will be born again and made right in your relationship with the Father (Romans 10:9-10). Pray with me now:

Jesus, come into my life. Forgive me of my sins. I ask You to cleanse my heart and make me a new person in You right now. I believe that You are the Son of God and that You died and rose from the dead for me.



When I reread what Jesus had spoken to us 4 1/2 months earlier, I was amazed that everything happened just like Jesse said! One of the things I realized from all of this is that God can't wait to forgive us—all we have to do is ask.

SOMEONE'S KNOCKING ON THE DOOR

The Faith-Filled Testimony of Richard Bartley:

"I Shall Live and Not Die!"

My story begins over 35 years ago when I was diagnosed with ulcerative colitis. This horrible disease caused me to have inflammation of the digestive track and excruciating stomach pain for the majority of my life. I could never eat what I wanted to eat or go where I wanted to go without worrying about when the pain would strike. A few years after my diagnosis, my symptoms got so bad that I finally decided to schedule surgery. This was no simple procedure! The doctors removed my large intestines and used part of my small intestines to create what is known as a "J-pouch." They also placed surgical mesh in my stomach to prevent me from developing hernias. Although this helped to an extent, it was considered a temporary fix. As the years went by, I continued to suffer more and more.

Last year, my condition took a turn for the worse. I decided to follow up with my doctor and let him check out what was causing these worsening symptoms. After taking a look, the doctor reported that my stomach was "in a mess!" He discovered that I had a failing, infected J-pouch along with many ulcers and legions covering the area. He recommended me to see one of the best surgeons available in order to get this "mess" under control. So, I followed his guidance and scheduled another surgery. My wife, Christine, and I asked our faith-filled friends, co-workers, and Covenant Church family to believe with us for a successful outcome. We knew that if we surrounded ourselves with people of like precious faith, we would overcome any attack of the enemy!

My surgery took place at the end of April 2023. Little did I know just how extensive and life-threatening this procedure would become. What was supposed to be a four-and-a-halfhour operation quickly turned into ten long hours. While I was on the operating table, doctors saw that the surgical mesh which was placed in my stomach during the initial surgery over 30 years ago had intertwined with my small intestines and J-pouch. This caused a much greater infection to develop. The J-pouch could have burst at any time! If that were to have happened, I would have gone septic within moments, and it would have been too late. I knew God's hand of protection was on me throughout all these years preventing this rupture from taking place. Glory to God!

After the surgery was complete, I was in a fight for my life. My condition was so serious that a nurse informed my son that I may not make it through my first night of recovery. I stayed in the Intensive Care Unit for two and a half days and can barely remember any details. Initially, I was told that this hospital stay would only be five days long...I was there for nine!

My time in the hospital was the hardest of my life, but one supernatural encounter with the Holy Spirit changed everything. I can vividly remember laying in my hospital bed and pulling back the covers to see my "new normal." When I lifted up the bed sheet, I discovered the severity of my condition. All I saw was my stomach covered in staples, stiches, a colostomy bag, and tubes attached to my abdomen. The sight of my body was upsetting, and I didn't think I could live like this. I was overcome with despair and said to myself, "I don't have to live like this." I knew the verse in Proverbs 18:21: "Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof." I was ready to speak out this scripture and ask the Lord to take me to my heavenly home because I was so sick and tired of everything I had to endure. My appetite was completely gone, and I had lost a lot of weight. I'd made up my mind that this was it. I'd lost my will to live.

So, I laid my hands across my chest and closed my eyes. Just before I opened my mouth to surrender my spirit to the Lord, I was suddenly stopped by a loud, powerful voice. I instantly knew that it was the voice of the Holy Spirit. I heard Him say the words, "DON'T SAY IT!" I opened my eyes and He repeated the command with even more authority, "DON'T SAY IT!" I quickly took my hands off of my chest and changed my mindset in an instant. Instead of asking the Lord to take my life from me, I switched my words and declared with boldness, "I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD" (Psalm 118:17).

After that precious experience with the Holy Spirit, things started to change. My attitude completely shifted, and I began to fight the enemy even harder. My countenance was lifted, because my God saved me! The Lord knew that, deep down, I wanted to live and that I had much more work to do. I obeyed His voice, changed my words, and I am here today to give God all the glory!

That powerful interaction with the Holy Spirit gave me supernatural endurance to overcome even more health attacks. Once released from the hospital, I found myself yet again in a life or death situation. I was back in the hospital with a severe infection caused from the surgery and weighing only 83 pounds, but this time I knew that I would overcome. I kept meditating on the Holy Spirit's instructions and matched my words with His will. I continued to believe and declare, "I shall LIVE and not die!"


