



What do you do when a storm blows your way? Whether the storm is a raging wave, a powerful wind, a destructive relationship, a financial storm, or even a life-threatening disease, it has one purpose: to blow you off your faith walk—to whip you, and make you frightened and weary until you just give up.

Give up what? Your walk with God. Your health. Your prosperity. Your family. Your vision. More than anything else, the storm is designed to make you give up your faith and rob you of God's blessings.

God never said we should hunker down and hide from the storm. We're told to go into the world, to press on toward the mark of our high calling in Jesus Christ. There isn't a clause for fair-weather followers.

Paul faced storms. Peter faced storms. John faced storms. Even Jesus faced storms. As surely as the sun rises in the east, storms of adversity arise in life. How will you continue your faith walk when the winds of hell blow against you? (Because you must continue.)

You'll find the answer in the fourth chapter of Mark.

And the same day, when the even was come, He saith unto them, Let us pass over unto the other side.

And when they had sent away the multitude, they took Him even as He was in the ship. And there were also with Him other little ships.

And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full.

And He was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake Him, and say unto Him, Master, carest Thou not that we perish?

And He arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

And He said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? How is it that ye have no faith?

And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey Him?

Mark 4:35-41

The first thing I want you to notice is that Jesus made a simple request to His disciples. He said, "Look, I'm tired. I've been preaching all day and I want to catch a few winks. I'm going to take a nap. You sail the ship to the other side of the lake."

But there arose a great storm. Jesus hadn't mentioned anything about a storm. "Well, Brother Jesse, do you think He even knew the storm was coming?"

Jesus is the Son of God! God always knows there are storms coming; it's the rest of us that are caught by surprise.

Notice this wasn't just a little storm. The Bible described it as a great storm. The waves beat against the ship until it filled with water. Jesus was so tired that He slept through it. Finally, the disciples woke Him and said, "Hey! Don't You care that we're about to die?"

When Jesus woke up, the boat had filled with water and His disciples were terrified. Yet Jesus dealt directly with the problem. He didn't rebuke the disciples (He saved that for later). He didn't rebuke the boat. He didn't even rebuke the devil. The wind was the problem. He rebuked the wind and spoke to the sea.

"Peace, be still." That's all. Three words. But not just any words, He spoke three faith-filled words.

The Bible says that the wind ceased and there was a great calm. At least the weather was calm! Then Jesus turned to His disciples and said, "Why are ye so fearful?" How is it that ye have no faith?"

Wouldn't you hate to hear those words from Jesus? I would. I know for certain that when you're facing a storm of hurricane proportions, you want to call on someone who isn't afraid and is in control.

When I was eighteen years old, Hurricane Camille hit Biloxi, Mississippi like an eraser. It wiped out homes in every direction. Just before it arrived, I was one hundred forty miles out in the Gulf of Mexico on a drilling rig. The wind was too fierce for the helicopter to fly out and pick us up.

Finally, they sent us a boat. It took fourteen hours for the boat to reach us. We boarded and started the trip back against twenty-foot waves. It was one of those trips where you find out what you've eaten for the past four years.

One wave blew out the windows in the front of the boat and knocked the Captain unconscious. We were still one hundred miles from shore with almost three feet of water inside the boat.

What do you do in a situation like that? Pray. Everybody prays. Everybody comes together in the unity of the faith. Nobody talks against anyone else. If you took an offering, you'd get it all.

I wasn't saved at the time. The first thing I thought about was Mama. "It's your tough luck you were born to me," she said so many times. "You'll get saved whether you like it or not!"

I thought, "Right now would be a good time, Mama. I'd like that. Really!"

Refuse the Opportunity to Fail

When you're a Christian, the storms in life may blow, but your faith walk continues. Every storm offers you opportunities. The first opportunity it offers is failure. Don't take it!

I faced a storm when I first started dating Cathy. "Do you want to go skating, Jesse?"

