

ately, it seems somebody is always asking me, "Why are you always working?" They have no concept of why I wouldn't want to retire. The truth is that my activity is the result of divine illumination. I'm busy because I'm Spirit-led! The light of the Holy Spirit within me empowers me to continue preaching and giving out what I've learned to others all around the world. It's His fire that keeps giving me the desire and the strength to keep riding the rails of this vision.

I don't have time for darkness. My light stays on 24/7! I've got an eternal flame, and He's called the Holy Spirit. I will never stop preaching this Gospel. Whether Jesus comes to get me or I go to get Him, I'm going to keep on moving forward with that commission. Jesus gave me His vision to reach people with the Gospel—after all, that's just what happens when the Holy Spirit fires you up! If you allow Him, the Holy Spirit will fire you up and keep you moving through all the phases of your life, too.

Like a Locomotive, We Were Designed to MOVE

The fire that the Holy Ghost brings is why people love revival. You could say that revival meetings are like a locomotive train flying down the track. People love it and hop on board to experience the ride of *moving* with God

Almighty. It's great! But have you ever seen a train that's just sitting in the grass with weeds growing around it? It's out of place, right? Why? Because sitting and rusting in a field is not what it was designed to do. Without fire, there's no movement! And the longer that locomotive sits in a field, the more the elements around it wear it down. Are you getting the analogy?

It's a whole lot easier to give God a job when you're tuning into the Holy Spirit because He's going to fire you up. It's easier to stay on track because He's going to lead and guide you in all truth. We aren't meant to lead a stagnant life. Like a locomotive, we were designed by God to move—to be on track, going somewhere to deliver something to someone. Life isn't meaningful if it's all about the lusts of the flesh and just me-me-me. We are all a part of God's plan to reach this world with the message of redemption through Jesus Christ. We have all been given faith and we're supposed to use it. We're not supposed to live a rusted-out life with no movement.

A locomotive train can't move unless it's transforming its energy into *fire*. You must allow the Holy Ghost to fire you up, too, if you want to move forward in God's good plan for your life. Remember that He's the fire-starter, but we must draw close to Him and be close enough to catch His flame. That's when giving God a job becomes easy—because when you're working with God like that, it's easy

to answer "NO" to the question, "Is any thing too hard for the LORD?" The Holy Spirit helps you to do it—and do it with boldness and power!

If *Jesus* Thought So Highly of the Holy Spirit, Why Don't We?

So many Christians think, "Oh, if only Jesus were here in the flesh with me!" Many think they'd be a better Christian and live with more power if He were. If you think that, I've got news for you: Jesus doesn't agree! Jesus told His disciples that it was to their *advantage* that He go away.

"But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor—Counselor, Strengthener, Standby) will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him (the Holy Spirit) to you [to be in close fellowship with you]" (John 16:7 AMP). The King James uses the phrase "it is expedient for you," and other translations use phrases like, "it is for your benefit," "it is better for you," and "it is for your good" that Jesus go away because if He didn't, the Holy Spirit wouldn't come. Now, if Jesus thought that highly of the Holy Spirit, why don't we?

Never discount the Holy Spirit. If you believe in God, believe in the Holy Spirit. If you believe in Jesus, believe in the Holy Spirit. Remember that this same Holy Spirit is the One Who helped bring Jesus into the world at the immaculate conception. This same Holy Spirit is the One that came down and rested on Jesus after His baptism, when everyone there heard the Father's voice from Heaven saying, "This is My beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased" (Matthew 3:17).

The same Holy Spirit that Jesus was telling the disciples would be sent after He ascended is the same Holy Spirit Who anointed Jesus with *power* for His earthly ministry. Luke 4:14-21 tells that it was right after being tempted by the devil that Jesus returned to Galilee in "the power of the Spirit," and this is when His fame begins to rise. Jesus really had people talking and even questioning, "Is not this Joseph's son?" (Luke 4:22). Why was He garnering such attention? Power! Jesus spoke with power and authority, which are hallmarks of the Holy Spirit.

It's during this time, right after resisting the devil and returning in the power of the Holy Spirit, that Jesus goes to the synagogue on the sabbath, opens the book to do a reading, and shocks everybody in the room by quoting a verse everyone knew referred to the Messiah they'd been praying to come.

And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of Him through all the region round about. And He taught in their synagogues, being glorified of all.

