

Faith. Now there's a word that many actually consider to be a message that is at odds with God. But really, it's just about believing what God said.

Faith isn't a "message" really. It's not a "movement" either. While there are some ministers who seem to specialize in preaching faith, they didn't make it up. Faith isn't some new teaching. God put the "believing and receiving" system into effect, and Jesus made the term popular. Anyone can read the Gospels and see that.

The theme of faith, or trusting God, is intertwined throughout the whole Bible, from Genesis to Revelation. But even though faith appears throughout the Bible, it isn't the *only* thing in the Bible. Think about it. How many times do you read about grace in the Word? What about mercy? Or how about God's love?

On the other hand, even though faith isn't the *only* topic in the Bible, it seems to be mixed up with just about everything else in there. In fact, for faith to work at all, you need to be walking in God's love (Galatians 5:6).

So even though faith isn't the only area you need to study in the Word, it is crucial to your success as a believer. It is important that you know about it, not just as some part of the Charismatic lingo but as a real and viable power tool for your life. Faith is God's key to breaking the power of natural law.

You've Got a Built-in *Substance* Designed to Connect With God's Word

Now I want you to think about it. What is it that makes you believe God's Word is true? *Faith* in God's Word. What makes you think you get righteousness by believing in your heart that Jesus rose from the dead? Faith in God's Word. What makes you think you can get salvation by confessing with your mouth Jesus as your Lord? Again, it is faith in God's Holy Word.

Why do you believe? Because something inside the very core of your being connects to the Word. You read it or someone tells you about it, and something clicks within you. You know that it is true. How do you know?

You know because God placed a substance inside you that was designed to be stimulated when confronted with His Word. What is that something? It is the amazing substance the Bible calls faith. Faith isn't floating around in the atmosphere somewhere; it's in you. The Bible says that *every* person is given the measure of faith (Romans 12:3).

God didn't leave you out when He was handing out faith. That is why you can read a Scripture, and suddenly it hits home. You get a "revelation," as they say. You recognize a Scripture for what it *really* means. That is

when your measure of faith jumps up inside of you and says, *I see what God meant, and I know that this stuff is true!* That is when, all of a sudden, you accept it as *more* than just a fact. You accept it as the truth. You believe it. And suddenly you receive it.

Suddenly!

For years I've said that *suddenly* is one of my favorite words in the Bible. I like excitement, and suddenly is sure more exciting than eventually, don't you think?

Regardless of how it appears, healing, for example, really does come suddenly. Again, consider salvation. Salvation doesn't take two years. It happens suddenly. The Bible says that there are some who are saved **as by fire** (1 Corinthians 3:15). In other words, they are about to bust hell wide open, but at the last minute they open their hearts to receive salvation, and *wham!* *Suddenly* the blood of Jesus gushes in and redeems them! *Suddenly* they are stolen from the hand of the enemy and reborn as children of God!

At the very last moment, they call on the name of Jesus, sidestep the heat of hell, and are ushered into the kingdom of heaven! *Whew!* That's what you call a close call! Thank God that His blood can redeem even until the last millisecond of a person's life.

Healing isn't much different when it comes to making that connection with God.

The Word Stimulates Faith, And Faith Activates Power!

There is a *connection* that takes place when the Word of God stimulates the measure of faith inside of you. The Word of God is alive. It is living and active (Hebrews 4:12). And the faith you have inside of you was given to you by the living God who inspired the Scriptures we have today.

When you connect the measure of faith with God's Word, something extraordinary happens. Faith and the Word collide, and *wham!* an atmosphere for the supernatural is instantly formed. Suddenly, the power to break natural law is present.

Suddenly, you experience that mysterious thing called receiving; the time when the blood of Jesus begins to gush in, the time when the very power of God is drawn into your physical body, obliterating sickness and disease. It is a combination of faith and the Word that activates God's power within your life. And it doesn't take years to happen. It can take place in an instant.

This is why Jesus said you could move mountains with your faith. He said that if you'd only believe you could say, "Move!" to a mountain and it would fall into

the sea (Mark 11:23). I don't believe that was just a poetic way of saying, "Major stuff happens when you use faith." I believe that Jesus used those particular words because they symbolized *your* ability to break natural law. After all, who can deny that natural law would have to be broken in order to send a mountain flying into the sea?