Of course I wanted to take her skating, but I had a couple of problems. First, I didn't know how to skate. Second, I didn't have very good balance. But I really wanted to be cool, so I said, "Sure, I'll take you."

It was one of those old skating rinks with the wooden floor and a big Masonite blade fan in the corner. I put on those skates and tried to pull myself around the rink by the rail. "You don't know how to skate, do you?" Cathy asked.

"No, but I'll learn." About that time, some guy blew a whistle in my ear. "Come on, move! Get your hand off the rail!"

I took my hand off the rail... Wham! I hit the floor.

The storm was blowing. Cathy skated by and said, "Do you want me to help you?"

"No, I can do it," I answered, pulling myself up by the rail, "but how do you stop?"

"Put your foot forward and lean on that little rubber stopper." I started moving and then leaned on both stoppers at the same time.

Wham! I hit the floor hard.

The storm was blowing. Kids were skating by and laughing. Finally, I got going, but I didn't know how to turn. Some kid pushed me and I headed straight for the fan, screaming the whole way. I hit the fan-rail with such force, it broke. I landed inside the fan and somehow managed to grab the blades.

Tweet! Tweet! Tweet! The whistle guy blasted at me and yelled, "Turn loose of the blades!"

"No!" I screamed. "That thing will eat my lunch if I turn loose!" By then, blue smoke poured out from the fan motor. It made an awful sound.

I'd burned up the motor.

They had to shut down the skating rink to get me out of the fan. The storm was blowing. I had cuts on my hands from holding those blades. Everyone kept staring at me, saying, "You burned up the fan!"

That storm gave me a great opportunity to fail, but I refused to take it. I got up and dusted myself off. "Come on," Cathy said, "give me your hand." I put my hand in hers and let her guide me. After a while, I was gliding.

When you face storms in your faith walk, don't take

the opportunity to fail and never try to make it through alone. Reach out to the Holy Spirit. He'll take your hand and lead you through to safety.

Refuse the Opportunity to Sin

The second opportunity that storms offer is the opportunity to sin. The devil will try to convince you that the trouble you're facing excuses sin. Don't fall for it.



That's what happened to three Hebrew boys. Their names were Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego. Those names are hard to remember, so I made up my own. I call them My-shack, Your-shack, and A-bungalo.

All they wanted to do was serve God, but the devil wanted them to sin. They were given the opportunity to bow down and worship King Nebuchadnezzar or be thrown into a fiery furnace. The storm was blowing!

Don't you know the devil worked overtime to remind them of all they had to live for? If faced with the same situation, a lot of folks would say, "Hey, don't get nuts with this thing. Bow now, and repent later!"

Those Hebrew boys didn't fall for it. The storm was blowing hard, but they refused the opportunity to sin. It made old Nebber so mad, he heated the furnace seven times hotter. Then he said, "I'm gonna' watch 'em burn."

He didn't figure on Jesus being there. That's where a lot of Christians miss it—Jesus is always in the fire. He's always in the middle of the storm with you ready to lead you to safety.

They came out of that furnace without even the smell of smoke on them.

It was a bad day for the devil.

Refuse the Opportunity to Lie

The third thing that storms offer you is the opportunity to lie. Don't do it. Sometimes, when the wind is blowing hard, lying seems like an easy way out. I haven't faced many fiery furnaces, but I've been in situations where I was mighty tempted to lie.

I very seldom visit people's homes, but many years ago I was up in the northern part of the country and a lady invited

me over for homemade gumbo. Now, good gumbo is an art, and it is a blessing to me, so I decided to go. I could hardly wait.

We all sat down at the table and that dear woman gave me the biggest bowl she could find. I held my spoon while we prayed over the food. Then I took a big mouthful of gumbo.

It was awful! I mean, it was so bad a dog would refuse it. I didn't even know if I could swallow. Everyone was looking at me intently. Her husband was sitting there holding his spoon, waiting on my reaction. Her nine-year-old son held his spoon and waited, too. Finally the woman said, "Brother Jesse, is it good? Do you like it?"