And He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up: and, as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.

And there was delivered unto Him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written,

The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He hath anointed Me to preach the Gospel to the poor; He hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

To preach the acceptable year of the Lord. And He closed the book, and He gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on Him.

And He began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.

Luke 4:14-21

You have been given so much as a believer! You have been given access to "the mind of Christ" (1 Corinthians 2:16), "the tongue of the learned" (Isaiah 50:4), and "the Spirit of Truth" (John 14:17)—all of which are part of God's method of helping you in life through Who? The Holy Spirit. The same Holy Spirit that empowered Jesus to proclaim His fulfilment of prophecy.

So, why don't people value the Holy Spirit? They value the Father. They value the Son. But they think of the Holy Spirit as some vague and mysterious expression of God. No. Wrong. The Holy Spirit is 1/3 of the Holy Trinity of God Almighty—He is worthy of respect because He is just as divine as Jesus. Just by using the words "another Comforter" in John 14:16 to describe the Holy Spirit, Jesus was revealing the personage of the Holy Spirit. He was letting us know that the Holy Spirit is a distinct and different spiritual part of God—just as distinct as the Father and the Son.

Now, the disciples had no understanding yet of what being baptized in the Holy Ghost really meant. So, I imagine that when He told them that it was in their best interest that He leave—because the Father would then send the Holy Spirit—they probably had a problem thinking that anybody could be "better for them" than Jesus in the flesh. Yet that is exactly what Jesus said.

The Last Words Jesus Spoke Were About the Baptism of the Holy Spirit

The last words Jesus spoke before His death on the cross were *not* the last words He spoke to His disciples. Christ's last words were spoken *after* He died and rose again, and they were about the baptism of the Holy Ghost.

You see, Jesus began to spontaneously appear to the early Church after He rose from the dead. For forty days in supernatural visitations, Jesus spoke to them about "things pertaining to the kingdom of God" (Acts 1:3). But on the day He ascended, He gave them a command to "not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father" (Acts 1:4). Jesus told them, "For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence" (Acts 1:5) Now, since He had been talking so much about the kingdom of God in the last forty days, they thought maybe He was going to restore the kingdom of Israel. Their minds were stuck on an earthly kingdom, but Jesus shut them down. He told them it wasn't for them to know that, but only the Father, and He went right back to talking about the Holy Spirit. His last words were these:

But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

And right after He gave them that prophecy, Jesus was taken up. They watched Him ascend above the earth

and go up, disappearing into a cloud. They couldn't take their eyes off the sky. That's when two men standing beside them, dressed in all white, said, "Why stand ye gazing up into Heaven? This same Jesus, which is taken up from you into Heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen Him go into Heaven" (Acts 1:11).

But just as it wasn't their destiny to see the earthly kingdom of Israel restored, it also wasn't going to be in their destiny to see the return of Jesus in their lifetime here on earth. Their part in God's redemptive plan was to start spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ and start establishing the kingdom of God—which would be a *spiritual* kingdom that was to start in Jerusalem, and then be pushed to the uttermost parts of the earth. This was a big job, and to even start doing it, they would need some real *power*. They'd need some serious *help*. They'd need to receive the baptism of the *Holy Ghost*. But first, they had to obey—they had to stay where Jesus told them to and wait!

The Day the Power Came

Sometimes we want things instantly, and sometimes God's power is manifested in us instantly. And sometimes we need to get into position to receive by being obedient to the Lord and waiting. It's through faith and patience that we receive the promises of God (Hebrews 6:12).

The Holy Spirit could have come down the moment Jesus went up—but He came at an appointed time, the right time, to create the most effect and reach the most people. So, although the disciples, Mary, and Jesus' brothers didn't really know yet what it meant to be "baptized with the Holy Ghost," they did know how to obey the Lord. So, they stayed in Jerusalem and "continued with one accord in prayer and supplication," according to Acts 1:14. They weren't fighting. They weren't vying for position. They were both spiritually and practically in agreement with one another. They were praying and presenting to God what was on their heart, waiting to receive what Jesus had promised. Ten days passed from the time Jesus ascended until the Holy Spirit came down, and they remained exactly like Jesus had instructed them. They didn't give up. They continued.

