

There's *Overwhelming* Power in Your Seed

JESSE DUPLANTIS

There is overwhelming power in seed, not just physically, but spiritually and even in the financial area of life. I believe that our future is in our seed. I believe that our legacy is not determined merely by what we do in life, but it is determined by what we leave behind in life for others. Every area is touched by the power of seed.

The greatest miracle God can give any individual is children. It doesn't matter if they're short, tall, fat, skinny, ugly, or pretty—they are little miracles. Within your children are your grandparents, your parents, and you. And when you go home to be with the Lord, they are the part of you that will still be on the Earth. It's powerful!

In life, I've found that everything God seems to do starts with seed. He wants us to do something first, and then we reap the benefits. In the financial area, many people have misunderstandings about sowing seeds because so many leaders have been abusive in this area. But the whole key to financial seed is that God is trying to get something *to* you, not take something *from* you.

The Bible says that God created this world to work by the laws of sowing and reaping. Genesis 8:22 says, *"While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease."*

I've decided in my life that I'm going to live with this knowledge: My future is in my seed. I've decided that I'm going to live by my giving.

The Falling Seed

Jesus' Parable of the Sower in Mark chapter four is familiar to many Christians, but there is always more that we can learn from this amazing passage. Read it with me now.

"Hearken; Behold, there went out a sower to sow: And it came to pass, as he sowed, some fell by the way side, and the fowls of the air came and devoured it up. And some fell on stony ground, where it had not much earth; and immediately it sprang up, because it had no depth of earth: But when the sun was up, it was scorched; and because it had no root, it withered away. And some fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up, and choked it, and it yielded no fruit. And other fell on good ground, and did yield fruit that sprang up and increased; and brought forth, some thirty, and some sixty, and some an hundred" (Mark 4:3-8).

Do you want a future? Look at your seed. What are you giving? Where is it going and what's it doing? Is the soil you're sowing into rocky or thorny? Or is it good? This parable is Jesus' teaching about the importance of soil.

The sower *did* something—he made a decision to sow. This parable also tells us that some of his seed wasn't actually *sown* at all. Some of it *fell* by the wayside, some of it *fell* into stony and shallow ground, and some of it *fell* into a thicket of thorns. And, of course, some of it *fell* on good ground.

I want you to see that although this parable deals with *fallen seed*, each portion of seed did something different. Some of it was lost to the birds, some was lost to the sun and the dense earth with thorns, but some of it sprang up and increased. It brought forth a harvest just because of the nature of the soil it fell into.

So, what is fallen seed? It's anything you didn't really intend to sow. It's what you didn't intend or *purpose* to give, but you did it anyway. There is a risk when you sow like that. Those seeds stand a chance of falling into a patch that just won't produce. Then again, you also stand a chance of those

seeds falling into good ground where the soil is fertile, making it spring forth thirty, sixty, and a hundredfold!

Remember, sowing applies to every area of life—spiritually, physically, *and* financially.

What Does It Mean?

When the disciples didn't understand this parable, Jesus told them, "...*Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God: but unto them that are without, all these things are done in parables: That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and their sins should be forgiven them. And He said unto them, Know ye not this parable? and how then will ye know all parables? The sower soweth the word*" (Mark 4:11-14).

The Parable of the Sower holds the mystery of the kingdom of God, according to Jesus. He said that this mystery has been given to us so that we might *know* it... and *sow* it, too. He gave His disciples understanding about sowing and reaping because life *is* sowing, life *is* giving, and life *is* receiving.

The Christian life is about the Word—it's about living by the Word, giving by the Word, and receiving by the Word. Whatever is *in* the Word is what we are to believe and put our faith in. Sowing the Word is about telling others the truth of the scriptures and not letting the devil get us into doubt about it.

I love how Jesus put it, and this is my paraphrase, "Boys, if you don't get this, you're not gonna understand anything else!" You see, salvation is available because God sowed. Think about it: "*For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life*" (John 3:16).

How do you get saved? By understanding and accepting God's Seed—Jesus Christ. The divine principle that God sowed His Son, Jesus Christ, and expected to harvest Christians is the foundation of the Christian faith.

The reason Jesus came was so that *you* could gain access to God and to the many benefits of being His child. It's up to you what you will *do* with that access. How much of God's best do you want? How much do you want to give in life?

Take Heed What You Hear

If you want more faith in God, you won't develop it by leaning on what you've *heard*. It comes by what you are "...*hearing, and hearing by the Word of God*" (Romans 10:17). Too many people are trying to develop their future on what they've already heard, but gaining faith is an *everyday* action of hearing.