The storm was blowing. I didn't know what to do. I didn't want to hurt the lady's feelings. I wanted to lie like a dog and say, "Oh, it's wonderful!" But I didn't want to go to hell over a bowl of gumbo either.

I thought real fast, and decided to ask God. The Lord spoke up on the inside of me and said, "Tell them the truth."

That's easy for You to say, I thought, trying to swallow that gumbo. The woman asked again, "Well, Brother Jesse, do you like it?"

"Ma'am," I said, "this is trash."

Her husband threw his spoon down. "I know you're a man of God!" he said. "I know you are!"

I was so shocked, I couldn't say a word. "We've had preachers come over here and eat this trash. But you're the only man that told the truth. This stuff is no good."

"Well, Honey," his wife said, "you never told me it was bad."

"I didn't want to hurt your feelings," he said, "so I prayed for a prophet of God to come tell you the truth."

When the storms are blowing, tell the truth.

I've learned something over the years. Most people don't miss God because the devil tripped them up—most people miss God because they get bone-weary tired of doing good. We're warned in Galatians 6:9, "And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not."

Are you standing in faith for your husband's salvation? Don't get weary about it. I don't care how long you've stood; it's his rotten luck he married you. Greater is He that is in you (1 John 4:4)! The Bible says you'll reap if you faint not.

Do you know what happens to a lot of people? They believe God...and believe God...and believe God...and when their prayers are finally, totally, and completely answered, they miss it. How? They passed out on the floor. They got weary and gave up.

If Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego had gotten weary of well doing, they would have missed out on one of the greatest miracles recorded in the Bible.

The storms may blow, but don't grow weary. Why? Because in due season, we shall reap if we faint not.

If you want to reap your harvest, don't grow weary! The faith walk continues.

Watch What You Hear

So, how do you continue the faith walk in the midst of the storm? There are two things that you can do that will bring you through safely.

The first step is to watch what you hear. It's interesting to note that Jesus cautioned the disciples about this before He got in the boat. Look back at Mark 4:24:

And He said unto them, Take heed what ye hear: with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given.

Do you want more? Second Chronicles 20:20 says, "... Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe His prophets, so shall ye prosper."

Do you want to be established even when the winds are blowing? Believe in the Lord. Do you want to prosper even in storms of adversity? Believe His prophets.

The world will tell you that you shouldn't do that. But let me warn you: If you go the world's way, you'll participate in recession and depression. Believe God's prophets, and you'll prosper in the midst of those things.

A man accused me once, "I suppose you believe the whole Bible?"

Guilty as charged. I believe it from Genesis to the maps.

Speak the Word

The second and most crucial step is to speak the Word of God. Many mornings I get up and talk to myself. "Jesse, come here. Listen, Jesse, you're a chosen generation. Boy, you're a royal priesthood. You don't have bayou water flowing through your veins; you've got the Covenant Blood of God flowing through you!"

I take the Word of God and speak it to myself in the first person. "I am abounding in the work of the Lord. For I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep that which I've committed to Him against that day."

"Those scriptures are nice, Brother Jesse, but I'm facing a real storm!"

So were the disciples in that boat, and Jesus called them men with no faith.

One of the worst storms I remember happened when I was a little boy. We were attending church at the Venice Full Gospel Temple. It was a little shotgun-style white church with about 35 members gathered there that night. We'd had real bad weather all evening, but suddenly, during the service, it sounded like a thousand trains were about to meet in that little building.

Someone looked out the door and saw that a tornado was coming through the woods, heading directly toward us. "Get on the floor!"

People dropped to the floor and scrambled to get under furniture. The Pastor, my daddy, and a few others went outside. I followed them out, and as soon as I stepped through the door, the wind blew me into the yard. I heard Daddy yell, and the next thing I knew he was holding me by my pants while the wind blew me off the ground. I felt my face sting from the pricks of hundreds of bugs hitting me.