There Is a Huge Difference Between Mountains and Mustard Seeds

Jesus said you could move something as large as a mountain with something as small as a mustard seed (Matthew 17:20). Now, He used the analogy of a mustard seed because it was the smallest of the seeds people planted in His day. It is tiny. You practically have to squint to see a mustard seed. But a mountain? How can you *not* see it? You can't even see around a mountain. It's so big that you can only see one side. If it's sticking out of the sea, it is even bigger because the thing goes down into the ocean! It's so big, it sits on the floor of the ocean!

Compare that mountain to a seed so small you've got to squint to see the details of it. Big difference, right?

Well, that's the ratio Jesus laid out between faith and your problems. Even if you've got to squint to get a look at your faith, it's enough to plow through a gigantic problem you can't see around. No matter how huge, deep-rooted and twisted that problem is, all you need is an itty-bitty speck of faith to start it on its descent into the sea.

It's Now Faith Is—Not Is Faith Now?

What is faith anyway? The Bible calls faith the substance of what you hope for and the evidence of what you don't see (Hebrews 11:1). In other words, you're saying, "Jesus, I believe You can and will do this thing that I hope for. And because I believe that You can and will, I take Your Word as evidence that it is already done."

That's what you call trust! You're trusting that God's Word will work for you. You are trusting in it so much that you don't even consider that what you hope for *might not* happen. "Of course it is going to happen!" you might say. "We're talking about God here!" Now, if you're thinking like that, you're going in the right direction.

The King James Version's definition of faith goes like this:

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good report. Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

Hebrews 11:1-3

God used faith to create the worlds. He used it to create you! The fact that you're here at all is evidence that God had faith! That ought to tell you something!

I think a lot of people negotiate with the things of God, choosing one instead of the other when the potential is there to receive all from God. What happens if you negotiate around the truth that Jesus delivers? You could get stuck fighting off miserable things like depression or addiction.

And what happens if you negotiate around the truth that Jesus blesses abundantly? You could miss out on God's plan for your earthly success. You could stay broken by poverty or limit God's ability to bless others through you.

And healing? What if you negotiate around the truth that Jesus heals? Yeah, you got it. You could remain bound by sickness and the freedom of living healthy. But faith is faith no matter whether it is put in God's power to save, deliver, prosper or heal, or if it is put in Satan's power to steal, kill and destroy.

Some people make faith hard. Instead of trusting in **Now faith is**, they say, "Is faith *now*?" They change the words and confuse themselves. But it is in black and white right there in the Bible, so don't let those people confuse you! If you hear someone say, "That faith stuff isn't for today," remind yourself of Hebrews 11:1 and then ask yourself, "When is *now*? Is now tomorrow? Is now yesterday?" Then answer yourself, "No! Now isn't in the past! It's in the immediate present. Now means now! It happens *suddenly*. **Now faith is!**!"

When You're Hungry, When Do You Want to Eat?

When you're sleepy, when do you want to sleep? Later? When you hear your stomach growling, you don't say, "Hmm. I'm starving. I think I'll eat in a couple of days."

I don't know about you, but if I'm sleepy, I want to take a nap! And if my stomach is stabbing me and growling like an animal, it can mean only one thing: It's time to chow down! Give me something to eat before I devour the next thing that moves.

You can attack sickness in much the same way. You can say to yourself, "I'm not waiting forever for my healing! I'm going to do everything in my power to get this thing done! I'm going to do my part, and God is going to do His; and between the both of us, I'm getting healed!"

It may sound kind of childlike to be demanding like that, but really, that's what it takes! If you look throughout the Scriptures, you can find stories of people who were demanding and received. Jesus responds to people who have enough faith to draw from His power.

Childlike but Not Childish

Kids have a great understanding of the word *now*. That is why you hear so much about childlike faith. Think of the way a child acts, and you've got a good idea about the essence of faith. For example, when a kid sees a piece of candy at the checkout counter in a grocery store, he zeros in on it and commands you to do what? Produce!

That child locks his little mind on that candy, and buddy, you'd better *know* that he isn't asking for it next week! When is the time for candy? *Now* is the time for candy! Baby wants it now! Do you understand what I mean? If you've ever dealt with a kid having a candy fit at the checkout counter, I'm sure that you understand what I mean.

