
MAKE THE VISION REAL



JESSE DUPLANTIS

Have you ever gotten out of bed in the morning and wanted to just kick all the stops out of your life and do something great for God? You would, but you're hindered by the one thing you know better than your own name—you *can't*. After all, nobody knows your limitations like you do.

Right?

Actually, that's wrong. *God* knows what you're capable of doing, and He knows what you *can't* do. Most of us believe that God will call us into the type of work that fits our own abilities. If that's what you think, here's my advice: don't hold your breath!

When God called me into the ministry, the only thing I knew how to do was sing and play instruments. I could play every instrument in the band. I played the piano, the guitar, the bass, and the drums! I was an entertainer with a rock band during the 60s and 70s. That's the way I earned a living. So, when God called me into ministry, I knew He must want me to become a musician or worship leader. It made perfect sense to me, but the Lord wouldn't let me.

"Jesse," He said, "I want you to preach the Gospel."

When God told me to preach, I was so sure I couldn't do it that I went to a pastor and told him. "Jesse," he said, while shaking his head, "You can't preach."

I knew I couldn't preach. That pastor knew I couldn't preach.

God was the only one Who hadn't

figured it out yet! I kept hoping that when He realized I couldn't do it, He'd let me use my musical talent for Him instead. I didn't know then what I know now:

The closer you get to the center of God's perfect will for your life, the further you get from your own talents and abilities.

GOD CALLS YOU TO THE IMPOSSIBLE

If you're capable of doing what you believe God has called you to do, you haven't found His plan for your life. Why? Because God will call you to the impossible.

"Wait a minute, Brother Jesse," someone said, "surely that's not scriptural."

The Bible is full of examples of God doing impossible things through very average people. Peter was an ignorant fisherman, but people put the sick and lame in the street where his shadow would heal them as he passed by.

The apostle Paul was on the other end of the spectrum. He had one of the greatest intellectual minds ever known to Christianity. He was an academic. He studied at the feet of Gamaliel, one of Israel's greatest scholars at the greatest university of that day. He was an excellent and powerful speaker, but look at what Paul said in 1 Corinthians 2:1-5:

And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God.

For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and Him crucified.

And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling.

And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

Think about this for a moment. Paul said, "I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and Him crucified." This man could preach a twelve-part series on righteousness that would knock your socks off! He had an IQ that was off the scale, but he set all of that aside and decided the only thing he had worth sharing was his knowledge of Jesus.

IN WEAKNESS. FEAR. AND TREMBLING

"And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling." I couldn't figure that verse out for years because it didn't match what I knew about Paul. He wasn't afraid of anything! For preaching the Gospel he was stoned, yet he didn't crawl away in fear and trembling. He got up and kept on preaching. He must have been thrown into the lion's den because he said he'd been delivered out of the mouth of a lion. He was in jail, bound to a Roman centurion, but he wasn't afraid or depressed. He said, "And because I preach this Good News, I am suffering and have been chained like a criminal. But the Word of God cannot be chained" (2 Timothy 2:9 NLT).

This man wasn't afraid of anything! A snake bit him and he shook it off in the fire. He was blown out of a ship in the middle of a hurricane. You would think that would have scared him, but it didn't. He said, "Hey, boys! Grab a board, we're going fishing! Glory to God!" Yet Paul himself records, "And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling."

Stoning didn't scare him. Lions and snakes didn't scare him. Hurricanes didn't scare him. Prison didn't scare him. For years I wondered, What scared Paul? The Lord finally told me. Paul actually referred to it in the same passage of scripture: he couldn't use his intelligence!

MY INABILITY QUALIFIED ME

Paul said he hadn't come with excellency of speech or of wisdom to declare the testimony of God. He didn't speak or preach with enticing words or man's wisdom because he didn't want their faith to stand in the wisdom of man.

Do you know what made the apostle Paul tremble in his sandals? He couldn't use his education. He couldn't use his knowledge. God was asking Paul to

do the same thing He's asking you and me to do: He wants us to do what we can't do!