Jesus continues on with this warning: "*And He said unto them, Take heed what ye hear: with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given. For he that hath, to him shall be given: and he that hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he hath*" (Mark 4:24-25).

Jesus warns us to be careful about what we hear—and this isn't talking about what we audibly detect with our ears. Jesus is talking about what we understand and grasp with our heart. He's talking about what measure, or portion, of that understanding we actually do something about.

There is deep revelation in the Word for you, but it's what you *seek* to understand and what you *do* with that revelation that matters. Why? Because that's what you're going to put your faith in...and it's faith that moves mountains in life.

When it comes to giving, it's not enough to always give without thought. If you have *faith* in the seed that you're giving, you're going to get better results. Remember, Jesus says that if you have faith in what you hear in the Word, then *more* faith will be given to you.

The more of the Word you apply, the more you will *get* to apply. *More* will be given to you when you use *more* of what you've got right now. This applies to everything in the Word.

If you wonder if sowing and reaping can be applied to finances, I have one question for you: Are finances mentioned in the Word? Yes, they are! So, if finances are in the Word and God says you can have something, then you can believe for it. Stand on His Word concerning finances and the blessing. Sow that Word into your own heart.

Don't let people criticize you for believing for God's best. Remember that those who do little or no sowing usually feel justified in offering criticism. Forget what *they* say; put your faith in what *God* says.

If God's Word says that you can have favor, then you can have favor. If the Word says that you can be blessed in the city, blessed in the field, blessed coming in, and blessed going out, then you can be blessed. Glory! The sooner you really *hear* that, the sooner you'll get more of what the Word is talking about. You can have God's overwhelming blessings in every area of your life!

Don't Lose Out—Seek and Knock!

Now, this is the shocker: If you have nothing, remember Jesus said in verse 25 that the little you have will be taken away...unless you begin to take heed what you hear and start doing what you know to do.

That may sound harsh, unless you realize that the things of God are precious. They are for those who seek and knock (Luke 11:9-10). When you seek, you'll find. When you knock, the door will be opened unto you. But *you* must do the seeking and the knocking! That's taking heed what you hear and measuring what you mete.

God wants you to receive from Him in exactly the way that you need it, but if you're not receiving from Him, take note. You are evidently not really *sowing* in that area. Go to God about it. Seek the Word, and God will reveal the problem and give you the solution. You can be sure it is going to start with taking heed what you hear.

I've decided that I'm going to give every day. Even if it is something as small as a smile, I'm going to do it—not just because I feel like it, but because I want to live a life of sowing.

The Seed and the Sickle

I don't have to know exactly how a smile, a financial blessing, or a kind word will affect someone. It's just my responsibility to give that smile, that financial blessing, or that kind word. God will produce results off of what I give. I just have to put my faith in Him.

Let's continue reading Jesus' teaching in Mark 4:26-32. *"...So is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground; And should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, **he knoweth not how**. For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear. But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come. And he said, Whereunto shall we liken the kingdom of God? or with what comparison shall we compare it? It is like a grain of mustard seed, which, when it is sown in the earth, is less than all the seeds that be in the earth: But when it is sown, it groweth up, and becometh greater than all herbs, and shooteth out great branches; so that the fowls of the air may lodge under the shadow of it."*

Even in the natural, you can't just sit on your porch and wait for God to bring you a harvest after you've sown seed. You have to *work* it. You may not know how it happens, but when you see the fruit emerge, you have to put forth the sickle. You have to pluck that fruit. So, not only must you have seed in your hand, but you must also have a sickle! You are not only the sower, but you are also the harvester.

I don't know much about farming, but I've talked to many farmers, and most agree that there is more work at harvest time than seedtime. I've preached in the grain belt of America and I've noticed that the harvesters will work from sun up to sun down when it's harvest time. At that time, it was all work and no play.

I've learned something from that. Seedtime is deliberate, progression time is a watering time, and harvest time is work. When fruit is beginning to come forth, it's up to me to go out and get what God has meant for me.

Progression Time

This is the time when the trials, temptations, and tests of your faith are going to come. It's when the seed is germinating and God is working on something that Satan starts to throw his sly questioning and criticisms of God's Word at you. He is an accuser, a discourager, and he always deals in doubt—and you can be sure that he will use "time" to discourage you.

You see, the devil always deals with time. He's very time-conscious because he knows his time is short. Satan has already been judged and is awaiting confinement. He knows that it's only a matter of time before he's thrown into the bottomless

pit. He's going to spend eternity in the lake of fire. So, he uses pressure about time to get you to doubt God. He'll say, "You see that? You've lost your money."

