I determined my destination when I was five years old. Where was I headed?

Out!

Out of poverty.

Out of lack.

Into a place of plenty.

How would I get there? I had no earthly idea, but I was going.

My faith had a destination.

You may have heard me say that I was a heathen by the age of eight. It's true, and it happened because of the commitment I made three years earlier.

I grew to hate prayer.

"Bow your head, Jesse!" My mama used to tell me.

I heard people talk about God healing. They were all sick.

I knew people who believed in prosperity. They were all broke.

The Christians I knew had preacher barbecues every day.

If a black man made the mistake of walking into our church, he probably wouldn't have made it back out. By the time I was eight years old, I'd seen too much hatred and bigotry in God's name.

"Mama," I asked, "what's the matter with the people at that church?"

"They're foolish," she sighed. "They're stupid. They shouldn't act that way."

After three years of waiting for God to show up, I gave up believing that He would.

"I don't believe in your God, Mama." I said.

"You're a heathen!" she gasped, slapping me.

"God don't do nothing!" I argued. Slap!

Mama's slapping and rebuking did no good. I gave up on God. I had a destination in my life, and by the age of eight, I figured I'd have to get there on my own.

It was especially important that I figure out what to do with my life, because I wasn't supposed to be. My daddy let me know that I was a fleeting moment of passion.

"Boy," he said, "you sure caught us by surprise." It was the simple truth.

I Was Different

If the news of my imminent arrival took my parents by surprise, that was nothing compared to the jolt they got when I was born.

I didn't have any eyes.

I didn't have a nose.

I didn't have a mouth.

"My God, what is it?" my mother cried.

"Let's put it back," Daddy said.

"Well, looky here!" the doctor said. "It's a veil baby!" *Veil baby?* my daddy thought, *It better be a Duplantis baby!*

I was born with a piece of skin covering my face. Someone told me it happens about once in every 30 million births. The doctor clipped that skin away, and I saw light for the first time.

There's something about being the middle child. Mama always worried about the oldest. And she always worried about the youngest.

"There's just something about you," Mama said. "I've got to take care of your brother. I've got to take care of your sister. You? You'll make it."

How will I make it? I wondered. Maybe like daddy in the oil field.

"Mama," I'd ask, "what am I gonna do?" In other words, what's my destiny?

"I don't know," she'd say thoughtfully, "but you won't be an oil field worker. You're going to do something different."

"What, Mama?"

"It'll be revealed."

My Mama's Faith Had a Destination

The day I found out I could play a guitar was the day I knew I'd found my key out of poverty. The other kids would be outside playing, and I'd be in my room

strumming that guitar. I started off with country music, then I discovered Elvis Presley. I'd rock out. "Hubba hubba hub

I went, but I took that old guitar with me. The man across the street would yell, "Hey! Little Jesse! Come over here and play for me!"

I'd play every song I knew for him, which was three.

"You can do anything you want!" he'd say. "You're an American!"

"Is that the same as being Cajun?" I asked.

"Play that guitar!" he'd say. "Play yourself out of here and into the world!"

Words like that go into a kid. Oh, I'd play! Eventually, I started playing different instruments.

Why did I practice, practice, practice when I could have been having fun? I had a destination.

Another thing I did, because I had a destination, was make good grades. I figured the only way out of there was to work hard and make good grades. I was an oddity among the Duplantis clan. I don't use the word clan lightly. The Duplantis bunch were Catholics and didn't believe in birth control. We grew into a clan.

Out of that whole clan of people, I believe that I'm the only one who always made good grades. I'm the only one who graduated from high school.

Was I smarter than the rest? No. I just had a destination.

But, as usual, Mama got her way, and I went to the church on the night of the campmeeting to play my guitar. The leaders listened to me play a little before service, and then they asked me to get on the platform with a few other guys. They didn't have a place for us to sit, so we stood with our instruments.

Now, I had a habit when I played. I moved!

When we started playing, I turned that guitar toward the amplifier, put in a few licks, and started moving. A little while later, the whole thing stopped. The sound went dead and I heard a voice yell from the pew. "Get that kid off there!" That was the first time I was thrown out of church.

"You can't play!" they said. "You've got devil music in you! And you've got some of that black music in you, too!"

"Yeah, well, y'all need some black mamas in here!" I said. "Them sorry, fat, white women can't sing a lick!"

I had a destination—out of that meeting!

It's sad to say, but after that, I sold my talent for a bundle of money. I had it all by the world's standards.

What made me walk away from wealth, fame, and fortune?

My mama's faith had a destination—to bring me back to the altar of God.

There's Nothing Infectious About Secondhand Faith

Why didn't I catch hold of the faith of those Christians that crossed my path when I was young? Because they were trying to live off of secondhand faith. They may have been living off the truth of their mama's relationship with God. Maybe they were living off the faith of the founder of that church. Maybe they were trying to live off the faith of John Wesley.

