How to Run AVISION

JESSE DUPLANTIS



Do you want to become a visionary? Do you want to finish what God has called you to do? Then it's time to get motivated and gain momentum in your vision for God!

If you've got a vision to do something from God, then it will take motivation and momentum to run your vision to completion.

The Simpler the Better

God isn't trying to make life complicated for you. He keeps the vision simple and wants you to do the same. In Habakkuk 2:1-2, the Bible says, "I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what He will say unto me, and what I shall answer when I am reproved. And the Lord answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it."

Now, the vision must be written in pretty big letters if you're going to read it while you're running! If you've ever tried to jog and read at the same time, you know that it's not easy if the print is too small and the wording is too complicated.

"For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry" (Habakkuk 2:3). In other words, there is a time frame in which God has appointed the

vision to be completed. It's as if He's entered you into a race and already clocked how long it should take you.

If you are the leader and there are people called to run alongside you, then your job is to make that vision as plain as possible.

The plainer you keep it and the more you repeat it, the more others will be able to keep pace with you.

Remember, some people won't believe it's possible, but they'll still work with you because *you* believe it's possible. This means that if you're a leader, you need to *KNOW* your vision better than anybody. When you know the vision, then you are motivated to *do* what it takes, no matter *what* it takes, and run toward the vision!

Running Your Vision

Once you have established that your vision came from God, it's time to run with it. I love how verse 3 says that vision speaks. That's why I'm always talking about my vision and telling people what I'm believing for. I often say that if you're not talking about your vision, your vision is talking about you. You see, if you're not doing the talking, your vision might say, "You're too lazy. You didn't do what you were supposed to do. You're behind schedule."

Jesus, of course, was a visionary and He knew how to speak. People who are filled with vision keep talking about it. Sometimes when you speak your vision, it sounds massive and impossible to do. But the more you speak it, the more you believe it will happen. You'll get to the point where you say, "I think I can do this." At first, you may say in your head, "Oh, no way!" but the more you say it, the more you see it in the Word. And the more you surround yourself with people who walk by faith, the more the vision becomes clear and understandable. It becomes something that can be done. You'll say, "Oh, yes I can! I've got this! I've got God in my life, and I can do all things!"

When I speak about the vision God sets before me, I'm filled with joyful confidence and an attitude of expectation. That's because I know in Whom I have believed, and I'm persuaded that He is able to keep what I commit to Him against that day (2 Timothy 1:12). You have to get to know God intimately and know that He is faithful to His promises.

Now, when you start talking about your vision, you may get some persecution. People may say, "Who do you think you are? You can't do this." That's earthly-mindedness talking. Remember, you have the mind of Christ. Tell them, "It doesn't matter who I think I am. It only matters who I think God is." Don't ever let someone's small thinking affect your *big* thinking. Talk about your vision!

Believe in Yourself

A visionary must maintain a high level of thought. This is done through patience and confident anticipation. You have to anticipate that the vision is working. Sometimes my mind wants to shut me down, so I just talk louder than my mind is talking. My mind will shut up to hear what my mouth is saying.

Belief in oneself is essential to leadership, and confidence will help you to succeed at whatever you do. If you cut hair for a living, speak well of your abilities to yourself. If you're a chef, speak well of your abilities to yourself. Whatever you do, build yourself up about it and you'll do a lot better. When you have self-confidence, people pick up on that energy and are drawn to you. People want to hang around those who have some life in them, and confidence exudes strength and a joy for life. So, get to know who you are (in Christ) and where you're going (your vision).

If you don't know who you are or where you're going, you can't be an effective leader.

When you *know* in Whom you have believed, it's easy to be confident. You can be a light to the world. If you want to be on the right path in life, you need that light. And what is that light? It's the light of God and His Word in your life—it's the effect of your relationship with Him. And guess what? You don't have to be perfect to have it, but you've got to be faithful. As a leader, you need that light.

So, it's not how confident you act in the church that matters the most; it's what you do when you walk out the doors. Can you stir up the gift of God in yourself when it seems like everything is going the wrong way? Can you pull on the energy of confidence when someone says something against you? Can you live for God when you're presented with your greatest temptation? Do you believe in yourself and the God Who lives inside of you enough to refuse distraction? Can you keep up your motivation and momentum to do what God has asked you to do?