What is he doing? He's trying to steal the Word that has been sown in your heart by using the pressure of "time" because he wants to steal from you. He wants to dig up your seed and cut you out from receiving your overwhelming abundance.

God doesn't have any time limitations. He is forever! He made the Earth to work by the principles of seedtime and harvest time, and progression time is part of the process. So, while the devil will put pressure on you about time, you can't move God with that pressure. He is above that. If He wants something, He just creates it. But He has put a system in place, and it will not cease as long as the Earth remains. Don't let the devil destroy your faith during progression time.

Worry Doesn't Help Seeds Grow

Seed has to grow up. It's like a child—when they are small, they practically scream to grow up. Then, when they get to a certain age, they start to reminisce about the times when they were small and want to go back.

My birthday is in July. Every year I am another year older, but I'm not worried about my age. I couldn't care less whether I look old or not. My face is going all loose on me, but who cares? Some people do care a lot, and I'm fine with that, too.

Once, a lady got mad at me and told me that I ought to preach against facelifts...but the sad truth was that she could have used one! I figure that your face is nobody's business but yours and God's. So are your teeth. If you're missing a few, get yourself some! Make yourself feel good about how you look if it matters to you. Just don't judge those of us who don't care about it, because, believe it or not, there are lots of us out here! We know that time is moving on. It's not seedtime anymore for us, but we're not worried about what's progressing, and we don't care to go back!

When it comes to sowing, too many people worry after they've sown. If you've given and haven't seen results yet, don't let yourself fall into worry. That's just an aggravating form of doubt. It won't change anything except your mood.

Philippians 4:6-7 tells us, *"Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus."*

Hurry and Faith Are Incompatible

Nothing serious or lasting can ever be done in a hurry. As you may know, I like antiques and artwork. Some of the furniture that I have purchased is two and three hundred years old and, to me, it just looks as good today as it did when it was built. Do you know why? It wasn't created in a hurry.

Today, everyone wants things fast, but a couple of hundred years ago, furniture was crafted by hand and it took a lot longer to build. Time and talent were invested. Some of the pieces of furniture I have today were built before my great-grandfather ever left France. The craftsman who made the furniture is dead and gone, and yet many of his pieces are still here. Why? He wasn't in a hurry!

Being in a hurry makes you overlook the small details. It causes you to miss some of the greatest things in life. If I'm in a hurry, I find that's when mistakes can happen. If I'm in a hurry while I'm driving, that's when I end up behind a slowpoke grandma going ten miles under the speed limit. That's when I lose my temper! If I'm in a hurry and the lane is clear, that's when I end up speeding and getting pulled over by a cop. Hurry...it'll get you in trouble!

When you're working on applying your faith, being in a hurry can mess you up. You sow, then the seed progresses, and then the harvest comes. That's the process. If you try to hurry that process, you may be disappointed and think the Word doesn't work. But it *does* work. It works according to your faith and God's timing—and His timetable isn't always as fast as you think it should be. Remember, faith that prevails is marked by patience. None of us like that, but it's the truth.

The Evidence of Doubt Is Seen

Hebrews 11:1 says, "*Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.*" This verse tells you that you're not going to see anything when you're believing by faith. Why? Because the evidence of faith is not seen. So, don't get upset if you don't *see* anything happening with your seed. That's evidence of faith at work.

So, when the devil tries to test you in progression time and says, "Can you see it?" Say, "No!" He will tempt you with disappointment and say, "Well, aren't you sad?" Say, "No! That's my evidence that I got it!" You'll confuse him, which is pretty easy to do since he's the author of confusion.

I've chosen to live by faith. So, I'm not moved when I see it; I'm moved when I *believe* it. The evidence of faith is not seen. When I do see it, it's no longer evidence of my faith; it's the manifestation of what God said He'd do all along.

Doubt, on the other hand, can be seen all the time. Doubt is never a spiritual thing. It's always a natural thing. It's secular, apart from God's way of doing things, and can be seen constantly.

Faith doesn't have a big voice, but it leaves a big footprint. Doubt can be heard above everything, but it doesn't leave a trace of a footprint. Why? Doubt doesn't *do* anything. Doubt just talks. It says what can't be done.

Faith does. Faith acts. Faith moves in the area of "can't be done" without talking about it all the time. Doubt, on the other hand, will even doubt itself!

I've said this many times: "If you learn to doubt your doubts,

you won't be a doubter anymore because your doubts will have been doubted. Why? Because you've learned to doubt your doubts!" Jesus said that ALL things are possible to those who believe. The devil always doubts that.