It really doesn't matter.

Secondhand faith isn't infectious.

I couldn't catch real faith from them if I rubbed up against them all day. The only antidote for secondhand faith is firsthand relationship.

Let's look at 1 John 3:1-2: "Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew Him not. Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be..."

These verses make it clear that not only should we be *called* the sons of God, we *are* the sons of God. But do you know what gets folks really riled up? People get mad when I say I'm a son of God. They write me ugly letters.

"Who do you think you are?"

I already told you. I'm a son of God.

One Catholic lady asked me, "Are you a saint?"

"Yes," I told her.

"When did they canonize you?" she asked.

"When I was born again."

I know we're using different terminology because the devil has invaded religion. Of course, you and I are not *THE* Son of God, but according to the Bible, we are *sons* of God.

"Why is that so important, Brother Jesse?" someone asked. Because if you don't know who you are in Christ,

you'll never fulfill your destiny.

Verse two in 1 John 3 says it all: "It doth not yet appear what we shall be..."

That means that we are not finished products. What will we be like next week? What about next year? It doth not yet appear.

But I can tell you one thing: If you're the same, you're not going anywhere.

Why? Because your faith doesn't have a destination. If it did, you would grab the torch of faith and move forward.

I can hardly wait to see what I'll look like next year. But it doth not yet appear, even though I look in the mirror every day.

I love to read the Word of God aloud. Why? Because faith comes by hearing, not by reading. I must grab the torch of faith and move forward. I need faith to reach my destination. So, I read along and substitute my name in those scriptures because God is talking to me.

I was doing that one day when the devil interrupted me. "Do you think all those words in the Bible belong to you?"

I answered without thinking, "No, devil, two of them belong to you. All the rest belong to me."

The devil is so stupid. He asked, "Which two belong to me?"

"Your words are The End! All the rest belong to me!"

Man Succeeds Because He Thinks He Can Man Fails Because He Believes He Will

I don't listen too much to people who say, "Well, you know, Brother Jesse, the last time I was sick..."

"I don't want to hear that," I tell them.

"Huh?"

"Don't rehearse what the devil did! Rehearse what Jesus has done!"

"But I'm sick!"

"Well, by Jesus' stripes you're healed! Take 'ye were healed' and omit, 'I am sick."

"How long would that take, Brother Jesse?"

"Do you ask that question when you take Sudafed? Do you ask it when you take Tylenol? Do you feel better as soon as you take it? No. You have to wait for it to kick in. About twenty or thirty minutes later, your sinus passages will open up and suddenly you can breathe again."

"See, Brother Jesse, you said it yourself. Cold medicine works quick."

"Yeah, but there's one big difference. Those cold remedies never conquered a cold. It just dulls them. In about three hours, you'll be hacking and clacking again."

When you take a dose of Jesus' stripes by faith, you'll be healed!

We were on a motorcycle trip with the Copelands one time when the lights went out on my trailer. Kenneth was laying on hard cement trying to fix them. My daddy always taught me to be helpful, but I can't fix anything. I never bought a screwdriver until I met Jerry Savelle and Kenneth Copeland. Why should I? Cathy always did the fixing around our house.

So, I stood there watching Kenneth on the cement by my bike, getting aggravated about the situation. I decided to be helpful in spite of the fact that Jerry was sending me all kinds of warning signals.

"Hand me that screwdriver," Kenneth said.

"Which one is the screwdriver?"

"It's the long one."

"Yeah...I got it!"

"Hand me the Phillips."

I didn't have any idea what a Phillips was.

Finally, I decided to give Kenneth Copeland some advice.

Jerry waved frantically trying to get me to stop. "Jesse," he said, "he'll get it."

Get in a Suburban? I thought, How about getting in a ditch? Pretty soon, here came the hail. It was beating that Suburban up.

God, I've got to get out of here!

About then, Kenneth started rebuking the devil.

"Devil, I said get out of here!"

"Kenneth, you're making him made!"

Here it was, my first movie, and I had to die...twice! The first time I was acting. By the looks of things, the second time would be real.

A few minutes later, someone walked up to the Suburban with a shovel over his head in the middle of that hail storm and those tornadoes! I figured it must be a mighty man of valor.

It was John Copeland, Kenneth's son. He knew something I hadn't figured out yet. He knew his daddy wasn't going to quit.

Jesse and I are so thankful to God for all His glorious acts in the lives of those that He has called us to reach. May God fill you with His joy as you read this month's collection of glorious moments from our wonderful Partners.