Don't Seek People's Approval

Jesus never sought the approval of His disciples. Jesus never said, "Hey, Peter! I was praying and My Father told Me this. What do you think about it? Should I do it?" No, He didn't do that. Why? Because Jesus had a destiny to complete. He had motivation and momentum, and the opinions of

people could not sway Him from doing what God had called Him to do.

If God has called you to be the pastor of a church, then you are the pastor whether other people approve of you or not! It's not your job to make people like you, it's your job to lead people in the right direction—toward God and the vision He's given you. Sure, you can listen to those God has placed under you because they may have some great ideas, but don't let yourself fall into the trap of always seeking their approval before you make a decision.

Your decisions should be based on the overall well-being of the vision that God's given you.

What they think about you should have nothing to do with your leadership. What you do may make some mad, but that's alright. If they're flowing with the vision, they're going to get to the top, too. They'll benefit later from the decisions you make now because they'll see the completion of the vision.

When Jesus started telling His disciples that He had to go to Jerusalem and suffer, die, and rise on the third day, the Bible says that Peter began to rebuke Jesus. Peter said, "Be it far from Thee, Lord: this shall not be unto Thee" (Matthew 16:22). In other words, "No! You can't do that, Jesus!" Now,

Peter was very close to Jesus and did a lot in the ministry, and yet He told Jesus *not* to do what God said.

Jesus didn't let it go any further. He said, "Get thee behind Me, Satan: thou art an offence unto Me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men" (Matthew 16:23). In other words, "Devil, SHUT UP! I'm interested in doing what God said, not what men say."

"Then said Jesus unto His disciples, If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me" (Matthew 16:24). Jesus was a leader and required others to deny themselves in order that they follow God's plan.

Peter didn't want to see the vision of God come to completion because he loved Jesus and cared for His security, but his words of sympathy were really a distraction. Jesus wouldn't allow them to take root or change His course. He immediately took dominion over the situation, subdued Peter, and went forward with what God had told Him to do.

Remember, God instituted authority to mankind in the beginning when He gave man dominion and told him to subdue (Genesis 1:28). Man's job is to subdue whatever rises up against God's Word or will in life. This means that if you're a pastor, you subdue those ideas contrary to the church's vision and well-being. If you're a company leader, you subdue those ideas that are contrary to your company's vision.

Whether it's in your church, your business, or your home, God expects Christian leaders to seek His approval and run with the vision. Like Jesus, your actions should not be based on what everybody else thinks about the situation; they should be based on God's will and the overall well-being of the vision He's given you.







I have been wanting to write you this letter for a long time, and I am so glad I finally have the chance to do it now because I have even more testimonies to share with you. Back in August of 2023, I received a letter from you in response to the letter and gift I had sent, where I asked you to come into agreement with me for debt cancellation. You agreed with me and declared abundant overflow over my life. I received your words, started believing, confessing, and sowing seeds. Nine months after I received your letter, miracles began to happen. A commercial property we had purchased years ago for \$430,000.00 was sold for \$1,700,000.00, leaving a profit of \$1,200,000.00 after paying off all the debt on the property. A few months after that, we paid off all our credit cards, which had a combined balance of about \$50,000.00. Then in December 2024, for the first time in our lives, we were able to purchase two new residences with cash, and they are now generating rental income. The miracle didn't stop there. My wife and I had a combined student loan debt of \$600,000.00, but we recently received letters confirming that the entire debt has been canceled and paid in full! Thank you so much for the sacrifices you and Pastor Cathy make so that we can receive the Good News. Thank you for never giving up, even during the most difficult times in this world.

I love listening to you. You inspire me so much. From Utahhope you come here!

I always liked Jesse Duplantis, since the '80s! He is such an innately comical person of God. Even though I have come against many pastors' teachings, I just can't seem to feel indifferent about Jesse. I just like Jesse and Cathy! They come off as very genuine, down-to-earth people; plus, they are from Louisiana! I stopped watching Jesse for years, not intentionally, but on Christmas Eve night 2024, after watching an old clip of Jesse, it brought me back to why I liked him. It's a God thing. He is bringing His people back. The worldwide web will be Jesse's biggest victory: Technology!