If the devil throws doubt in your mind, doubt it! Speak faith instead. That will cancel out his doubt. If he puts doubt in your mind about the Word and your ability to receive from God, just do what I do. Say, "Devil, I doubt that!" He'll say, "You can't doubt that." Then, just say, "I doubt your doubt." He'll get confused and say, "You can't doubt that. That's my doubt." Don't move off your stance. Just counter him by saying, "I doubt your doubt!" He'll say, "Yeah, but that's my doubt." Don't let him deter you. Just say, "I don't care if it's your doubt. I doubt your doubt."

The devil will get confused. He'll start talking to other devils, saying, "Listen, I put doubt in the man's mind and he doubted it." They'll say, "How'd he do that?" He'll say, "I don't know, I'm still doubting it myself, I don't know how he did it!"

Did you get that?

You see, the evidence of faith is not seen, but the evidence of doubt is seen...it's seen all the time. It's seen when people put limits on the Word. It's seen when people dismiss the Word. It's seen when people choose to do things naturally when they know that God has challenged them to live a better way.

This is such an important subject that I wrote an entire book about it entitled, *I Never Learned to Doubt: Lessons I've Learned About the Dangers of Doubt and the Freedom of Faith.*

The Power to Get Wealth

The Bible says that it is God that gives us the *power* to get wealth (Deuteronomy 8:18). What is that power? It is faith in His Word. Faith in His way of doing things. Faith in seedtime, progression time, and harvest time.

So, I've decided to just believe God. It's God Who gives me the power to get wealth, and He will continue to bless me as long as I put my trust in Him and my faith in His Word. So, what do I care if people get mad at me about it?

If I'm blessed, it isn't my fault—it's my Father's! He's my El Shaddai, Adonai, Elohim, Yahweh, Jehovah, God! I know why people get mad at me for being blessed—it's because I'm the one they see! They can't see God, so they take it out on me. But that's OK. I stick up for my Father. I stick up for His Word. Harvest time is mine, and I am overwhelmed by my abundant harvest from my God!

The Responsibility of the Soil

Some people think the soil has no responsibility. They believe that only the sower is responsible to sow and reap. That is wrong. The soil is important to the growth of the seed.

When you give, it's a holy thing unto God. You have the responsibility to have faith in God's Word, to water your seed

by speaking the Word over it, and not to doubt in progression time. But it is the soil's responsibility to stay clean and rich with God's Word—to live right, do right, and believe right.

If you're a financial Partner to my ministry or if you've given in any way, I have the responsibility to keep the soil of this ministry fertile so that your seed can grow. It's my responsibility not to put any carcinogenic chemicals of doubt, sin, and unbelief around your seed.

I have the responsibility to keep the weeds out. I have the responsibility to stay in line with what God has told me to do—to continue to *"Go ye"* and reach people for Jesus, to keep myself and this ministry holy and clean, and to keep my ministry running right to give your seed every possible way to "spring forth." I can't allow my ministry to have weeds that choke out your seeds.

I believe that ministries that do not keep themselves on track will be accountable to God for the seeds that they've stifled. Those who've committed adultery, stolen money, and played around while their ministries limped along inefficiently are going to be held accountable to God for all the hard-earned seeds that've been planted into their ministries for God's work.

God calls ministry and church leaders to fast and pray when we're doing His work; not to feast and play. He's called us to *be* a blessing, and that means that every ministry or church that receives seed must be responsible for the seed that is sown into their soil. It is the responsibility of the leaders to see to it that the work of God gets done.

I'm laying this responsibility right on me too, because I have got to believe every day for my Partners to receive the thirty, sixty, and hundredfold. I have to do everything I can to keep my ministry running well, and I do! I pray every day for my Partners and for those who write into my ministry to *be* blessed and *be* a blessing to others—to keep God's ways going throughout the Earth. Even if I get tired, I can't let myself get weary in well-doing about it because "due season" is on the way (Galatians 6:9).

Seedtime is a season. Progression time is a season, too. It's the season of pregnancy, when life is forming and God is working on something great. And whether you like it or not, if you stick with God and the soil stays good, you're going to have harvest time. The seed will spring forth—spiritually, physically, or financially—and what you have sown, you *will* reap.

Your Seeds May Feed the Next Generation

Don't look at what you do today as insignificant. The seeds you plant today may grow into a mighty tree—a tree whose fruit may feed the hungry long after you've passed away.