Thank you for praying for me. I gave God a job and He was at work! On 12/26/2023 I was diagnosed with lung cancer that jumped to my back and liver. I went to the elders of my church and they anointed me with oil, wrote to KCM and JDM, and advised that no one could talk negative about or around me. I did my declarations with God's medicine and the ones Brother Copeland sent me, and I praised God for my healing. On 3/18/2024 I journaled the words the Holy Spirit gave me: "Miracle, peace, home, expect a miracle, look for it." My cat scan on that date showed no success with chemo, and the doctor started talking about quality of life. But there was 1 more drug that had a less than 9% chance of working. I claimed it as my miracle. On 6/13/2024 I had another scan, and the tumor in my lung was GONE, and the tumors on my liver were almost gone! My liver was brown before, but now it is turning pink, and all the tumors are coming off! My blood work is so much better, almost perfect! My doctor knew I was praying, so he said I should do one thing: "Keep praying!" I took Brother Jesse's advice and gave God a job, and He is doing it! I continue to take treatment and I declare, "I will not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord!"To my God be ALL the Glory!

Last year my son was told that he had tongue cancer. He had chemo and radiation done. After 6 or 8 weeks, they did a scope that didn't look good. He was told that the next option would be to remove part of the tongue. He had a biopsy of the tongue and, one week later, the results were that he was cancer free. Thank you for your prayers.

At the 2023 Rejoice Conference in Colorado Spring, Colorado, Cathy, along with the pastors, prayed for my foot to be healed. I had injured it several years ago, and it had begun to hurt so badly that it was painful to the touch and often kept me up at night. I am healed! It has not hurt or been swollen since! Praise God! We enjoy listening to Jesse and Cathy and appreciate everything that they do, including coming to Charis Christian Center. Very thankful for those that proclaim God's goodness.

Hi, Jesse! Just want to say that when I first accepted Jesus in my heart, your sermons/messages were the first I heard and watched. That was 20 years ago. I have since watched many pastors and many wonderful sermons, but you are still my favorite. I also just watched the Boardroom Chat, "Angels: Our Hidden Help." It was so good, I found myself smiling the whole time.

I need to let you know the fun we have been recently having with God and the way He has been answering prayer. About 2 weeks ago, we bought a turkey at a new store we were trying out, and my wife suggested that we could make a Thanksgiving meal out of it. We live in England, so this is not the norm. We had a wonderful meal and gave thanks to God for the various ways His goodness has been shown to us down the years. For the first few hours, I wobbled and hobbled but kept declaring that I was healed and pain free. Returning home, I could tell that the ankle was working and the pain had almost gone. Imagine my joy, however, when I checked the ankle the following morning and found it not only healed, but all the bruising almost gone! We serve an awesome God. 

Isometimes tease Jesse and tell him that the reason I stopped cooking was because he stopped being thankful. It's a joke, of course. The truth is that we rarely have time for a home-cooked meal because of our busy traveling schedule. But, when I have the time to clean the cobwebs out of the pots and cook, it is cause for a celebration. I even use the special china that Jesse thinks is "just to look at." I consider it worth all the trouble when he takes the time to give thanks for the meal that I cooked for him.

God is the same way. He has prepared so many good things for us to enjoy and He likes to know that it is appreciated. Ephesians 5:20 says, "Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ."

Jesus, our perfect example, always showed His appreciation by publicly giving thanks to His Father. Whether He was multiplying the food or raising Lazarus from the dead, Jesus never forgot to give thanks to His Father. He spoke out of the abundance of a heart that was full of thanksgiving to God.

"Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ." Ephesians 5:20

"I Want to Thank the Lord!"

"Does anyone have a good testimony today?" That question was regularly asked by the pastor in the first church that Jesse and I attended after we were born again. There never seemed to be a shortage of saints to stand up and testify about the faithfulness of God. Some members could testify with such boldness that it ignited shouts of praise all over the building.

Others would ramble on forever and put half of the congregation to sleep. Then there was me.

In those days, my testimony always started the same way: "I want to thank the Lord..." But before I could say just what I was thankful for, I would burst into tears. Just thinking about all that Jesus meant to me would touch my heart so deeply that I would cry like a baby in front of the entire church. This happened more often than I care to remember.

Each time someone in the church told me how blessed they were by my "testimony," I would stare at them in disbelief. What testimony? I never made it through the introductory phrase.

Jesse's mom liked to say that it was the golden finger of God touching my heart. I knew that was true, but I was ready for Him to touch my tongue. I felt like a failure because I couldn't say six words without getting choked up.

Although I was tempted to stay seated and never try to testify again, I refused to give up. I was determined to testify about all that Jesus had meant to me. When that day finally came, I'm not sure if the church people praised God for my testimony or for the fact that I actually completed an entire sentence *before* breaking into tears.

In the years since that time, I have developed a thankful heart for what my mother-in-law called "the golden finger of God." When He moves my heart to testify or to shout, dance, run, laugh, or cry, I am always thankful for His touch, in whatever way it happens to come. I'm dedicated to yielding to His touch. I have what you might call a "have handkerchief, will travel" kind of attitude!