I could see the tornado coming. There was no running away from it. It looked like it was going to blow that church apart. I saw trees being ripped up like grass in the wind.

I was waiting for my daddy and the other men and women to do something. They did: They started talking to that storm.

I thought, We're dead!

"In the name of Jesus..." they declared. The tornado kept getting closer, but they kept talking to it. I could barely hear what they said because of the force of the wind. Finally, they were just hollering Jesus' name.

I'll never forget what I saw next: That storm split in half. Right in the middle where the tornado had been, I saw clear sky. Half of the storm went left, and half of the storm went right. It never touched us.

The whole congregation started shouting, dancing, and praising God—all except for me. I just stood there with my mouth open. All I could say was, "Wow!" But one thought was forever burned into my mind that night: We beat up a tornado with the name of Jesus!

What made those people stand against odds that no natural force could conquer? Jesus was with them. They didn't have time to call a prayer vigil or form a committee. They just went out there and spoke faith-filled words to the storm.

Don't give up on your healing! Don't give up on the salvation of your loved ones! Don't give up on your harvest! Don't

give up on your vision!



Testimony

Hello, Jesse and Cathy! I enjoy viewing your programs on YouTube, such as your Sunday Services, Boardroom Chats, Faith the Facts, and Glorious Living with Cathy. I have borrowed one of Jesse's taglines, "Jesus, You got mail!" as I stand on the Word in Philippians 4:6-7 not only for my bills, but for whatever shows up in my mailbox or on my doorstep. Back in 2021, I was a cashier suffering from the aftermath of the pandemic: low wages, inadequate paycheck, and a court-ordered eviction from my apartment. My daughter and I began living at a hotel. The payments drained my savings and eventually rendered my paycheck useless. Even though I was and had been a faithful tither for four and a half years, my home church, without explanation or justification, turned me down when I'd asked for help. I was deeply heartbroken. I became depressed, my health plummeted, and I began to dislike the church. But I never blamed God.

In 2022, we came dangerously close to living outdoors. Much like my savings, resources from family, friends, and their families had dried up. In desperation, I reached out to your ministry for help. We are so very thankful for your love, encouragement, and generosity. With your help, we were able to remain off the streets until two slots opened up at the local shelter. Your broadcasts helped me re-learn what I already knew: that as a Christian, I am responsible for applying the Word of God to my life. I must choose to live in victory, without doubt, fear, or excuses. So, I repented and surrendered my will unto the Lord. It wasn't easy for me to let go of the pain and forgive the church, but God said that I had to. It wasn't easy for me to remain and not go join another church, but God said to stay where He put me. It wasn't easy for me to continue paying tithes to the church, but God had me re-read Malachi 3:10-11. He reminded me that paying the tithe is a commandment to honor Him, not that church. He and He alone is the one true God with the power to open the windows of Heaven to enhance everything that touches my life, not that church.







Jesus mastered every disastrous situation that He encountered. He spoke peace to raging seas, commanded blind eyes to see, and crippled legs to walk. The dead were raised, multitudes were fed, and devils were cast out. Even when an angry crowd in Nazareth drove Him out of town and tried to hurl Him over a cliff, Jesus just passed through them and went on to the next town to preach the Gospel. No plan of the devil could stop His purpose that was established before the foundation of the world. First John 3:8 says, "... For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil."

Jesus came to remove every burden and destroy every yoke of bondage placed on mankind by the devil. His precious blood redeemed us from the curse of the law and restored God's blessing to those that call upon Him in faith. First John 4:4 & 5:4 say, "Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world... For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith."

When we are born again by the blood of Jesus, He gave us the ability to live gloriously. He gave us world-overcoming faith to be victorious over sin, sickness, poverty and every evil work the devil can produce. Jesus said, "I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have [perfect] peace and confidence. In the world you have tribulation and trials and distress

and frustration; but be of good cheer [take courage; be confident, certain, undaunted]! For I have overcome the world. [I have deprived it of power to harm you and have conquered it for you]" (John 16:33 AMPC).