When we give God a job, when time is moving by and we aren't seeing anything happen yet, it's easy to let our natural mind tell us, "It's never going to happen" or "You're wasting time with that faith stuff." But to get the promises of God, we must *continue*. We can't get off the path and still get where we need to go. We can't give up and expect to receive. We've got to keep the faith! We must *continue* with one accord in prayer and supplication, keeping our heart open and ready to receive at any time, and we must

stay in the unity of the faith. With childlike faith, we must focus on the promise and forget about the time.

Keeping our heart clean is also vital. To keep ourselves from losing out on what we want from the Lord, we must keep ourselves from veering off into unforgiveness or disharmony with others. A lot of people point to unbelief alone as a hindrance to prayer, but unforgiveness is a major hindrance to our prayers, too. Strife and unforgiveness can stall your progress because they affect your spirit—and you must live in congruence with your spirit. If you pray one thing but have unforgiveness in your heart, you will be in inner conflict—even if the conflict you had with others was forty years ago! So, always strive to keep your heart free of that junk. Let people go and let God deal with them. Keep your heart clean. You've got too many promises to see fulfilled to be shut down over holding on to what *they* have done.

The day the Power came down, people from all over had come to Jerusalem to celebrate Pentecost—the annual festival that celebrated the first buds of the harvest. By law, all Jewish men had to be there, and so the city was filled with people who'd traveled from far distances. Different languages were being spoken throughout the city. Meanwhile, Peter, James, John, Andrew, Philip, Thomas, Bartholomew, Matthew, Simon, and James the son of Alphaeus and his own son, were gathered in the Upper Room in Jerusalem. Many women, along with Mary, the mother of Jesus, and His brothers were there, too. Suddenly, a deafening sound from Heaven got all of their attention...including the attention of the people who were all over the city. The Holy Spirit had come, and with Him came the power and the ability to witness in languages they did not know how to speak.

And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.

Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language.

And they were all amazed and

marvelled, saying one to another, Behold, are not all these which speak Galilaeans? And how hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born?

Acts 2:1-8

Immediately, Peter stood up and began to quote the prophet Joel, a passage that ended with, "... whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved" (v. 21)— and Peter then started preaching! He began with the story of Jesus and of His miracles, and ended his sermon by saying, "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call" (vv. 38-39). Then, he shared even more about Jesus—the miracles, the signs, the wonders that everyone had already heard about, because the fame of Jesus had spread so far. He spoke about David and how he'd prophesied Jesus would come, too. It was a powerful day!

Acts 2:41 says the people gladly received the word and were also baptized in the Holy Ghost, and that 3,000 souls were added to the kingdom of God in that one day! A great many who traveled back home after the festival told the Good News to others, too. That day, the promise of the Father had come at the right time, in the right place, and to precisely the right people to have the greatest effect on establishing the kingdom of God in the earth. The world evangelism that Jesus had told them would begin once they'd been Holy-Ghost-baptized had begun!

What I want you to see is that the group who'd gathered in the Upper Room were changed by the POWER infused in them through the baptism of the Holy Spirit—they went from laying low to being ablaze with fire, energy, boldness, and direction for their lives. The miracle of being able to win souls in languages they did not know was only one sign. What they were given the most of was the power to *do* what God had called them to do. They quickly became *doers*, and that's exactly what we should be, too. The baptism of the Holy Spirit can light a fire in us that compels us to MOVE.

Those in the Upper Room that day suddenly had a whole new understanding of Jesus and the authority they'd been given. They knew what they had to do—they had to go out and *speak*. They had to *preach*. They had to get up and *go!*

Read the book of Acts and you'll see that when the fire came down, they lit up! They didn't stay in that Upper Room just marveling at the power of God. No, they got up afterward and *did* something. That's why it's called the

book of Acts—these people began taking action! Under the influence of the Holy Spirit, they began to live Spiritled lives, boldly moving forward in God's plan for His Church and for their lives.

The Tongues of Men and of Angels

You are never alone. Right here, right now, and right where you are, the Holy Spirit is now *here*. He dwells on the earth, and if you're saved, He's also dwelling in you. That's the mystery of how our God works in salvation. But the baptism of the Holy Spirit is a next-level experience with the Helper. It happens when a believer yields to the Holy Spirit in prayer, asks for more, and is doused with the fire of His power to such a degree that the evidence is shown outwardly. The most common and wonderful evidence that someone has been baptized in the Holy Ghost is when they spontaneously begin to pray with what the apostle Paul called the "tongues of angels." Many in the early Church experienced this phenomenon from the Holy Ghost when they were endued with power, and many experience it today, too.