What you say today may take root in somebody's heart. What you do today may influence someone far more than what you say. You just never know. So, you might as well just live your life as a testimony to God's overwhelming power and blessing.

Why? Because, every day you'll get another opportunity to sow a seed and send the right message. It may be a word, a smile, a deed, or a gift. It may be just overcoming an obstacle with grace or conquering a bad habit by leaning on Jesus. Whatever makes people think about God with reverence and gratitude promotes His glory.

What you see as insignificant, God may see as very important. You are earning jewels for your crown in Heaven as you live for God day by day. The best preparation for Heaven is the faithful execution of God's will on Earth. Don't get so caught up in life's busyness. Don't let what *you* want make you forsake what *God* wants. What is His will? What would He do in the situation?

It doesn't take much to start something for God. It just takes the first step of obedience—then the next step, and then the next. What you do may seem small, yet out of your obedience, a work may grow that blesses the world. You may end up influencing someone who takes your seed to another level. You may have planted a tree, but someone may come behind you and use those seeds to plant an orchard. You may only know your influence when you get to Heaven.

I believe that the seeds I'm sowing today will grow into a mighty tree that will feed the hungry long after I've passed away. I believe that your seeds will too. We are all called to show forth the overwhelming love of the Father to those He places in our path.

I like to say it this way: If we have a Christian's hope, it glorifies His name. If we lead a Christian's life, it glorifies His cross. If we perform a Christian's duty, it glorifies His grace. If we make it through a trial, it glorifies His support. If we overcome a sinful habit or the lust that led to it, it glorifies His power working in our lives.

How do we do it? I like what the apostle Paul said in Galatians 2:20: *"I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, Who loved me, and gave Himself for me."*

Remember the abundant truth of your salvation today. Remember that you have been separated and set apart for a purpose. You have a calling and a commission to bring glory to God.

Whether you are a leader or a layperson, you can send a message to the world that says, "Jesus is real! He lives and He saves. He can turn anybody's life around from lack to prosperity. Just look at what He's done for me!"

Remember, your future is in the overwhelming power of your seed. 🌍







Psalm 44:5 (TPT) says, *“Through Your glorious name and Your awesome power, we can push through to any victory and defeat every enemy.”* As you read this issue of our ministry magazine, I pray that God will empower you to push through to your victory and defeat every enemy through the glorious name of Jesus.

Jesse Duplantis gave me a taste of Heaven through his testimony, and it changed my life. Now I live from eternity’s perspective, seeing how temporary this world truly is. We are seated in heavenly places! I’m so grateful for his ministry and his authentic, raw faith. 

ANYBODY CAN “TELL IT LIKE IT IS.”

**THE VOICE OF FAITH “CALLETH
THOSE THINGS WHICH BE NOT
AS THOUGH THEY WERE.”
ROMANS 4:17**

**Below is an excerpt from Jesse Duplantis' March letter to JDM Covenant Partners. Partners are those who support the ministry's vision of world evangelism with donations and/or product orders, and they receive a letter each month from Brother Jesse, sharing what God has put on his heart. We hope you enjoy reading a portion of this month's letter and will consider becoming a Partner in JDM's vision of world evangelism.*

Dear Partner,

I hope you are enjoying our new theme, “Use Your Faith Voice. Only Say What Faith Says.” Let’s go right to our founding scripture for the 2026 theme now. It’s found in Romans 4:17 which says, “...even God, Who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.” Partner, that scripture just rolls off the tongue so easily to me—and this year, I want it to do the same for you.

Today, I want to bring you to Joshua 1:8 where God speaks His final advice to Joshua after the death of Moses. Joshua is taking over as leader. He’s nervous about that because Moses was such a loved leader for the Children of Israel. But God speaks plainly to Joshua and tells him in Joshua 1:1-7 what to do and how to be. God wants to assure Joshua that he will fulfill his destiny and reach his destination, but He closes out His advice by saying how Joshua is going to be able to do that.

There are five things I want you to notice about God’s advice to Joshua on how he’s going to succeed God’s way in doing what He’s called him to do. God tells Joshua, “*This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth*” (that’s #1), “*but thou shalt meditate therein day and night*” (that’s #2), “*that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein*” (that’s #3), “*for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous*” (that’s #4), “*and then thou shalt have good success*” (that’s #5).

Partner, if we as believers want to succeed in what God has told us to do or to have—if we want to do things God’s way and succeed at making our way prosperous and having good success like God said—then we too must do the five things God told Joshua. He is no respecter of persons. Remember that the Word of God is a lamp unto our feet and a light unto our path. But we must let it illuminate how we think, feel, walk, and talk.