Now, I know that not every life that is touched by God gives Him thanks. The Bible tells us about nine lepers that just kept on walking after they were healed by Jesus. Although Jesus responded to the cry of all ten lepers, only *one* was actually thankful. Only *one* turned around and glorified God. And, do you know what? Only *one* was made truly whole.

And it came to pass, as He went to Jerusalem, that He passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. And as He entered into a certain

And as He entered into a certain village, there met Him ten men that were lepers, which stood afar off:

And they lifted up their voices, and said, Jesus, Master, have mercy on us.

And when He saw them, He said unto them, Go shew yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were cleansed.

And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice glorified God,

And fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks: and he was a Samaritan.

And Jesus answering said, Were there not ten cleansed? but where are the nine? There are not found that returned to give glory to God, save this stranger.

And He said unto him, Arise, go thy way: thy faith hath made thee whole.

Luke 17:11-19

Now, all ten were healed of leprosy, but what kicked the miracle healing into a higher level of wholeness was only one thing: thankfulness!

I believe that if the one grateful leper had lost any fingers, toes, or bits of ear to that dreadful disease, all those stolen parts grew back that day. Even though this man was a Samaritan—a stranger to the covenant of promise—Jesus said that his faith had made him **whole.** Because this man had a thankful heart, he was able to tap into a higher level of faith and got *all* that was available to him that very day. Glory to God!

Attitude Adjustment

There is a great lesson to be learned by the story of the nine lepers that forgot to thank Jesus for their healing. The lesson is that God always has much more than we can ask or think, and He wants to pour His goodness out on our lives. But when we forget to acknowledge what He has already done, we stop the flow of His power in our lives. Without a thankful heart, we simply can't get God's best.

Psalm 103:2-5 says, "Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; Who healeth all thy diseases; Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; Who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; Who satisfieth thy

mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's."

If you have forgotten those benefits, it may be time to give yourself an attitude adjustment. Just like the Psalmist did, you can tell your soul (which is your mind, will, and emotions) to "Bless the Lord!"

Get into the habit of acknowledging God's benefits to you, and thank Him with every fiber of your being. Count your blessings and consider what He has already done for you. Thank Him for forgiving your iniquities, healing your diseases, redeeming your life from destruction, and crowning you with lovingkindness and tender mercies. Thank Him for satisfying your mouth with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. Don't forget *all* of His benefits!

When God sent His Son, Jesus, to die for our sins on the cross, every benefit we would ever need in this life was freely and lavishly bestowed on us. And those gifts of divine favor and blessing are available to *all* who will humble themselves and call upon the name of Jesus. God has given us His Holy Spirit to help us realize, comprehend, and appreciate these gifts.

The Bible says, "Now we have not received the spirit [that belongs to] the world, but the [Holy] Spirit Who is from God, [given to us] that we might realize and comprehend and appreciate the gifts [of divine favor and blessing so freely and lavishly] bestowed on us by God" (1 Corinthians 2:12 AMPC).

Not Just Lips

Tradition and empty words may impress man, but true thanksgiving will come from a heart full of gratitude to God for His goodness. If your heart is not right with God, you're just a pair of lips. Hebrews 13:15 says, "By Him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name."

The people of Jesus' day were filled with tradition. The Pharisees enjoyed putting on great shows of formality to impress the people with their religion. They were also very critical when Jesus did not do things exactly the way they thought He should. In Mark 7:6, Jesus said, "... Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me."

I'm reminded of the candy wax lips I used to buy when I was a child. They were huge, red, perfectly shaped lips that covered my entire mouth and chin. Like a mask, they could change my outward appearance and make me appear to be smiling and full of joy. But they were just wax lips and didn't last very long.

Many people struggle their entire lives to keep up a front and say the right words, but they are just lips. They may fool people and themselves, but God sees right through those lips and goes straight to the source: the heart. Hebrews 4:13 says, "Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in His sight: but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of Him with Whom we have to do."

As a child, whenever I had a fight with my sisters, my mother would make us hug each other and say, "I'm sorry and I love you." If it was just lips and not

from the heart, mother knew it. She would make us apologize again until we actually *meant* what we said. Mother had to be satisfied that it came from our heart and not just our lips.

In Luke 12:2, Jesus said, "For there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; neither hid, that shall not be known." When we realize that we are transparent before Jesus, we can take off our wax lips and open our lives completely to Him. His power to save, heal, and deliver is still available to all that reach out to Him in faith.

Just like that one leper that had an attitude of a thankful heart, *your* faith can also make you whole. When you take that one step towards Jesus, He will meet you and walk with you every step of the way. It is just one of the many benefits that you can thank God for. Open your heart to Him today and give thanks always!