The apostle Paul prayed in tongues, and we know it because he said, "Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass..." (1 Corinthians 13:1). He was warning the early Church not be so enthralled with having a heavenly language that they let go of love. He told them to, "Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts..." (1 Corinthians 14:1 NKJV). But in talking about the tongues of men and angels, Paul was making a distinction between the two that lets us know that speaking in tongues isn't talking gibberish. It is heavenly angelic languages being spoken without having learned or even understood them. Now, this world has thousands of natural human languages, and the number of angels God made is vast, so when Paul says "tongues of angels," he's letting us know there are multiple angelic languages used in Heaven. Maybe that explains why people sound so differently when the Holy Ghost hits them with His fire and they begin to pray in tongues.

Paul relied on praying in tongues so much that he said, "I thank my God I speak with tongues more than you all..." (1 Corinthians 14:18 NKJV). He used his heavenly language to build himself up in his most holy faith so that he could fulfill his destiny and reach his destination with power. Paul explained that was the whole reason for tongues when he said, "He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself..." (1 Corinthians 14:4). He also explained that even though we don't understand what we're saying, God does: "For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him: however, in the Spirit

he speaks mysteries." Paul explained that we are bypassing our mind and praying directly from our own spirit to God: "For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays, but my understanding is unfruitful" (1 Corinthians 14:2,14).

One of the greatest blessings of being able to pray in the tongues of angels is that, sometimes in life, you just get to the point where you do not know what to pray—the situation is too muddy or you just don't know what to do. That's when you can do what my wife says and, "Hit it in tongues!" Romans 8:26 (NKJV) says, "Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered." So, when we don't know, He does! We can do spiritual warfare when we pray in tongues, and we can lift ourselves up when we pray in tongues, too. We can receive divine guidance, have supernatural direction for life, and sometimes God will open our spiritual eyes and we can experience visions, too.

Now, I know some think it's weird to speak in tongues. But, again, remember that the natural mind doesn't understand the things of the Spirit—they're foolishness to him. So, while it may be weird to those who have no understanding of the phenomenon and don't want it, something changes when you get to the point that you really want more of God and, weird or not, you want it! And once you receive your heavenly language and start using it all the time, you wonder why you ever questioned getting this wonderful gift from the Helper in the first place!

My Struggle and Success in Finally "Getting the Holy Ghost"

Some people don't struggle at all with getting the baptism of the Holy Ghost, but I did. Some people go up to the altar to receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost and, before you know it, they're hit with the power! That didn't happen to me. When I was a new Christian, I answered altar call after altar call whenever they asked who wanted to be baptized in the Holy Ghost. Over and over, I'd go up to get prayed for and nothing would happen.

Preachers and other church members would pray over me, sweat over me, put their hands on me, and sway so hard that they practically danced with me! Still, nothing happened in me or to me. I got so frustrated after a while that I told my wife, Cathy, that I was done with it. I said, "I don't care! I'm happy. I love Jesus, I'm saved and going to Heaven, but forget this!" And guess what? I lived a great Christian life, and I was learning new things left and right. God was moving in my life and it was wonderful. I'd

decided that if I never "got the Holy Spirit," I'd be alright.

God has a sense of humor, though. I find the more you seek Him, the more He helps you—even in areas you think you failed at—and He sometimes sends somebody you never thought He would just to help you out. In my case, it was a cross-eyed preacher! I'm telling you, this man looked east and west at the same time. But he was a great preacher and he loved God. He was so on fire for God that after he preached, I decided that I'd go up in the prayer line and let him pray for me to get the Holy Ghost. I guess God knew I didn't need to be under pressure, because when that cross-eyed preacher was talking to me, I thought he was talking to the person next to me!

But, man, that preacher didn't play games—and for some reason, I stopped paying attention to everything and everyone around me. Instead of "just trying to get it" or wondering if this will be the time, I just opened my heart and my mouth and surrendered to God. With that cross-eyed preacher's hand on my head, and with all the shouting going on around me, I tuned out of my mind and into God. Before I knew it, I was filled with the Holy Spirit and words started bubbling out of me. It started with little syllables, and I knew it wasn't "me" doing it. I surrendered and just let the Holy Spirit have His way, and I went home so refreshed, so energized, and even more on fire for God. I knew without a shadow of doubt that I'd experienced something miraculous. It may not have been in a solemn service with an eloquent speaker who softly prayed over people in a dignified prayer line—but today, I thank God for that fired-up Holy-Ghost-preacher. God used him to help me with what I needed to take my relationship with Him and my prayer life to the next level.