In other words, God was saying, "Look, Paul, I don't want you to do an educational discourse here. All I want you to do is tell them about My death, burial, and resurrection."

I don't mean to brag, but I'm not a man who is afraid of anything or anyone. At least I wasn't until God called me to do something I knew I couldn't do. When He called me to preach, I said, "Forget it! I don't know how to preach!"

"I know," the Lord said, "that's why I called you." Do you understand what I'm telling you? My inability to preach was my qualification!

I didn't understand that back then, so I argued with God. "I don't talk good," I explained. "I'm a Cajun!"The more I pointed out my shortcomings, the more excited He became. God saved me and put me in the ministry.

He said, "I want you to do the things you can't do."

"I can't do that," I said, "but I'll tell You what I can do. I'll play and sing for You because I know how to do that. Or I could go into the business arena and make lots of money for You. I always knew how to make money."

I wasn't bragging; I was stating a fact and God knew it.

MAN SAYS YOU CAN'T. GOD SAYS YOU CAN

Paul said, "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God" (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).

The whole reason that God calls us to do what we can't do is so that our faith will be in the power of God rather than the wisdom of men. In other words, God will get all the glory.

I'll let you in on a little secret: The men and women who know you also know you can't do what God has called you to do. If there is one thing that has marked my ministry, it is the fact that people have told me that I couldn't do anything that God has called me to do.

People said I couldn't preach the Gospel; God said I could.

People said I couldn't go on worldwide television; God said I could.

People said I couldn't pay my bills; God said I could.

This may surprise you, but those people were right! *I couldn't!* In fact, there isn't one thing that is being done through Jesse Duplantis Ministries America right now that I can do. There's nothing being done through Jesse Duplantis Ministries Europe that I can do. There's nothing being done through Jesse Duplantis Ministries Australia that I can do. But here's the exciting part: we're doing it!!

Don't Let Your Faith Stand in Your Wisdom

Years ago, I flew home from a meeting and I decided to walk around my ministry headquarters and visit different departments. I arrived at the Television Department as they were filming. "Hey, guys! How are you doing?" I asked.

"Just great, Brother Jesse. It's good to see you. By the way, we need some cameras."

"Cameras? What kind of cameras?"

"The kind with the big lenses that can spot a fly on the wall at a hundred yards."

"How much do they cost?"

"The whole rig is "150,000.00."

I swallowed hard. "How many do you need?" "Two of them."

I'd been there thirty seconds and it cost me \$300,000! I left there and went to Partner Care. They needed a new computer software system. The Maintenance Department needed a new truck. The Duplication Department needed 60 new duplicating machines.

I asked God, "Is there someplace I can go where they won't ask me for money?" Then I had a great idea... I'll go to Cathy's office.

"Hi, Cathy," I said when I got to her office. "Jesse," she said, "we need \$1.2 million."

I wanted to scream, "God, I can't do this!" I'd no sooner had that thought when the Lord said, "Don't let your faith stand in your wisdom. Let your faith stand in My power."

In other words, God was confirming that I couldn't do it all, but He could! I shifted gears and stopped dwelling on my limitations. Instead, I dwelt on God's limitless power. Guess what God did?

He brought in the money for the new cameras. He bought the new software. He provided a new truck. He bought us 60 duplicating machines. He even provided the \$1.2 million!

Would you like to know why we got all those things? Because we couldn't do it! And neither can you. But the faith of God and the wisdom of God in your life will get it all done. The wisdom of men told me not to open that office in Australia while I was jumping out on major television here in the states. You can't run a multi-million-dollar corporation and act stupid. One day I'm going to stand before God and hear, "Well done, Jesse, you good and faithful servant."

How can I be so sure about that? Because I've earned a PhD—that means *Past Having Doubts!*

Paul told us clearly that we are not to stand in the wisdom of men. That means we had better be searching for the wisdom of God.