Joshua 1:8 is telling us to only say what faith says. To do that, we must put the Word at the center of how we think and speak, and not just on Sunday or when we feel like it. In 2026, I want us to focus on meditating on the Word day and night, and never letting it depart from our heart and our mouth! That’s how we’re going to be able to do what the Word says and have what the Word says. Our life will unfold in the direction of our faith, and our faith must be in the principles of the Word of God. Then we can make our way prosperous. Then we will have good success. Glory!

Only say what faith says, Partner. Only use your faith voice! Start seeing faith in His Word and His ways as the way to being a success going somewhere to succeed. Let the meditation of your heart and the words of your mouth be acceptable to God, like the scripture says—and the only way for those two to be acceptable is to have faith. We don’t please God with doubt. We please Him with faith (Hebrews 11:6).

Realize this: Worldly riches and great estates are not mere accidents for the believer—there is special providence in them. God didn’t say that *He* was going to make Joshua’s way prosperous; He said that *Joshua* would make his own way prosperous by consistently speaking the Word of God and keeping it rolling over in his heart, so that he could obey the Word. Notice that God called it the way to prosperity. God called it the way to have good success. God said that! So, I want you to realize that God wants you blessed—spiritually, physically, and in every other way—but it won’t happen His way unless you use your faith voice.

Anybody can “tell it like it is,” as they say. But faith tells it how it’s going to be! Faith says how it’s going to be before it ever is! And it is in the saying, believing, and doing that what we are aiming for starts coming to pass. Being wishy-washy doesn’t do diddly-squat in making your way prosperous or having good success. A double-minded man is unstable in all his ways—we know that from scripture.

Remember: you believe your own words more than anybody else’s, so let your words line up with God’s Word. When God spoke to Joshua, Joshua turned around and spoke to the nation of Israel. God’s Words didn’t end in

Joshua's heart or self-talk! God's Words moved on and into the ears and hearts of others.

Partner, we are loudspeakers for people to see and hear—the question is what are we saying? God may speak in a still, small voice in your heart, but it should affect you as if it is very loud in your ears. Your faith voice needs to be heard by others. You're called to pass along good things, and faith is a great thing! The only Jesus some people will ever see is the Jesus in you or the Jesus in me—but unless we value Him, we won't have that sense of obligation to spread

His Word and His ways. Obedience is better than sacrifice. Just do what He said, and remember that your faith voice has the power of not only producing in your life but also affecting the lives of others as well. Your words matter, so make them count! Do it for yourself and for the people around you who are listening. It will work!





GOD'S *Glorious* Masterpiece



I don't usually watch reality television shows, but one of them caught my attention while surfing through the channels several years ago. A gigantic tractor was taking out huge chunks of an old house and tearing it down to make room for a new construction that would soon begin. I was fascinated.

Apparently, there was nothing about this old house that was worth keeping because everything from the roof to the floor was gobbled up and dumped into large containers. I watched in amazement as the builder totally cleared the house to the ground—even the concrete foundation was busted up, scooped up, and hauled away along with the rest of the demolition debris.

When the camera flashed images of the homeowners watching the tear down, I could tell they had mixed emotions about the project. Although their old house held many cherished memories, they were excited about building a new home that was designed just for them. Their builder assured them that it would have everything they ever wanted in a home—an amazing kitchen, great family room, plenty of space for the kids, and a fabulous master bedroom with his and hers closets. It was their dream home.

Since the one-hour show had to cover a project that lasted for almost one year, they fast-forwarded through a lot of the construction, and paused mainly for visits by the homeowners—everyone had to make sure the project was going according to plan. The blueprints must

be followed exactly, or their dream would turn into a nightmare of mistakes and delays that could blow their budget sky high. They had to stay in daily contact with their builder—after all, it was *their* home that was under construction. They were the ones that would have to live with every decision that was being made.

Finally, when the project was completed, the family gave the viewing audience a grand tour of every beautifully furnished room. It was obvious that they were anticipating the new life they would enjoy for years to come. They absolutely loved their dream home and were totally pleased with their decision to remove their old home and start fresh with a totally new construction.

Created Anew

Before we made the decision to accept Jesus Christ as our Savior and Lord, we were all a lot like that old house. There was nothing about us that was worth keeping—we had to be totally cleaned away on the inside before Jesus could come into our lives. This was not something that we could do for ourselves—only the blood of Jesus could cleanse us from sin and change us into a new creature in Christ. Second Corinthians 5:17 says, “*Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.*”

In an instant, the wonderful, amazing grace of God demolished our old, dead lives and replaced them with a new recreated spirit. The Amplified Bible, Classic

Edition of this verse says we have become “...a new creation (a new creature altogether); the old [previous moral and spiritual condition] has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come!” All of your past is gone forever! Every failure and disappointment were wiped clean when you left the demolition zone through the blood of the Lamb of God.