From then on, when I prayed in my private time, I would pray in English like usual—just talking to God, presenting my needs and praising Him—and then I'd naturally just start praying in the Holy Ghost. Those few syllables developed quickly, and I found I used my heavenly language more and more—especially when I felt I needed to pray or praise more than what I could express with my own words. I found that it led to God revealing more to me, and it opened other gifts of the Spirit to me that I'd later flow in as a minister of the Gospel.

Receiving MORE of the Spirit Is What the Baptism Is All About

It's hard to receive anything from the Holy Spirit if we don't yield to Him. Our free will is at play with the Holy Spirit, just as it is with everything else. We have to be obedient, willing, ready, and open to more of Him to get more of Him—because the same way that we get

hungry and thirsty in our body, we get hungry and thirsty in our soul.

We yield to our thirst and drink water. We yield to our belly and eat food. And if we are thirsty and hungry for more of the Holy Spirit and the spiritual power He gives, we must yield to that need and desire, open our hearts, and *ask* to receive more of Him. He will not override our free will.

Now, I want you to understand this, because a lot of people who want to be baptized in the Holy Spirit and have that experience just focus on the heavenly language part. They get hung up on speaking in other tongues and think that's the only thing they'll be getting, but that is wrong. When we are baptized in the Holy Spirit, we are receiving more of *the Holy Spirit*. The heavenly language is what comes when we are so full of Him that we overflow with Him, and we spontaneously start getting a heavenly language that comes up and out of our spirit.

When we're seeking to be baptized in the Holy Spirit, we're simply seeking MORE—more of the One already here and dwelling in us through salvation; a different part of God; a deeper experience as a believer. We're taking the next step in our Christian faith. You don't need it in order to get to Heaven, by any means, but it sure makes life here on earth better. Your prayer time gets stronger. The anointing of the Holy Spirit bypasses your mind and moves in you and through you. It's powerful!

To receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit, there must be a sincerity of heart and motive, and an open-hearted admission to Him that says, "I'm willing, and I'm ready. I'm open to You, Holy Spirit. Fill me with Your Spirit because I want more of You." And just like we can't take in natural water if we don't open our mouth and let it flow in, we have to open our mouth in readiness for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit too. That's what "yielding" is all about. That's what desiring more of God is all about. Surrendering is always part of the process.

Whether you answer an altar call and have someone pray and lead you into receiving the baptism of the Holy Spirit, or you press in and ask for it all alone in your room, the Holy Spirit will be faithful to fill you to overflowing when you surrender to Him. If it takes you more than one try, just remember that you're going to receive if you keep on seeking more of Him, asking for His power, and yielding to His Spirit. Take it from me, it's worth it. Even if it takes a cross-eyed, Holy-Ghost-filled, spit-flying kind of preacher to help you, I promise, it's worth it!







Every activity in life has basic rules that must be followed before success can be achieved. For example, if you want to play the game of baseball, you would not use the rules that govern the game of football. And in the game of baseball, you can't get to first base, let alone make a home run, without a bat. You'll just stand at home plate watching the ball whiz by and strike out every time.

The same principle is true when it comes to prayer. There are basic rules that must be followed in order to have a winning prayer life. Without them, you will continually strike out and never achieve God's will for your life.

Prayer has been defined as "communication with God." Throughout His earthly ministry, Jesus demonstrated the importance of staying in constant communication with His Father. Because prayer was His lifestyle, Jesus always knew where He was going and what He would say and do when He got there. Through His example, we know that the very first rule about prayer is that we need to do it!

Hebrews 5:7 in the Amplified Bible, Classic Edition, says, "In the days of His flesh [Jesus] offered up definite, special petitions [for that which He not only wanted but needed] and supplications with strong crying and tears to Him Who was [always] able to save Him [out] from death, and He was heard because of His reverence toward God [His godly fear, His piety, in that He shrank from the horrors of separation from the bright presence of the Father]."