Breaking the power of natural law through faith is much the same way—it has all the elements of childlike faith and tenacity without the childish tendency toward whining and complaining. It is about realizing that power flows *now* and *suddenly* and that you don't give up if something doesn't go perfectly along the way.

Childlike faith is about sticking to it until you make the connection with God's Word and draw on the blood of Jesus. It's not about *when* you get healed; it's about realizing that by His stripes you *were* healed (Isaiah 53:5). You've got to know in your heart that "were healed" can change "are sick." Stop and think about that for a moment.

The grown-up in you talks away the issue. The grown-up looks at the facts so much that he misses the truth. As adults we are taught *not* to be childlike but to give up on our dreams, be logistical and never take what people say literally. Basically, we're taught to give up our childlike faith in favor of cold, hard facts and cynicism. But Jesus didn't tell us to do that. He didn't instruct us to act that way at all.

Jesus told us and showed us through His example that we should strive to have childlike faith. He showed us through His example that we should hit the root of problems instead of wading around in logistics. Throughout His life, Jesus continually shoved rules and regulations out of the way and spoke on the heart of matters.

If you think about it, that's exactly what children do. They don't have to know the methods of making candy in order to enjoy it! They don't care how much corn syrup it takes to create a cherry-flavored lollipop. They just grab that sucker and start licking and chewing until that thing is gone!

That is what you do with the Word of God too. You just keep taking it in until it's *within* you, until it's a part of you. You may be a person whose childlike faith is easily

tapped. You may be a person who can put aside logistics and believe pretty quickly. Consequently, you may also receive quickly.

Or you may be like a lot of others who need to hear a bit more of the Word to help stimulate their childlike faith. You may need to wade through some of the “adult” thinking and get into the habit of using the childlike faith God put in you.

After all, you don’t have to know exactly how an engine runs to drive a car and get where you’re going. You don’t have to know all about gravity and the law of lift to ride in a jet. All you really need to know is that God’s Word is for you and if you believe it, it can simply work a miracle for you—regardless of the complications of the situation.

You Need the Prayer of Others

If you’re sick, you don’t have to face it alone. Not only is Jesus inside of you, but you’ve got people all around you who are willing to pray the prayer of faith for you. James 5:14-16 instructs you on exactly what to do if you get sick:

Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: and the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

In other words, the prayers of the righteous work!

There are people walking in the gifts of the Spirit in the Church today—as described in 1 Corinthians 12:8-11,28—and also many good churches with pastors and teachers who believe in healing and are willing to lay hands on you and pray the prayer of faith.

Don’t Be Bashful! Get Yourself to the Altar for Prayer!

I know of some people who have talked about healing so much that they’re embarrassed when sickness tries to attach itself to their bodies. I know some preachers who leave their hometown when they’re sick because they’re afraid their congregation will find out. They’re scared of what the “faith crowd” will think about them if they admit to being sick.

That’s crazy. Don’t let pride keep you from having other believers pray with you. You know, I believe in

healing. And I’m healthy. But I’ve had sickness try to attach itself to me, and do you know what I’ve done about it? I’ve fought it with my faith and my will. I’ve spoken good things over myself. But I’m not afraid to say, “Hey! Pray for me! The devil’s attacking my body.”

Yeah, I’m a faith preacher. And yeah, sometimes I need prayer. Big deal. Nobody on this earth is perfect. Sometimes the devil tries to knock us in the head. But that isn’t any reason to skip town and pretend like nothing bad ever happens. This is a way that people are robbed of one of the most important facets of healing—the power of united prayer.

Many years ago now, I had a problem in my body that was really getting on my nerves. It happened after I ate some ten-year-old Vienna sausages. Yeah, I know I should have looked at the date on the can. But my wife wasn’t home and I was looking for something to munch on. You know, my wife doesn’t cook much, so you can bet she hadn’t been cleaning out the pantry. I found that little can of poison lurking in the back corner of the pantry.

I peeled open the can, grabbed a sausage, slugged the jellied fat off of it and went to chomping. Big mistake. That sausage tried to murder me! I got choked up and couldn’t breathe. I got dizzy, the room started spinning, and I could hardly walk straight. After the initial symptoms, I still had to fight the devil tooth and nail over what that sausage did to my body! I know that eating ten-year-old sausage was my own fault, but thank God, God had grace—and here I am today!