SPEAK THE WISDOM OF GOD IN A MYSTERY

Paul told us clearly that we are not to stand in the wisdom of men. That means we had better be searching for the wisdom of God. How do we find it? Paul tells us in the next two verses of 1 Corinthians:

> Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought:

But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory.

1 Corinthians 2:6-7

Look at what Paul said: "But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery." What mystery is he talking about here? Tongues! When you pray in tongues, you are praying the mysteries of God. Have you ever noticed when you're praying in your prayer language that there will be intervals when you stop? Then, in a few seconds, you'll take off again? The Holy Spirit will stop on occasion so that you can pray with your understanding.

What you're praying is a mystery to your mind, and it's a mystery to the devil, but it isn't a mystery to God. Why has there been such a huge war against speaking in tongues? People will tell you it's not for today. They'll say it's of the devil. The devil fights it so hard because what you're praying is a mystery to him. He can't understand what you're saying, so he wants it to stop. He would much rather you pray something he can understand.

I'll tell you something that is a mystery to me. How can I do the things that I know I can't do? That's your mystery too. When God tells you His plan for your life, the mystery is how to do what you can't do. When Paul began his ministry, he didn't know how in the world he was going to do it, but he learned the secret to success in God. That's what he explained in verses six and seven.

How do you do the things you can't do? You pray the mysteries of God.

That's why Paul said, "I thank my God, I speak with tongues more than ye all" (1 Corinthians 14:18).

He had to tap into the plan of God and the power of God. That's why he prayed in tongues more than anyone else. He also received more revelation from God and wrote more of the New Testament than anyone else. Is that a coincidence? No. It was a choice.

Paul chose to pray in tongues more than anyone he'd ever known. As a result, he spoke in the power of God rather than the wisdom of men. That's why he shook off the viper the way you might shake off a fly. That's why he wasn't depressed in prison—he had more time to pray in tongues. That's why he wasn't afraid of lions or

hurricanes. That's the reason he got up to preach again after he'd been stoned.

The apostle Paul put aside his intellect to pray out the mysteries of God in tongues. He chose to live by the power of the Holy Spirit rather than through his own wisdom or the wisdom of men.

THE GOD WHO IS MORE THAN ENOUGH

I was mad almost every day of my life until I received Jesus and was born again. God came inside and washed away sin, sickness, and all the junk that had held me in bondage. Do you know what happened? I fell out of love with myself.

According to Cathy, when we met, we both fell in love with the same person—me! That was the truth until I fell in love with Jesus. When He said, "Jesse, I want you to preach," I loved Him so much that I told Him the truth: "Jesus, I can't."

"I know, Jesse," He said, "but I can."

I loved Jesus so much that I stopped worrying about how Jesse would look. I just wanted to please Him. I stopped living by my intellect and started praying out the mysteries of God for my life.

If you're waiting until you get educated to serve Him, you never will. If you're waiting until you're qualified to serve Him, you never will. If you're waiting until God calls you to do what you can do, He never will.

It's not that God doesn't appreciate your willingness to do what you can do for Him. It's just that those things glorify you and they nullify the power of God to do the impossible in your life.

How do you begin? The same way Paul did. Lay down your intellect and pray in tongues. Then, pray more and more. Pray out the mysteries of God for your life. Before you know it, you'll be doing the things you can't do!

CATHY DUPLANTIS



Tused to make amazingly delicious pecan praline Landy. Each creamy delight was as large as my hand and filled with whole pecans from one end to the other. Before I hit my forties, I could eat an entire batch without gaining an ounce, which I did more than I care to admit. It seemed that once I ate one sugar-filled bite, a deep hunger would come upon me and I would plot ways to get more.

I never realized how hooked I was until the day I tried to hide them from my sister, Christine. The last of my pecan praline candy was in a bag in my purse, and I was struggling with the idea of sharing them with her. I knew she loved them almost as much as I did, but I was trying to convince myself that she could make a batch of her own if she really wanted one. After all, it was her recipe. That's when I reached in my purse and gave her the entire bag. She thanked me, and as any good sister would, she offered one of them to me.