Now, if the matchless Son of God offered up

"definite, special petitions" for what He "not only wanted but needed," shouldn't we follow His example and do the same? Notice that the Word doesn't say that Jesus' prayer was heard because He was the Son of God. It says that His prayer was heard because of His reverence toward God.

Jesus said, "... The Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He seeth the Father do: for what things soever He doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise... I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father hath taught Me, I speak these things. And He that sent Me is with Me: the Father hath not left Me alone; for I do always those things that please Him" (John 5:19, 8:28-29).

While talking with a friend about the importance of prayer, I said, "It's not that *God* won't, it's that *we* don't." Why is that? It's because the devil convinces us that God won't answer our prayers, so we don't even bother to pray. How many victories were never won because we failed to go to God for help in the time of need or for the things that we desire? Realize today that it is not that God won't, but rather that we don't.

Types of Prayer

Now that we have established the importance of prayer, the next thing you should know is that there are different *types* of prayer with rules that govern each one. For example, there is the **prayer of faith**, which is the prayer of petition or the prayer to change things. It is always based on God's revealed Word and never

contains the word "if." A couple of examples of this can be found in Matthew 21:21-22 and Mark 11:22-24.

This is very different from the **prayer of consecration**, which is the type of prayer that Jesus prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane: "Saying, Father, if Thou be willing, remove this cup from Me: nevertheless not My will, but Thine, be done" (Luke 22:42).

People mistakenly think that every type of prayer should begin or end by asking for God's will to be done. When Jesus prayed for the sick, He didn't end it with "if it be Thy will" as so many do today. He often told the sick things like, "Your faith has made you whole." We know from God's Word that it is always His will to heal the sick, save the lost, and deliver the oppressed.

the oppressed.

A friend of mine told me that he used to pray "if it be Thy will" when he was praying for others who were sick. But when the tables were turned and he was the one that was near death, he didn't want to hear the words, "If it by Thy will, heal him, Lord." He needed someone to pray for him who knew the difference between the prayer of consecration and the prayer of faith. There is a difference.

Other types of prayer are the **prayer of commitment** (1 Peter 5:7), the **prayer of worship** (Acts 13:1-4; Luke 24:52-53), the **prayer of agreement** (Matthew 18:18-20), **united prayer** (Acts 4:23-31), and **intercessory prayer** (Romans 8:26-27, Ephesians 6:18). Although there are many types of prayer, it is vital to always pray *in faith* and expect results *every* time.

I heard a story about a congregation that met in a field to pray for rain, to relieve a long dry spell in their

area. The preacher looked severely at his flock and said, "Brothers and Sisters, y'all know why we are here. Now, what I want to know is, where are your umbrellas?"

That congregation must have forgotten the words of Jesus, "Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them" (Mark 11:24).

One day while studying the Word, I discovered five essential elements of effective prayer. Each one just happens to begin with the letter "A," which makes it easier for me to remember. I call them my *Prayer Basics* and hope they will help you as much as they help me.

Prayer Basic #1: ABIDE

Although this is just the first prayer basic, it is enough to get your prayers answered. In John 15:7 (AMPC), Jesus promised, "If you live in Me [abide vitally united to Me] and My words remain in you and continue to live in your hearts, ask whatever you will, and it shall be done for you." Now that is an awesome promise! Think of it: Ask whatever you will, and Jesus said it shall be done for you. It all hinges upon that little two-letter word "if":

If you live in Christ—abide vitally united to Him. If His Words remain in you.
If His Words continue to live in your heart.

If you ask for whatever it is that is on your heart. "If" is a little word that packs a big punch!

You see, while on the earth, Jesus walked in this powerful truth day by day and He wanted us to have the same advantage. Because He stayed vitally united to His Father in prayer, He could ask whatever He willed and it was done.

Remember the leper who came to Jesus wanting to be healed? He said, "Lord, if Thou wilt, Thou canst make me clean" (Matthew 8:2). Some people know that God can, but don't know if He will. Others believe that it's God's will to heal, but they don't believe He can heal them. Jesus touched the leper and said, "I will; be thou clean" (verse 3). This man had the will and can in the right perspective and got his miracle that day. Immediately, the leprosy left and he was made clean.

Psalm 91 describes an impenetrable fortress of protection that is available. However, there is a condition that must be met before the protection promise can go to work. Psalm 91:1 says, "He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty."