What do you do when trouble comes your way? Do you struggle with it? Do you turn it over in your mind so much that it weighs on your heart like a ton of bricks? Satan may attack and trouble may come, but Jesus gave us a cure that can shut all of that down—BELIEVE!

When Jesus told His disciples that He would be leaving them to go to His Father in Heaven, He saw and felt their anxiety and fear. Jesus responded with these simple, yet profound words that were the antidote that would keep them (and you and me) in His perfect peace. In John 14:1, Jesus said, "Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in Me."

Now, that's a big statement right there, because He was equating Himself to be on the same level with God Almighty. He revealed that He Himself was God manifested in the flesh—part of a Triune God, and the part of God that we can hug. Glory!

I want you to notice that when Jesus phrased the command to "Let not your heart

be troubled," He wasn't asking the disciples (or us) to try to avoid being fearful or anxious. He was letting us know right then and there that we have a choice. You see, we have complete control over how we respond to the burdens of life, and Jesus tells us how: with faith in God and faith in Him.

You see, those who believe in the Father and Christ are the true possessors of peace. The world will give you trouble and offer a dash of peace, but Jesus has given you and me His very own peace to rest in—the peace with God, the peace of God, and the peace from God. Like I often say, I define peace as the possession of adequate resources—that means nothing missing, nothing broken. And if that is true (and it is true), then my heart cannot be troubled...unless I open the door and let trouble in.

People often say, "Brother Jesse never seems to have any problems." Well, they're living in a dream world! The devil tries to attack me

ferociously, but it's like water off a duck's back to me. When trouble tries to raise its ugly head in my life, I just do like Jesus commanded and "Let not!" Is it easy? No! But I just remind myself that my faith is equal to any emergency that life may bring. I accept and stand on the revelation of my divine union with Jesus Christ and with the Father, and so I know that I'm covered no matter what! I believe in that divine union and it keeps trouble out.

Like I said, my life is not trouble free. But I have a responsible spirit and I choose to not let my heart be troubled. When people give me a bad report, the first thing that comes up from my spirit is, "Well, Jesse, whose report shall you believe?" Then I build up my faith with the Word, and I speak the report of the Lord that fits my situation.

I'll tell myself things like, "The Spirit of Truth has come and guides me into all truth" (John 16:13). "Jesus, by Your stripes I am healed" (Isaiah 53:5). "Thank You, Lord. I can do all things through Christ Who strengthens me" (Philippians 4:13). "Jesus came to give me abundant life" (John 10:10).

Listen, even though this world is a rough place, the Bible gives us the blessed hope of the return, reunion, and reception of Jesus Christ with His Bride, the Church. No matter what is going on in this world, Jesus says, "Let not your heart be troubled," and so, that's what I'm going to do.


You may say, "But look at the Middle East, Brother Jesse!" Jesus says, "Let not your heart be troubled." "Look at the environment and the natural disasters!" Jesus says, "Let not your heart be troubled." "But look at the people, Brother Jesse. Right is called wrong and wrong is called right!" Jesus says, "Let not your heart be troubled." When you are tempted to worry and be troubled, remember that Jesus gives you the way out of that mess in that same verse: "...ye believe in God, believe also in Me."

I love using faith and the Word to shut the enemy up. Afterall, he's a punk and God says he's a defeated foe under our feet. Our faith is the cure for any scheme the devil could ever conjure up. You see, faith in God is a kind of Heavenborn insight—it's a light that some do not see, a hand that others cannot feel, and a voice that others do not hear. And it's our belief in the Father and in Christ that is the real ladder to Heaven and Earth—it's the way to rise up high over any fear or anxiety that Satan tries to throw our way.

Fear is terrible and no amount of it should be tolerated. It's the opposite of faith and it's a killer. When fear and trouble have an open door to get inside of a believer, expectation in God will die. But when we choose to believe in God the Father and in Jesus Christ, great hope is activated within our hearts and creative and noble activity will follow. And, buddy, the next thing you know, you're rising high above trouble and *full* of God's supernatural peace. There's just no other choice in the matter!

As long as sin remains in the hearts of men and as long as the devil is on the earth, there will be trouble. But the Good News is that Jesus died on the cross to give you power over all the attacks of the enemy. Jesus said, "These things I have spoken unto you, that in Me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world" (John 16:33). You don't have to have anxiety even if you're going through the worst trial of your life. You can find peace today in Jesus Christ. You can choose to trust and have faith in Him because He is trustworthy. If the devil attacks you, stop fear in its tracks with your faith and remember the wonderful words of Jesus: "Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in Me."