Since that day, I have taken control of my candy-eating life. I have found that I can no longer recklessly indulge without seeing that unwelcome new bulge. I have even stopped sending my pecan praline candy to a few of my friends because I was contributing to their addiction, which was equal to mine. They embarrassedly admitted to hiding them from others to feed their deep hunger for more. I thought I was the only one that did that!

You see, if you have a deep hunger like that for something, it will become obvious to those around you.

TASTE AND SEE

Many of us have had to deal with hungers of one type or another in our lives. But there is one hunger that should never be ignored: the deep hunger inside every living soul for God Himself. Although many people seek out religious tradition, worldly entertainment, or the wealth of this world in an attempt to satisfy themselves, nothing manmade will ever satisfy that deep hunger for God. Jesus said, "...I am the bread of life: he that cometh to Me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on Me shall never thirst" (John 6:35).

When you make Jesus the very bread of your life, you shall never hunger. He is the answer to the deepest desire of your heart and the answer to every problem

you will ever face. Psalm 34:8 says, "O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in Him."

I am convinced that anyone who doesn't hunger for God has never tasted and seen just how good He is! Once you know just how good God is, you will want more. The Psalmist said it this way: "As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O God" (Psalm 42:1).

The Gospel is filled with testimonies of people who had such a deep hunger to be near Jesus that others took notice. My personal favorite example is Anna, an eighty-four-year-old prophetess who had such an intense hunger to see the Messiah that she "...departed not from the temple, but served God with fastings and prayers night and day" (Luke 2:37).

Another great example of someone with deep hunger for Jesus was Mary, the sister of Lazarus and Martha. She totally ignored her sister's complaints as she committed herself to spending every available moment at the feet of Jesus to hear His Word. Later, this same woman was criticized severely by Judas when she anointed the precious feet of Jesus with a pound of very expensive ointment. The sweet odor of Mary's sacrificial gift was so powerful that it filled the whole house and got the attention of everyone. We are still talking about her today.

You see, Mary was a real person who had tasted and seen the goodness of Jesus. She learned to yield to her hunger for spiritual things, and it showed. The opposite is also true if you have ignored the desire of

your heart for more of God. It will show, too. If you are a spiritual anorexic, people know it. When you are weak from hunger, it is impossible to feed someone else spiritual food. You can't pour out to others if you haven't been filled up.

NO LIMITATIONS

When you eat from the banquet table of God, there are no limitations. If you are hungry for more of Him, just step up to His table and fill your plate to the brim. Psalm 105:2 (AMPC) shows us how to stay filled up: "Sing to Him, sing praises to Him; meditate on and talk of all His marvelous deeds and devoutly praise them." God has an abundant selfserve buffet arranged just for you with a sign that reads: "ALL YOU CAN EAT!" You don't have to stop until you are full.

Singing praises to God and meditating on His Word filled Paul and Silas with God's strength, and it gave them peace that was beyond understanding. Acts 16:25-26 says, "And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them. And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed." While they were chained in prison, they refused to give up until they were delivered by the hand of God and their victory was complete. Devout praise lifted them above the problems of life and into the presence of God.

OUR INDISPENSABLE NECESSITY

I have traveled to many wonderful places spreading the Gospel around the world with Jesse. Of course, that also means that I have packed and unpacked luggage thousands of times over the years. And although I try to pack light and get by with less stuff, my bags are always much heavier than Jesse's.

I was quite embarrassed the time that the airline placed a large "HEAVY" tag on my bag. I really hated that. In an attempt to camouflage my overweight bag, I bought one that had wheels. However, the moment always came when my gigantic bag had to be lifted. That's when Jesse always complained. Even if he isn't the one actually lifting my bag, Jesse will always ask something like, "What did you pack inside here, a bowling ball?"