The definition for the word *shadow* in Strong's Concordance is "shade." That secret place is a cool spot to abide in. No matter what weapons the devil may be forming against you, they will not prosper (Isaiah 54:17). Psalm 91:16 says, "With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him My salvation." When you stick with Jesus, you have it made in the shade.

Prayer Basic #2: ASK

When speaking about prayer, John Wesley said, "It seems God is limited by our prayer life—that He can do nothing for humanity unless someone asks Him."

It is difficult to think that the Creator is limited by His creation, but it is true. God is just and will

not intervene in our lives without being asked or invited. A perfect example of this is the Israelites who refused to possess their Promised Land. Psalm 78:41 says, "Yea, they turned back and tempted God, and limited the Holy One of Israel." When you refuse to ask God for the things you need, regardless of your reasons, you limit God in the earth.

Now, don't think that you are going to shock God with your requests.

Remember, He knows what you have need of *before* you ask. However, His will is still that you ask.

Jesus said in Luke 11:9 (AMPC), "So I say to you, Ask and keep on asking and it shall be given you; seek and keep on seeking and you shall find; knock and keep on knocking and the door shall be opened to you." He taught us that we serve a good Father that desires to give good things to those that ask Him. Matthew 7:11 says, "If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in Heaven give good things to them that ask Him?" It is God's will that believers come together and ask Him for the things that we desire and need in this life. Jesus revealed this powerful promise to us in Matthew 18:19: "Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of My Father which is in Heaven."

With so many people on the earth asking, have you ever wondered how God knows who is who? Well, in the same way that your fingerprints are unique to you alone, your voice has a voiceprint that is unique to you as well. It is your address in the spirit realm and is easily recognized by God. His system is much more sophisticated than the latest voice recognition software known to man and is not limited by time or distance.

Psalm 145:18-19 says: "The LORD is nigh unto all them that call upon Him, to all that call upon Him in truth. He will fulfill the desire of them that fear Him: He also will hear their cry, and will save them."

When you cry out to God, He instantly

identifies your voiceprint.
Not only does He hear it,
He is always nearby to those
that call upon Him in truth,
and will fulfill the desire of
them that fear (reverence)
Him. So, go ahead and ask.
It's His idea!

Prayer Basic #3: ASSURANCE

My mother is the best cook in the world. Now that she is 92, she doesn't stand over the stove, but I still know how much she loved

to cook for me. Even after I was a grown woman with a kitchen of my own, I could walk into her house and ask for a bowl of her amazingly delicious chicken gumbo and knew she would hit the pots in a flash. In no time, we would be slurping up her wonderful gumbo, eating potato salad, and rubbing our tummies in contentment. I knew it would happen just that way. I know her that well. That's my assurance.

As children of God, we can have complete assurance in our Father's desire to fulfill the desires of our hearts. One of my favorite promises for answered prayer is in 1 John 5:14-15. I love the way it is translated in the Amplified Bible, Classic Edition: "And this is the confidence (the assurance, the privilege of boldness) which we have in Him: [we are sure] that if we ask anything (make any request) according to His will (in agreement with His own plan), He listens to and hears

us. And if (since) we [positively] know that He listens to us in whatever we ask, we also know [with settled and absolute knowledge] that we have [granted us as our present possessions] the requests made of Him."

Assurance in prayer comes from knowing the character of God. When you have studied His Word, you will know His will concerning the thing you are asking about. There is no reason to be timid or fearful because God's Word says in Hebrews 4:16 (AMPC), "Let us then fearlessly and confidently and boldly draw near to the throne of grace (the throne of God's unmerited favor to us sinners), that we may receive mercy [for our failures] and find grace to help in good time for every need [appropriate help and well-timed help, coming just when we need it]."

The moment you fearlessly and confidently draw near to your Father's throne with your request, you

can rejoice. You know you will find mercy and grace just when you need it. When you abide in Him and He abides in you, you can be assured that He will always hear and listen to you, and grant anything that you ask. You just know it would happen just that way because you know Him that well!

Prayer Basic #4: **AUTHORITY**

Every born-again believer has the potential

to tear down strongholds of the enemy and build up the Kingdom of God with their prayers. Now, I am not talking about a haphazard prayer life that occasionally reminds God about your problems. I am talking about perpetual, consistent, and even constant communication with God—communication that keeps the airways open, so to speak, so that the Holy Spirit is able to reveal the plans of the enemy to you and show YOU how to neutralize his forces and send him running for cover.