Now, I’m not a man to show much weakness. I guess that is a product of my upbringing. I’m not one to blab my problems to people. I figure Jesus can take care of it. But sometimes you need other people to pray with you. And when those times come, I’m not above asking for prayer. Faith preacher or not, if I’m sick, I want somebody to believe with me. I want somebody to pray for me because the prayer of a righteous man avails much.

I know quite a few righteous men. But I’ve got one friend with whom I feel the most comfortable talking about what I need from God. He is a great man of faith whom I admire. He’s older than I am and has been saved longer than I have. And he has shown me time and time again that he actually gives a flip about what happens to me. I think God must tell him when to call me and let me know he’s praying for me, because sometimes I’m blockheaded and won’t tell other people I need prayer. But this guy is in touch with God!

After the sausage incident, a nagging problem kept trying to surface. I’d get dizzy for no reason. I told my wife

about it and mentioned it a few times in passing. Then one day I got a call from my friend. I was scheduled for a routine physical, and I was trying to avoid it because, well, I wasn't looking forward to some of the tests they do. He called me one day to talk to me about it.

This friend of mine said, "Jesse, you need to get down there to get that physical. And listen, don't worry if they find something. You've got faith. Together we can whip this thing."

I thought, *Look at this here! Somebody is calling to encourage me!*

I said, "I know, and I'm not worried about it! I'm going!"

I went and got a clean bill of health. The doctor told me I was so healthy that I was in the top 20 percent of the nation! I thought, *I could have told you that.* He told me that the dizziness was an allergy and let me know that sometimes people start getting allergies in middle age.

Middle-age allergies? I thought, *Not me, Jack! I'm fighting this thing!*

So I started walking out my healing like the lepers did in Luke 17:14: *"And it came to pass, that as they went, they were cleansed."* And I did it by faith, knowing that in the process I would be healed of allergies.

That is God's plan for you and me. You might be a brand-new baby Christian. You may be a faith preacher like me. You may be a person of great faith who is having a hard time receiving healing for yourself. Regardless of your position in Christ, I want to let you know that you can walk out your healing like the lepers and be healed in the process. You can walk by faith!

So don't be bashful to ask for prayer. Don't be embarrassed if something has gotten ahold of your body. So what! Be tenacious! Be bold! Have faith, and get to the altar for prayer. Let somebody lay hands on you and pray the prayer of faith. Call friends who won't poor-mouth your situation, and ask them to stand with you. God has many warriors who can stand with you in prayer.

I'll tell you what my friend told me:

"Don't worry. You've got faith. Together we can whip this thing!"

You and God can whip this thing for good!


"I pray this prayer to the Father, in the name of Jesus. Amen!"





Praying for HEALING

Healing is for today. It did not pass away with the disciples or stop when Jesus left the earth. His plan was that we continue praying for healing by laying hands on the sick and watch them recover. However, healing is not just a New Testament experience that began with the ministry of Jesus and continued through His disciples. Healing has always been an established truth of the Bible.

Even though the curse of sickness came into the earth through Adam's disobedience, healing was still available by faith. Why else would Abraham pray for it? Genesis 20:17 says, "So Abraham prayed unto God: and God healed Abimelech, and his wife, and his maid-servants; and they bare children." Apparently, Abraham knew that healing was God's will for mankind.

Regardless of any personal experience, the Bible must be our final authority that healing belongs to us. In Exodus 15:26, God is revealed as our Healer: "...I am the *LORD Who heals you*" (NKJV). When we follow His instructions in Deuteronomy 7:15, God's promise to us is that He, "...will take away from you all sickness" (NKJV). And Isaiah 53:4-5 boldly declares, "Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows...and by His stripes we are healed" (NKJV). The Bible has many more promises and

examples that clearly establish that our God has made healing available to His children by faith. Healing is a settled fact.

God Is Willing

However, the first step is realizing that it is *always* God's will to heal. The Word of God settled this issue in Matthew 8:2-3: "And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped Him,

saying, Lord, if Thou wilt, Thou canst make me clean. And Jesus put forth His hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed."