God has good things planned for you—you’re His glorious masterpiece! He created you anew from the inside out and gave you a clean foundation to continue to build upon. Ephesians 2:10 (NLT) says, *“For we are God’s masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things He planned for us long ago.”*

From Demolition Zone to Construction Zone

Although every tool you will need has already been provided for by your Master Builder, you will need to go through an intense training period. And since you are technically in a construction zone, it would be wise to wear a hard hat, *“And take the helmet of salvation”* (Ephesians 6:17).

If you have ever walked onto a large construction site, you were probably handed a hard hat. You didn’t have a choice, you had to take it. That hat was designed to protect the brain and it was required for everyone on the project. If you refused, you would be escorted off of the property—end of discussion.

The purpose of the helmet of salvation is much like that hard hat—it is designed to protect your mind, which is the devil’s main area of attack. When you make the decision to *“take”* the helmet and keep it on, you actually take the important step toward demolishing the devil’s plan to control your thought life. Salvation realities found in God’s Word are powerful weapons that supernaturally

infuse a spiritual helmet to shield your mind against the tactics of the enemy.

Your new creation thrives in the construction zone. It is a place where you learn about your salvation and the abundant life that Jesus came to give to you. Keep your helmet securely in place and never go anywhere without it!

Pardon My Dust!

I’ll never forget the first scripture that I memorized. I was twenty-one at the time, newly saved, and knew almost nothing about the Bible. I realized that my thinking was all wrong and I needed to change my thoughts to match the new life that I had found in Jesus. My mind needed an overhaul. I willingly entered the construction zone!

Romans 12:2 (NLT) gave me clear instructions: *“Don’t copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God’s will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.”*

The truth of this verse hit me squarely between the eyes. For the first time I realized that I needed to change my thinking and be transformed from the inside out. This transformation would be a lot like what happens when a caterpillar goes through metamorphosis and is miraculously transfigured into a butterfly. In fact, the words that are translated *transform* in the above verse are the same root words for *metamorphosis*, which means “changed, transfigured, or transformed.”

So, not long after I was born again in May of 1973, I made a quality decision to spend quality time in the “cocoon” with God. More than anything, I hungered for my life to match my new recreated spirit that was on the inside and to be an awesome display of my glorious God. But like most construction zones, my transformation project did not always go according to plan. I had a lot to learn and even more to unlearn, so I guess you could say I was a work in progress.

My construction zone was often such a mess that I could have hung a sign on my chest that read “Pardon My Dust!” However, instead of allowing my mind to torment me with discouraging thoughts about giving up, I dug down deeper in God and allowed His Word to strengthen and renew my mind. By doing that, I was learning to stand in faith, shake off the dust of discouragement, and keep on walking. I had promises that I was determined to receive!

When our minds are under construction, we are all a work in progress. It may not be the most exciting job, but we must all be diligent in our study of God’s Word.

Colossians 3:10 says we *“have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of Him that created him.”* Unless we take the time to get into God’s Word and allow it to transform our old way of thinking, we will live in constant defeat and frustration and miss out on God’s perfect plan for our lives. Thankfully, God doesn’t give up on us as quickly as we tend to give up on ourselves. His gentle voice is always there, encouraging and guiding us along the way.

Ephesians 4:22-24 (NASB1995) says: *“that, in reference to your former manner of life, you lay aside the old self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit, and that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and put on the new self, which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.”*

The remaining verses of Ephesians chapter four contain seven things that show us how to put on the new self and be renewed in the spirit of our mind.

1. Be Real

Verse 25 says, *“Therefore, laying aside falsehood, speak truth each one of you with his neighbor, for we are members of one another.”* When you determine in your heart to be real with yourself and others, you have taken a vital step toward renewing your mind. It is only with a pure, open heart that you can be transformed and allow your beautiful recreated spirit to soar.

2. Be Forgiving

Verse 26 says, *“Be angry, and yet do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger.”* The Bible teaches only two instances when we are required to forgive. The first is when we have an ought against someone, and the second is when someone has an ought against us. That seemed to cover it all to me when I was trying to hold grudges and not forgive. But how could I expect God to forgive me of my sins if I was unwilling to forgive others?