It's no wonder the devil works overtime to stop your prayer life. He knows that it's all over for him the moment you discover the authority given to you by Jesus Christ in Luke 10:19 (AMPC): "Behold! I

have given you authority and power to trample upon serpents and scorpions, and [physical and mental strength and ability] over all the power that the enemy [possesses]; and nothing shall in any way harm you."

Jesus gave you authority to use His Name when asking for anything. Look at His powerful promise in John 14:12-14 in The Passion Translation: "I tell you this timeless truth: The person who follows Me in faith, believing in Me, will do the same mighty miracles that I do—even greater miracles than these because I go to be with My Father! For I will do whatever you ask Me to do when you ask Me in My name. And that is how the Son will show what the Father is really like and bring glory to Him. Ask Me anything in My name, and I will do it for you!"

When you have the authority to use someone's name, it's as though they were standing there in person.


That's exactly what happened to the paralyzed man who sat at the gate of the city asking for money from those who went into the temple. The Passion Translation of Acts 3:4-6 says, "Peter and John, looking straight into the eyes of the crippled man, said, "Look at us!" Expecting a gift, he readily gave them his attention. Then Peter said, "I don't have money, but I'll give you this—by the power of the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, stand up and walk!" The power of

the name of Jesus instantly healed that man. He was so excited that he took off running and leaping and praising God.

When you use the name of Jesus in faith, everything that is named has to bow. Philippians 2:10-11 says, "That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in Heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."

The devil messed up when he put a name on your problem. Cancer has to bow, poverty has to bow, oppression has to bow, fear has to bow-every name that is named has to bow at the name of Jesus!

Paul prayed that the Ephesians would know "...what is the exceeding greatness of His power to us-





ward who believe, according to the working of His mighty power, Which He wrought in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead, and set Him at His own right hand in the heavenly places, Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: And hath put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be the head over all things to the church...And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus" (Ephesians 1:19-22; 2:6).

You are seated with Christ and have full authority to use His name to bust the devil's head back into the dust. So, get busy! Pray!

Prayer Basic #5: ASSIGNMENTS

Once you learn the first four prayer basics—abide, ask, assurance, and authority—you are ready to go deeper. You are ready to be led out of infancy in prayer and into rivers of Spirit-led prayer. This is what Jesus told the crowd of people in the temple during the Feast of Tabernacles. John 7:37-39 says, "In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto Me, and drink. He that believeth on Me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake He of the Spirit, which they that believe on Him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)"

I believe that heart-led prayers, not head-led prayers, are the type that flow with the Holy Ghost. Once God knows He can rely on you to pray, He may place specific assignments on your heart. It could be an entire nation or the little girl next door, but in His sight, they are equally important and vital to His

plan. Think of it: God has asked *you* to be involved in helping Him in the earth!


One prayer assignment that was given to a church while Peter was in prison was recorded in Acts 12:5 (AMPC): "So Peter was kept in prison, but fervent prayer for him was persistently made to God by the church (assembly)." Continue reading that chapter and you'll see that their prayer was so full of the fire of God that it broke open the prison door and set Peter free. This church took their assignment seriously and prayed fervently.

According to Vines Expository Dictionary, the definition for the word *fervent* is "to be hot, to boil." The Bible tells us in James 5:16 that, "... *The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.*" That's the kind of prayer that Elijah prayed. He really turned the heat on old Ahab because he was on an assignment to intercede for his nation (1 Kings 18).

Prayer always begins with God. If prayer is your lifestyle, God will find a way to get His assignments to you. But don't worry; God will not throw you in over your head. He'll start you out in the shallows (sort of a wading pool) so that you can get your feet wet first. If you are found faithful, God will move you on to deeper things.

Never underestimate the power of prayer. It is so awesome that it will heal the sick, save the lost, and set the captives free. Prayers spoken in faith parted the Red Sea, raised the dead, and fed the multitudes. Regardless of your need or desire, prayer will always reveal God's plan for your victory.

Don't let past failures keep you away from God's throne of grace. Discover the awesome power that is available in prayer. Learn to apply the basics of prayer and never pass up the opportunity to pray!



SUITED FOR SUCCESS

While societies in the world today are driven by the desire for success, many Christians seeking success in their own lives are not well received. But the TRUTH about God's view of success is revealed throughout the Bible. 