Like most people, the question of the leper to Jesus was not, "Can You heal me?" There was no doubt in the leper's mind about Jesus' power to heal. He must have heard about many other great miracles of healing, and was convinced that Jesus *was able* make him clean from that horrible disease. His only concern that day was *"if Thou wilt."* Jesus settled the issue once and for all with a simple statement, *"I will."*

Jesse and I know that faith begins where the will of God is known. We accept the fact that the Word of God is final authority on the subject of healing. This is why you will never hear us say, "if it be Your will" when praying for healing. Although it may sound very holy and religious to close a prayer that way, it's a lethal statement when it is attached to the prayer of faith.

However, like I mentioned in chapter 3, when seeking God's will about a matter, the prayer of consecration could contain the question, "if it be your will." In the Garden of Gethsemane, Jesus sweat drops of blood as He fervently prayed, "...Father, if Thou be willing, remove this cup from Me: nevertheless not My will, but Thine, be done" (Luke 22:42). When Jesus prayed this prayer of consecration, it had absolutely nothing to do with healing.

Healing: The Family Business

When I was about fifteen years old, I worked at a small, family-owned pastry shop that made the best donuts in town. It was my job to make sure that the glass display cases were sparkling clean, the floors were mopped at the end of the day, and, of course, to sell those donuts. It was great experience for me, and as my brother Deril used to say, "I made a lot of dough!"

The husband and wife that owned the shop were hard-working people. They were up at the crack of dawn six days a week, mixing, baking, and icing delicate creations that filled the sparkling display cases. The success of their shop was directly related to the amount of dedication and commitment that they were willing to put into their family business.

As part of God's family, the work that we do for Him is very serious business. We must be dedicated to serving Him and committed to doing His will in order to successfully reach the world with the Gospel. It is our job to follow Jesus' example and be about our Father's business!

We all know the story about Jesus astounding the teachers in the temple when He was only twelve years old.

The Bible says that, *"All who heard Him were astonished and overwhelmed with bewildered wonder at His intelligence and understanding and His replies"* (Luke 2:47 AMPC).

But the part of this story that always sticks with me is the answer that Jesus gave His parents after they had been searching frantically for Him for three days. He said to them, *"How is it that you had to look for Me? Did you not see and know that it is necessary [as a duty] for Me to be in My Father's house and [occupied] about My Father's business. But they did not comprehend what He was saying to them"* (Luke 2:49-50 AMPC).

Jesus knew His purpose for coming to the earth and was very serious about His Father's business. Everything He said and everything He did was in direct obedience to the will of His Father. Jesus came to destroy the works of the devil and bring abundant life to the world.

Open for Business

After thirty years of preparation, Jesus made His formal announcement to the world that He was open for business. He walked into the synagogue of His hometown of Nazareth and boldly proclaimed:

The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon Me because He has anointed me [the Anointed One, the Messiah] to preach the good news (the Gospel) to the poor; He has sent Me to announce release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to send forth as delivered those who are oppressed [who are downtrodden, bruised, crushed, and broken down by calamity],

To proclaim the accepted and acceptable year of the Lord [the day when salvation and the free favors of God profusely abound].

Luke 4:18-19 (AMPC)

Now, you would think that the people in Jesus' hometown would have rejoiced when Jesus announced, *"Today this scripture has been fulfilled while you are present and hearing"* (v. 21). The Anointed One had come with Good News: The poor did not have to be poor anymore! The poor, oppressed, bruised, captive, and blind people in that synagogue should have lined up for their miracle. But even though they marveled at His words, they rejected His message. All they could think about was, *"Is not this Joseph's son?"* (v. 22). As a result, they missed their day of visitation. They missed out on all of the marvelous things that God wanted to do for them that day.

A Family Tradition

Throughout the Bible we see that God has always provided healing for His people. Psalm 103:3 reveals a God "...who heals all your diseases." And Psalm 105:37 reminds us that when God led the children of Israel out of Egypt, there was "...not one feeble person among their tribes."

While on the earth, Jesus sent out the twelve disciples and gave them power to bring healing to their generation (Luke 9:1-2). Later, Jesus sent out seventy more with the message of the Gospel and to heal all. They went from house to house and village to village, spreading this powerful message to their generation and healing those that were sick and oppressed of the devil (Luke 10:1, 8-9).

Just like the disciples and the seventy others, God can use you to tell those you meet that they don't have to remain sick, poor, and oppressed. No matter what the enemy says, Jesus has put that lying devil out of business forever! If the devil tries to shut down healing, you can tell him to keep his nose out of your business. After all, healing is none of his business!