Of course, people around us always laugh, but not me. I just smile and remind Jesse that I refuse to leave home without my indispensable necessities. Ladies just need more stuff!

Many years ago, I decided to take his suggestion and pack lighter for a trip. I didn't even take a small carry-on bag on the plane. Jesse was so happy! He was smiling and humming as we walked together down the long walk to the boarding area for our one-hour commercial flight home.

I'll never forget that day. It is forever burned in my memory. Why? Because we were stranded for nine hours in the Houston Airport. All flights into New Orleans were shut down because their Control Tower was damaged due to severe weather.

Needless to say, I wasn't happy about being without my indispensable necessities, and I reminded Jesse about it the entire time. Since that experience, I pack what I need and always bring a small carry-on bag with wheels, and I refuse to let Jesse carry it. That way I don't have to hear him complain about the weight of my bag.

I feel the same way about my purse. I would never consider leaving home without it. Jesse always jokes about the size of my purse and the fact that I have everything imaginable in there. But his attitude soon changes when he wants a toothpick, his wallet, sunglasses, or almost anything else that he needs. All of a sudden, he is glad that my purse is large enough to carry those indispensable necessities that we need throughout the day.

My relationship with the Lord is much more important than anything I own. He is my indispensable necessity, and I wouldn't consider doing a thing without seeking Him. Psalm 105:3 (AMPC) says, "Glory in His holy name; let the hearts of those rejoice who seek and require the Lord [as their indispensable necessity]."

Your success in life is directly related to the time spent seeking God, His strength, His face, and His presence. Psalm 105:1 (AMPC) says, "O give thanks unto the Lord, call upon His name, make known His doings among the peoples!" If you have difficulty seeking God, this powerful verse reveals three essential steps to get you started.

1. GIVE THANKS

This may seem simple, but giving thanks is essential to beginning your quest for more of God. When you seek God in prayer, you have an immediate audience with the King of Kings. Psalm 100:4 (AMPC) tells us to "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving and a thank offering and into His courts with praise! Be thankful and say so to Him, bless and affectionately praise His name!" An attitude of thanksgiving opens the door and ushers you before the face of God. If you are thankful, say so!

2. CALL UPON HIS NAME

Don't be shy—call upon His name and acknowledge Him as your Father. He loves to hear the voice of His child. Psalm 145:18-19 (AMPC) says it best: "The Lord is near to all who call upon Him, to all who call upon Him sincerely and in truth. He will fulfill the desires of those who reverently and worshipfully fear Him; He also will hear their cry and will save them."

3. MAKE KNOWN HIS DOINGS

Let it be known that God is a good God. Daily remember all the wonderful benefits that He has given to you. Psalm 103:1-5 declares that the Lord FORGIVES, HEALS, REDEEMS, BEAUTIFIES, DIGNIFIES, SATISFIES, and RENEWS your strength!

Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, O my soul; and all that is [deepest] within me, bless His holy name!

Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, O my soul, and forget not [one of] all His benefits—

Who forgives [every one of] all your iniquities, Who heals [each one of] all your diseases,

Who redeems your life from the pit and corruption, Who beautifies, dignifies, and crowns you with loving-kindness and tender mercy;

Who satisfies your mouth [your

necessity and desire at your personal age and situation] with good so that your youth, renewed, is like the eagle's [strong, overcoming, soaring]!

Psalm 103:1-5 (AMPC)

Seeking God is never difficult when you start with a thankful heart, sincerely call upon His name, and declare His great works.

When we continually seek and require the Lord, we have His promise that we will find well-timed help just when we need it (Hebrews 4:16 AMPC).

Do you crave more of God? Don't ignore it! If you are hungry for the presence of the Lord, draw near to Him and indulge. Psalm 105:4 (AMPC) says, "Seek, inquire of and for the Lord, and crave Him and His strength (His might and inflexibility to temptation); seek and require His face and His presence [continually] evermore."