The road to recovery took hard work and many prayers, but with the help of my family, friends, and my wife Christine, I slowly began to regain physical strength. I was determined to do what I needed in the natural in order to live and not die. I am now back to work at the ministry, serving at Covenant Church, and eating ANYTHING I want! As a matter of fact, I have gained over 40 pounds already, and I'm loving every minute of it! For the first time, I can eat all of the delicious Cajun food that I want without a care in the world. I have no more pain, and my quality of life is absolutely wonderful. It is the best it has ever been!

Christine and I would like to thank everyone for their faith-filled prayers and support. The teachings we have learned here at Jesse Duplantis Ministries taught us to KEEP the faith and proclaim what we want instead of what we have. Just remember, God will do it for you and honor what you say—all you have to do is ASK and believe!







Take the Path to the

CATHY DUPLANTIS

In South Louisiana, we have an abundance of seafood and, boy, do we know how it should be cooked! It's all about flavor and spice. One of my favorite local television commercials was from many years ago, and it began with a scene of an outdoor picnic table loaded with fresh, steaming seafood of every type you can imagine. The last time I saw the commercial, I could almost smell the seasoning through the television screen! Just as I began to lick my lips, the camera backed up slightly to reveal the back of a large man also looking at the tantalizing table loaded down with the good of our land. Just then, that man turned to look straight at me through steam-filled eyeglasses, and with a huge grin, declared, "Life is good!" Now even if you hate seafood, you know that man was talking about abundance.

Abundance has always been God's will for His children. To those who are willing and obedient, He promises that they will **eat the good** of the land (Isaiah 1:19). That is the quality of life that God offers to each of us today.

I believe that when God promised that we would eat the good of the land, He wasn't just talking about a full belly. He was talking about a full life—one that is filled with joy, peace, love, and every good thing that Heaven has to offer. We can *expect* a boundless supply of healing for the sick and salvation for the lost. We can *expect* deliverance for the captives and prosperity for the poor. This is the kind of abundant life that Jesus came to give you and me, and it is good! It's the life you were *created* to enjoy.

While most people will agree that God wants them to *be* a good person and *do* good works, many of those same people haven't realized that God also wants them to *live* the good life. The truth is that God has created all of us with that in mind.

> For we are God's [own] handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us [taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in them [**living the good life** which He prearranged and made ready for us to live]. Ephesians 2:10 (AMPC)

Isn't that amazing? God has good things that He has prearranged for you to walk in. If there seems to be a wall between you and the good life, settle the fact once and for all that God is not holding out on you. The problem is never with God. I have discovered three steps that have helped me to stay on the path to the good life. I hope they will help you, too.

Step One: Be Thankful

Being thankful is the first step in the path to the good life that God has for you. Although your life may be anything but good at this moment, you can be thankful that Jesus came to change all that. Psalm 100:4 in The Passion Translation says, "You can pass through His open gates with the password of praise. Come right into His presence with thanksgiving. Come bring your thank offering to Him and affectionately bless His beautiful name!"

Once you are thankful and acknowledge that He came to lead you out of a life of despair and into the good life, it won't be long before He will show you His path for your life. Proverbs 3:6 says, "*In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths.*"

God's Word can lead you out of lack and into abundance in every area of your life. Psalm 16:11 says, "Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in Thy presence is fulness of joy; at Thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore." Establish the fact in your heart that God is always looking to do you good.

Step Two: Walk Uprightly

This leads me to the second step in the path toward the good life, which is to walk uprightly. This simply means to walk in integrity and truth. When you are determined to always do what is right and always do it right, the byproduct of that is the good life.


Jesus said, "But seek (aim at and strive after) first of all His kingdom and His righteousness (His way of doing and being right), and then all these things taken together will be given you besides" (Matthew 6:33 AMPC).

When your life is focused on God's way of doing things and walking uprightly, Jesus promised that you would have all you need to eat, drink, and wear. However, having these life essentials is just the beginning of the good life that God has in mind for you. You can have hope for a successful life for yourself and your family. You were created by God, and through Christ Jesus you can live the good life. Although you may not be walking in every facet of it right now, it is available to *every* believer, including you.

Step Three: Sow Your Seed

The third step on the path that will lead you into this good life must begin with a seed offering. Once your heart has been changed and things do not control you, you will need to recognize that God's plan to move you out of lack will always begin by giving to God.

It is vitally important that we are obedient when God reveals what we are to do with the seed that He gives to us. We bind His ability to meet our needs



when we do not yield to the spirit of giving. The principles that God established in His Word will guide us through the desert and bring us to the land of milk and honey. We serve a God that specializes in making a way where there is no way.