Cheerful, courageous faith in Jesus always conquers the distress and frustration of this world. Once you know that Jesus has deprived the world of power to harm you, perfect peace and confidence will rule your heart and mind. You can take courage. You can remain confident in the finished work of Jesus. Go ahead, stir yourself up in the Holy Ghost and be gloriously cheerful! Romans 8:37 says, "Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him that loved us." You are more than a conqueror because Jesus has overcome the world and given you the victory.

You Have Superhuman Power

Did you know that you are superhuman? It's the truth! Jesus Christ has made it possible for every bornagain believer to be anointed with the power of the Holy Ghost to destroy the works of the devil and be victorious in every area of life. You are not limited to the natural, you are supernatural! When you walk with God, you are powerfully strong, indestructible, and very dangerous to the enemy.

It's time for us to get a true picture of ourselves and forget about the lie that the devil would like for us to see. He is continually trying to convince us that we are powerless and subject to his every whim. But if you are

a born-again believer, nothing could be further from the truth.

Philippians 4:13 (AMPC) says, "I have strength for all things in Christ Who empowers me [I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him Who infuses inner strength into me; I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency." You are mighty in Jesus! The devil's

As a born-again child of God, you have superhuman power to master any disaster. The transforming power of the Word of God is more effective than Superman's phone booth or Wonder Woman's spin. You may look like mild mannered Clark Kent on the outside, but the anointing can transform you into a Superman or Superwoman of God.

Think about it. You may be in the middle of the grocery store or at a ball game when you notice someone that needs the power of God applied to their life. You know that Christ has empowered you to be ready *for anything* and equal *to anything* that comes your way. Suddenly, you swing into action and a disastrous situation is mastered by a born-again child of God. He places His "Super" on your "natural" and the works of the devil are destroyed once again. Now that is what glorious living is all about!

The church at Thessalonica experienced the superhuman power of God's Word at work. The apostle Paul wrote, "And we also [especially] thank God continually for this, that when you received the message of God [which you heard] from us, you welcomed it not as

the word of [mere] men, but as it truly is, the Word of God, which is effectually at work in you who believe [exercising its superhuman power in those who adhere to and trust in and rely on it]" (1 Thessalonians 2:13 AMPC).

Paul also wrote to the Colossians about the superhuman energy given to him by God for the work of the ministry. "For this I labor [unto weariness], striving with all the superhuman energy which He so mightily enkindles and works within me" (Colossians 1:29 AMPC).

Paul had a huge assignment, but God never expected him to accomplish it in his own natural strength. All the superhuman energy needed to get the job done was mightily at work in Paul's life. He was empowered by God to reach his generation with the wonderful Gospel of Jesus Christ.

A Disaster Perceived & Prevented

Not everyone liked the message that the apostle Paul was preaching to the world. He had enemies. There was that thorn in the flesh; a messenger of Satan sent to buffet or harass him. Paul's life was definitely a fight of faith every step of the way. But it was a good fight. In Philippians 1:20-26 (NLT), he wrote:

For I fully expect and hope that I will never be ashamed, but that I will continue to be bold for Christ, as I have been in the past. And I trust that my life will bring honor to Christ, whether I live or die.

For to me, living means living for Christ, and dying is even better.

But if I live, I can do more fruitful work for Christ. So I really don't know which is better.

I'm torn between two desires: I long to go and be with Christ, which would be far better for me.

But for your sakes, it is better that I continue to live.

Knowing this, I am convinced that I will remain alive so I can continue to help all of you grow and experience the joy of your faith.

And when I come to you again, you will have even more reason to take pride in Christ Jesus because of what he is doing through me.