SUITED FOR SUCCESS

Jesse and I were married on June 6, 1970, and in 2025 we will celebrate our 55th wedding anniversary. We have never separated or even considered divorce. Murder maybe, but never divorce. Haha! (I'm joking, of course!)

Jesse and I could not have been a more opposite couple. He was a bold and flashy rock entertainer, and I was a shy girl with plans of becoming an elementary school teacher. If we are asked to describe our marriage, we usually say it has been 50 years of heaven and 5 years of hell. They often laugh when they hear us say that, but our relationship before we gave our lives and marriage to Jesus was a lot like that old Neil Diamond song, "Love on the Rocks." It could have been our theme song during our first five years together.

Jesse seemed determined to do whatever he wanted and had the typical attitude of our generation: If it feels good, do it. Everything he did revolved around drugs, alcohol, and wild parties—never thinking about the consequences of his reckless lifestyle. Those early years were tough because it is very hard when only one acts like they're married. He actually let me know from the start that nothing would interfere with his plans for a successful rock music career, including me. I often tell people that we were in love with the same person—Jesse!

"...And They Shall Be One..."

We had a traditional Catholic-church wedding on the first Saturday after my high school graduation in 1970—three months before my eighteenth birthday and one month before Jesse turned twenty-one. Three days later, we loaded our wedding gifts in the back of a tiny U-Haul trailer and drove to Arlington, Texas, where Jesse had a job to play music. It wasn't long before we were traveling to a new city every two weeks, where Jesse was working six nights a week and fifty weeks a year in night clubs across the United States. I went with him to every gig (that's what he called each job) and stayed in more hotel rooms over the next five years than I care to remember.

Although we were married in church, both of us were lost as a goose in a fog and didn't realize that God had an awesome plan for our lives. His marriage plan for mankind was established in the beginning in

Genesis 2:24, "Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh."

Sounds impossible, doesn't it? How can two people that are so opposite become one? The first step for us began in May of 1973 when I asked Jesus Christ to come into my life. That was the night that I watched Billy Graham preach the Gospel on television while rocking our one-year-old daughter to sleep. It was my first glorious moment—I was surrounded and saturated with God's amazing love, and my hotel room was flooded with God's presence.

When Jesse finished playing music that night, he found me weeping before the Lord, not really understanding what had happened to me. He said that when he put his hand on the doorknob to our room, he sensed something had happened.

I began reading the Bible in the hotel, and started praying for Jesse to be saved and to discover this wonderful peace and love that I had found in Jesus.

Focus on God's Promise

Proverbs 4:25 says, "Let your eyes look right on [with fixed purpose], and let your gaze be straight before you" (AMPC). My fixed purpose was to put God first and allow His amazing love to flow through me to Jesse. I kept my gaze straight on God's promise that my husband would be WON by the conversation (godly living) of his wife (1 Peter 3:1).

Although we were married in church, both of us were lost as a goose in a fog and didn't realize that God had an awesome plan for our lives.

Now, Jesse did many things that were not deserving of my love or forgiveness, but I knew that I had to make a quality decision to walk in love and forgive. People who have heard Jesse's personal testimony are amazed to hear how awful he was before he knew Jesus. He is the first to admit that he was running away from God as fast as he could. After he gave his life to Jesus, he told me that he thought he was safe marrying a girl that had never read the Bible.

I've often been asked, "Why didn't you just leave him?" In the natural, I had every right to leave. But, I was determined to win Jesse to the Lord and refused to allow the devil to have him. It was Jesse's tough luck that he had married me. He was going to get saved whether he liked it or not!

I could not even think in terms of "if" he would be saved; it was just "when" he would be saved. I KNEW it was simply a matter of time. I KNEW God was able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that I could possibly ask or think (Ephesians 3:20). I KNEW that if I was faithful to God and did my part, God would do His part and I would receive my promise (Hebrews 11:11). I was a focused woman.

Come Out, Devil!