It is especially important to quickly forgive (before the sun goes down!) and release that anger so that you do not stunt your spiritual growth. If unforgiveness is allowed to take root in your heart, your prayers will be hindered and you will quench the Spirit of God in your life.

3. Be Wise

Verse 27 says, *“And do not give the devil an opportunity.”* Wisdom is the ability to use knowledge. When you daily pray and study God’s Word, the Holy Spirit will give you

knowledge each step of the way. It is your responsibility to be wise and promptly respond to the leading of the Spirit. Stay alert to His directions at all times and you will never give the devil an opportunity.

4. Be Diligent

Verse 28 says, *“He who steals must steal no longer; but rather he must labor, performing with his own hands what is good, so that he will have something to share with one who has need.”* Diligence is vitally important for steady, strong spiritual growth. Without it, you are just going around in circles. When you consistently seek God and do what He calls you to do, no matter how small, He will lead you into bigger things. You are God’s hands in the earth and destined to be a blessing to those you meet.

5. Speak the Word

Verse 29 says, *“Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give grace to those who hear.”* Learning to speak the Word has transformed my life. When I learned that my words were containers that held my future, I began to be more selective about what I allowed to come out of my mouth. If I wanted the promises from God’s Word to dominate my life, I had to learn to dominate my mouth and let no unwholesome word proceed from it.

I remember making a list of all of God’s promises that applied to each particular problem that I was facing. Each time the enemy would tell me that I would fail, the Word that I had put in my heart would rise up and defeat him. Even if things looked bad, I refused to draw conclusions based on what I saw in the natural. I made God’s Word final authority in my life and spoke God’s Word to the situations in my life that needed to be changed, and they did!

The Bible teaches us that the worlds were framed by the Word of God and that we are to be imitators of Him as dear children. Death and life are in the power of our tongue. It is vitally important to fill our hearts with God’s Word and say what God says rather than what we think, so that it will give grace to those who hear.

6. Be Sensitive

Verse 30 says, *“Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by Whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.”* Most of us have no idea how easily the Holy Spirit is grieved. Just as God has a greater capacity to love than we can conceive,

His capacity to be grieved is greater too. When we refuse to obey His directions, He will quietly withdraw His gentle prompting.

If you haven't heard God's direction in a while, go back to the last thing He told you to do that you were not obedient to do. Start again from that point and allow Him to lead you gently through His plan for your life. He is waiting for you.

7. Let Love Rule

Verses 31-32 say, *"Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you."* When love rules your heart and life, you become a true reflection of Jesus Christ. You can refuse to allow the works of the flesh to dominate your life by making the decision to love the way God loves. It was this limitless love that compelled Jesus to the cross to die for the sins of the world. This same force of love can rule your life and cause the world to be attracted to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The Clean Zone

Have you ever made the mistake of cleaning out one closet just to store that junk in another one? I have made that mistake, thinking I would have more time to get to that closet later to decide what is worth keeping and what needs to go. Years went by and I never missed anything that was “stored” away.

Renewing your mind is a continual process. We must be constantly renewed in the spirit of our mind because our old way of thinking and acting will never work in

our new recreated life. Isaiah 55:8 says, *"For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways, saith the LORD."* But once we become a child of God, 1 Corinthians 2:12 (AMPC) promises, *"Now we have not received the spirit [that belongs to] the world, but the [Holy] Spirit Who is from God, [given to us] that we might realize and comprehend and appreciate the gifts [of divine favor and blessing so freely and lavishly] bestowed on us by God."*

He has given us the Holy Spirit so that we can understand His thoughts and ways. Jesus came to rescue us from a hopeless life without God, and reveal the direct path to a truly glorious life on earth and in Heaven. Second Corinthians 10:3-5 encourages us with this amazing promise: *"For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ."*

You and I have a very important part in our own spiritual growth. Our minds don't need to be troubled or tormented by the lies of Satan. We have a choice in life. Instead of thinking about defeat and failure, we can choose to elevate our thinking and follow God's plan for our thought life. Philippians 4:8 says, *"Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things."* I like the last part of that verse in The Amplified Bible, Classic Edition: *"[fix your minds on them]."*

What are you fixing your mind on today? You can send a strong warning to Satan that his days of stealing, killing, and destroying are over. Go ahead and post signs around your mind and all that you possess—Caution: This Mind is Under Construction by the Power of God! No Trespassing Allowed!

Make a quality decision to be transformed by the renewing of your mind and move toward God's perfect will for your life. You are His glorious masterpiece, and He has designs on you for glorious living. 