The world needs to know that Jesus Christ has come to give abundant life to all that receive Him. He is still in the business of saving the lost and healing the sick. He is just looking for those that will carry on the family business and spread His good news about healing to all. Will you be one that He can use?

Paul's Thorn: Trouble

Whenever you make a solid stand on the will of God concerning healing, someone usually brings up Paul's thorn in the flesh—saying he was sickly. However, in 2 Corinthians 12:7 (AMPC) Paul wrote, *"And to keep me from being puffed up and too much elated by the exceeding greatness (preeminence) of these revelations, there was given me a thorn (a splinter) in the flesh, a messenger of Satan, to rack and buffet and harass me, to keep me from being excessively exalted."*

Paul was very specific about how he was buffeted by this nasty thorn:

Of the Jews five times received I forty stripes save one.

Thrice was I beaten with rods, once was I stoned, thrice I suffered shipwreck, a night and a day I have been in the deep;

In journeyings often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils by mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils

in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren;

In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness...

In Damascus the governor under Aretas the king kept the city of the Damascenes with a garrison, desirous to apprehend me:

And through a window in a basket was I let down by the wall, and escaped his hands.

2 Corinthians 11:24-27, 32-33

In several chapters before this passage, Paul had already described how he was overcoming troubling situations that had come to him because he preached the Gospel of Jesus Christ. In 2 Corinthians 4:8-9 he wrote, *"We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed."* Although Paul did not deny all the trouble, he was determined to focus on the faith side instead of the attacks.

I am not saying that Paul was never attacked in his flesh or never needed to be personally healed. Remember the snake bite? The people standing around expected him to swell up and die, but Paul shook it off in the fire and wasn't harmed at all. We can see in the Word that no matter what type of attack the devil launched, Paul overcame it. In 2 Timothy 3:10-11 (AMPC), Paul boldly wrote his testimony of victory: *"Now you have closely observed and diligently followed my teaching, conduct, purpose in life, faith, patience, love, steadfastness, persecutions, sufferings—such as occurred to me at Antioch, at Iconium, and at Lystra, persecutions I endured, but out of them all the Lord delivered me."*

Following Jesus' Example

The ministry of Jesus revealed the truth about healing throughout the Gospels. In Matthew 4:23, we are told, *“And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the Gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.”* Each time Jesus would teach and preach the Gospel of the kingdom, healing was the result.

Think about the time when doctors of the law from every town of Galilee, Judaea, and Jerusalem were gathered to hear Jesus. Luke 5:17 says, *“...and the power of the Lord was present to heal them.”* Notice that the healing power of God was *present* to touch every person in that jam-packed house, but not one of them tapped into the life-force of God. All that power was just waiting for someone to make a demand on it and get healed.

Thankfully, a crippled man was carried to the meeting by four determined and dedicated friends that were ready to do whatever it took to get him to Jesus. They seemed to know that healing would be the result of the teaching and preaching of Jesus. They were right!

When they arrived with their sick friend, the house was so packed with preachers that they had to crack open the tiles of the roof to let their friend down in front of Jesus.

And, behold, men brought in a bed a man which was taken with a palsy: and they sought means to bring him in, and to lay him before Him.

And when they could not find by what way they might bring him in because of the multitude, they went upon the housetop, and let him down through the tiling with his couch into the midst before Jesus...

I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house.

And immediately he rose up before them, and took up that whereon he lay, and departed to his own house, glorifying God.

Luke 5:18-19, 24-25

I just love that story. It shows how very important it is for us to be connected to people of faith that know how to access the healing power of God. When you need a healing or any other miracle from God, we need to be surrounded by those that teach healing is for today and that healing belongs to us—it is our covenant right as born-again believers in Jesus Christ.

Jesse and I have a similar determination, like the four radical friends in Luke 5:18. Our staff is also the same way. We realize that the Great Commission of Jesus Christ in Mark 16:15-20 also included healing. Verse 18 says, *“...they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover,”* and we expect that to happen. As a result, we have received countless testimonies of recorded miracles of healing.


Each day, we are using every available tool to proclaim that Jesus is the same yesterday, today, and forever—He is still willing and able to heal all that come to Him. People have been healed through our ministry products, television broadcasts, and through the programs and teachings on our website, app, and social media platforms. I ONLY SAY WHAT FAITH SAYS. I ONLY USE MY FAITH VOICE.