Jesse likes to tell everyone about the time he caught me laying hands on him to cast the devil out of him when he was sleeping. I quietly moved my fingers over his pillow and very lightly touched his head as I whispered, "Devil, come out of him in the name of Jesus!" He usually slept hard and I didn't expect him to hear me, but he did. Really, though, at that point I didn't care if he did wake up; I was a desperate woman. I decided to use the weapons available to me.


I fervently contended for Jesse's salvation, standing in proxy for him whenever I went to church, and enlisted every Christian that I met to pray with me in Jesus' name. I rebuked the devil from blinding his eyes to the light of the Gospel and commanded laborers of the harvest to go forth and minister salvation to him. I knew that it was God's will for all to be saved and prayed for God's will to be done on the earth as it is in heaven.

I will never forget that Saturday night on Labor Day weekend in 1974, when I asked Jesse to watch a Billy Graham Evangelistic Crusade on television with me. He said, "Why would I want to do that?" My reply shocked him, "Well, he pulls more people than you do—he must be saying something!" He still had a few minutes before he had to leave to perform in the nightclub with his rock band that night, so he glanced over at the television in our hotel room. Those thousands of people packed in an outdoor stadium to hear Billy Graham really captured Jesse's attention and sat on the edge of the bed to listen.

During that glorious moment, my prayers for Jesse's salvation were answered. He went into the bathroom to be alone, and God got in there with him. Jesse gave his life to Jesus and took his first step toward God's wonderful plan for our lives. (You can see why television ministry is such an important part of our life and ministry!) He was instantly delivered from sin, drugs, and alcohol addiction. Glory to God!

"...Stand Fast in One Spirit..."

For the first time in our lives, we really understood what it meant to be "one flesh." God was knitting our hearts together in Him, and we understood what it meant to "...stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the Gospel" (Philippians 1:27). When a husband and wife stand side by side in



their covenant relationship with God, nothing is impossible. Only God can bring two people who are so opposite and make them one flesh.

Now, I am not saying we agreed on every single thing from that moment on. We are still opposites. Jesse and I often disagree about many things. Being "one flesh" doesn't mean we lost our individuality. Both of us have strong opinions and we get frustrated when the other doesn't see things in the same way. But we are learning to recognize our individual strengths and always arrive at the best decision when we take the time to talk things out. Sometimes we talk louder than other times. I have told Jesse, "I am anointed to help you! So, listen to me!" Occasionally it works.

A Heavenly Relationship

God's Word is filled with wisdom for heavenly marriage relationships. In Mark 11:25-26, Jesus taught us to forgive regardless of who is right or wrong. That is not fun, but it will empower us to live a faith-filled, victorious life. Jesse and I have learned to never to go to bed angry—we never give the devil a foothold. Ephesians 4:26-27 (AMPC) says, "When angry, do not sin; do not ever let your wrath (your exasperation, your fury or indignation) last until the sun goes down. Leave no [such] room or foothold for the devil [give no opportunity to him]."

After all these years with the same person, I have learned a few things. Proverbs 14:1 says, "Every wise woman buildeth her house: but the foolish plucketh it down with her hands." I know the words that can bring us closer together and strengthen our relationship. I also know the words that can drive us apart and tear down all that we have built together.

The Word of God is packed with powerful scriptures that are filled with wisdom for husband and wife relationships. The following two passages have meant so much to me over the years, and I pray they will be an encouragement to you, too:

> However, let each man of you [without exception] love his wife as [being in a sense] his very own self; and let the wife see that she respects and

reverences her husband [that she notices him, regards him, honors him, prefers him, venerates, and esteems him; and that she defers to him, praises him, and loves and admires him exceedingly].

Ephesians 5:33 (AMPC)

Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous:

Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing.

1 Peter 3:7-9 (Also read this in the Amplified Bible, Classic Edition—it is powerful!)


Making a commitment to the kind of love described in these passages will have far reaching benefits. It will help you love one another completely, look beyond faults, enjoy each other, and fulfill God's plan for your life.

Psalm 119:130 says, "The entrance of Thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple." God wants to pour His light on our lives and help us to understand how to have great relationships. In fact, this is the first key to any good relationship, whether it be a marriage, friendship, family member, or business associate.

Keep God first in your life and trust Him to guide you by His Spirit and His Word. He can show you how you can speak words that bring life and understanding instead of division. You can have relationships that are heavenly!