Second Corinthians 9:10-11 (AMPC) says: "And [God] Who provides seed for the sower and bread for eating will also provide and multiply your [resources for] sowing and increase the fruits of your righteousness [which manifests itself in active goodness, kindness and charity]. Thus you will be enriched in all things and in every way, so that you can be generous, and [your generosity as it is] administered by us will bring forth thanksgiving to God."

If you want to reap, you must sow. And like we just read, the good news is that God will provide seed to the sower. Once you thankfully offer back to God what is rightfully His, you are actually investing in your own prosperity. God is able to put His kingdom principle of sowing *and* reaping to work for you. Your obedience will result in blessing. Paul made this truth clear to the Galatians when he said:

Let him that is taught in the word communicate unto him that teacheth in all **good things**.

Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.

And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

As we have therefore opportunity, let us **do good** unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith. Galatians 6:6-10

That word *communicate* translates "contribute" in the Amplified Bible versions. Paul was teaching them the principle that reaping is always the result of sowing into good soil. This truth is reinforced in the book of Philippians, which says:

> Always in every prayer of mine for you all making request with joy, For your **fellowship** in the Gospel from the first day until now; Being confident of this very thing, that He which hath begun a **good work** in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ.

Philippians 1:4-6

The people in the church at Philippi were faithful Partners to the apostle Paul. The Amplified Bible, Classic Edition translates the word *fellowship* in verse five to mean "(your sympathetic cooperation and contributions and partnership)." They had been instrumental in advancing the Gospel, and Paul wanted them to know that they were destined for good fruit to abound to their heavenly account. They could expect God to supply all of their needs. Later in this same book, Paul told the Philippians: Psalm 16:11 says, "Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in Thy presence is fulness of joy: at Thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore."

> Now ye Philippians know also, that in the beginning of the Gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, no church communicated with me as concerning giving and receiving, but ye only.

For even in Thessalonica ye sent once and again unto my necessity.

Not because I desire a gift: but I desire fruit that may abound to your account.

But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things which were sent from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God.

But my **God shall supply all your need** according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:15-19

Paul knew the principle: If you give, you shall receive. God's way of supplying all your need was revealed by Jesus in Luke 6:38. There, He promised: "Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again." It is Christ's desire to give you a life that is so full, it is literally running over and spilling onto others.

God sent His Son, Jesus, to bring this message to the world. In fact, in His first sermon, Jesus boldly preached about *"the accepted and acceptable year of the*

Lord [the day when salvation and the free favors of God profusely abound]" (Luke 4:19 AMPC).

We know that God's Word cannot change, and it will not return to Him void. It will accomplish that which He sent it to do. God *will* have a generation that will receive His promise and welcome this day "*when salvation and the free favors of God profusely abound.*"

That word *profusely* means "to radiate with abundance; plentifully, abundantly, extravagantly, freely." Now that ought to make you shout! Those are the kind of *"free favors*" our God has prepared for His children and it is *this* kind of blessed life that you were created to live! This is not just a suggestion from your Creator; it is His command, which you'll see in the following passage:

It is Christ's desire to give you a life that is so full, it is literally running over and spilling onto others.

If you will listen diligently to the voice of the Lord your God, being watchful to do all His commandments which I command you this day, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. And all these blessings shall come

upon you and overtake you if you heed the voice of the Lord your God.

Blessed shall you be in the city and blessed shall you be in the field.

Blessed shall be the fruit of your body and the fruit of your ground and the fruit of your beasts, the increase of your cattle and the young of your flock.

Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading trough.

Blessed shall you be when you come in and blessed shall you be when you go out.

The Lord shall cause your enemies who rise up against you to be defeated before your face; they shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways.

The Lord shall command the blessing upon you in your storehouse and in all that you undertake. And He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God gives you.

The Lord will establish you as a people holy to Himself, as He has sworn to you, if you keep the commandments of the Lord your God and walk in His ways.

And all people of the earth shall see that you are called by the name [and in the presence of] the Lord, and they shall be afraid of you.

And the Lord shall make you have a surplus of prosperity, through the fruit of your body, of your livestock, and of your ground, in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers to give you.

The Lord shall open to you His good treasury, the heavens, to give the rain of your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hands; and you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow.

And the Lord shall make you the head, and not the tail; and you shall be above only, and you shall not be beneath, if you heed the commandments of the Lord your God which I command you this day and are watchful to do them.

Deuteronomy 28:1-13 (AMPC)

Realize today that God has empowered *you* to prosper spiritually, physically, and financially. He wants you to be the head and not the tail, above and not beneath. You were created to be blessed coming in and blessed going out. You *are* the blessed of the Lord. Take the path to the good life and experience success today!