Although the devil tried to destroy his life on many occasions, Paul stayed as long as he wanted to. Once Paul completed the work commissioned by Jesus, he left this world to be with Christ in Heaven.

One particularly unforgettable story from the life of Paul happened while he was a prisoner aboard a ship headed for Rome. In Acts 27:10 (AMPC), Paul warned and advised the crew:

Saying, Sirs, I perceive [after careful observation] that this voyage will be attended with disaster and much heavy loss, not only of the cargo and the ship but of our lives also.

Paul did not say that God sent him a warning. He just perceived after carefully looking at things in the natural, that it would be disastrous to take that voyage. However, no one paid attention to what Paul said and continued on their journey.

It wasn't very long before a horrendous storm, like a typhoon, came bursting on the ship. In verses 18-20, Paul goes on to tell us,

As we were being dangerously tossed about by the violence of the storm, the next day they began to throw the freight overboard;

And the third day they threw out with their own hands the ship's equipment (the tackle and the furniture).

And when neither sun nor stars were visible for many days and no small tempest kept raging about us, all hope of our being saved was finally abandoned.

That is when Paul stood up with a word from God for all those on board (verses 21-25):

...Men, you should have listened to me, and should not have put to sea from Crete and brought on this disaster and harm and misery and loss.

But [even] now I beg you to be in good spirits and take heart, for there will be no loss of life among you but only of the ship. For this [very] night there stood by my side an angel of the God to Whom I belong and Whom I serve and worship,
And he said, Do not be frightened,
Paul! It is necessary for you to stand before Caesar; and behold, God has given you all those who are sailing with you.
So keep up your courage, men, for I have faith (complete confidence) in God that it will be exactly as it was told me.

The decision to take that voyage was not Paul's. But, because he was a prisoner, he had to go where he was told. Many times, the bad decisions of others affect the course of our lives. That is why it is so vital that we obey God's commands to pray for those in government that have authority over us. Their righteous, godly choices make it easier for us to all lead a quiet and undisturbed life (1 Timothy 2:1-2).

Even though that ship was headed straight toward disaster, Paul knew how to turn things around with his faith. Although everyone else on board had given up all hope of survival, Paul had God's Word that all 276 lives would be saved if they stayed with the ship. The storm was still not over, but Paul's faith-filled words restored their hope and brought courage to their hearts.

You can take refuge in God's Word and refuse to allow your heart to be overwhelmed with fear and worry.

A Refuge in Times of Trouble

In the same way, God will never leave you or forsake you, especially in those times of difficulty and trouble. Psalm 9:9 (AMPC) says, "The Lord also will be a refuge and a high tower for the oppressed, a refuge and a

stronghold in times of trouble (high cost, destitution, and desperation)." You can take refuge in God's Word and refuse to allow your heart to be overwhelmed with fear and worry. First Peter 5:7-9 (AMPC) says,

Casting the whole of your care [all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares for you affectionately and cares about you watchfully.

Be well balanced (temperate, sober of mind), be vigilant and cautious at all times; for that enemy of yours, the devil, roams around like a lion roaring [in fierce hunger], seeking someone to seize upon and devour.

Withstand him; be firm in faith [against his onset—rooted, established, strong, immovable, and determined], knowing that the same (identical) sufferings are appointed to your brotherhood (the whole body of Christians) throughout the world.

I don't know why people are so surprised when the devil attacks. That's what he does for a living. The devil is not doing anything strange or new. He's still a destroyer. First Peter 4:12 says, "Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you." Fiery trials are designed by the devil to shock and awe you into believing his lies. Instead of giving into his tactics, you can turn the tables on the devil by worrying his worry, aggravating his aggravation, and troubling his trouble.

James 4:7 says, "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you." Once you learn how to withstand him firmly in faith, his days of stealing, killing, and destroying are over. He is destined to lose and you are anointed to win. Jesus has made you more than a conqueror and deprived the world of its power to harm you. You can master any disaster and live a glorious life!