**Below is an excerpt from Jesse Duplantis' February letter to JDM Covenant Partners. Partners are those who support the ministry's vision of world evangelism with donations and/or product orders, and they receive a letter each month from Brother Jesse sharing what God has put on his heart. We hope you enjoy reading a portion of this month's letter and will consider becoming a Partner in JDM's vision of world evangelism.*

Dear Partners,


Things are moving very quickly here at the ministry—no grass grows under our feet, as they say! We're busy reaching people and changing lives, one soul at a time, just like our mission statement says. Let's get into our theme for 2026 right now.

I Only Say What Faith Says. I Only Use My Faith Voice.

In Romans 4:16-17, it talks about faith and I want you to see the context—but notice what I put in boldface type because that is the scriptural foundation for this year's theme: *"Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all, (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before Him Whom he believed, even God, Who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were."*

To me? That passage above is as good as it gets when explaining faith. It's telling us that the promise of blessing on Abraham's life is for us—not just those of us who are in the actual biological lineage of Abraham, but for those of us who have the *faith* of Abraham.

The scripture lets us know exactly what Abraham's kind of faith was too. He believed God—in the manner of God—choosing to *" calleth those things which be not as though they were"* until they came to pass. You see, faith listens to what God says, and then says it too. Faith talks like it's already a done deal. Faith believes the end from the beginning, as if the promise has already come to pass. And like our theme says, faith speaks! Faith *" calleth,"* which is why our theme this year is, *"I Only Say What Faith Says. I Only Use My Faith Voice."*

I want to give you a wonderful example of the faith voice from the Word. The story of the prophet Elisha and the Shunammite woman from 2 Kings chapter four is about a woman who'd been barren but had a miracle son in her old age after Elisha had prophesied it over her. When the boy grew up, he was working out in the field with his father during harvest time when he cried out in pain over his head suddenly hurting. They brought the boy to his mother, and it wasn't long before he died right on her lap. The Shunammite woman immediately headed out to see Elisha. She wanted a miracle, and the scripture tells us that her soul was vexed over her boy's sudden death.

Now, you can read the whole story for yourself again, but I want you to notice her *words*. Before she even saddled up the donkey to head out to see Elisha to tell him the problem, this woman says, *"It shall be well"* (2 Kings 4:23). The Shunammite woman had decided to *" calleth those things which be not as though they were"* about her dead son, whom she loved so dearly. What was she doing? Even in the intensity of heartache, this woman was speaking the *answer*.

The thing I want you to notice the most is this: She went from *"It shall be well"* in verse 23 when answering her husband's questions to *"It is well"* in verse 26 when she gets to the prophet Elisha and is answering his questions. Notice that nothing had happened to the boy between those verses. He was just as dead when she said, *"It shall be well"* as he was when she said, *"It is well."* But something had shifted in the woman—she stopped putting off the answer to her faith. The Shunammite woman moved her faith into the now.

So, point one today is this: **When you remember God, your faith will turn your heart and eyes to Heaven.** I believe that between verses 23 and 26, that woman's faith kicked in—she took out all the delay. She said what she *wanted* and not what she had. Partner, everyone wants "now" answers, but they forget how God works. They forget how faith works.


Don't forget the way faith works. As long as you remember, God will remember. His Word will not return unto Him void, but it can return to *you* void if you don't believe it. Remember Abraham. Remember the Shunammite woman. Tune out all the other voices in life and tune into your faith voice.

FEBRUARY CONFessions OF FAITH

- Faith remembers God—I will turn my heart and eyes to Heaven, the place where every good thing comes from.
- Faith has a voice—I will imitate my Father and "*calleth those things which be not as though they were*" (Rom. 4:17).
- Faith "calleth" and faith speaks—I will tune my ear to what God says in the Word and say it, too.
- Faith speaks the answer, and not just the problem—I will say what I want, and not what I have.
- Like Abraham, I believe God's promises. Like the Shunammite woman, "*It is well*" with me (2 Kings 4:26).
- Like Abraham, I speak the end from the beginning. Like the Shunammite woman, I tune into my faith voice.
- I tune out the opinions of others and the doubts of the mind—my faith turns my heart and eyes to Heaven!
- My faith is based on God and His Word—I pray the Word, study the Word, and quote it to myself daily.
