

In the Beginning
GOD...
In the Beginning
Was the **WORD**

JESSE DUPLANTIS

The Beginning. We like to think of time as if it's the only thing that matters—something that limits us and has total control over us. We are born. We live and learn, and if we know God, we move on afterward to the place God lives—Heaven. That's all true, but the scripture tells us that we serve an eternal God Who exists outside of what we perceive as earthly time, and that He made us eternal, too. We are eternal spiritual beings. We were born in the Spirit of God before we ever even got here! It's important that we remember that time can't contain us, and that this earthly life is a temporary gift.

God says, *"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you..."* in Jeremiah 1:5 to give you the reassurance that you're valuable to the Lord—and even if nobody thinks you belong, they're wrong because you do. You are a spirit with a soul, and you're clothed in a body God's Word calls *"fearfully and wonderfully made."* (Psalm 139:14) So from your spirit to your soul to your body, God formed you with intention.

You are not what the world says you are. You're not what the devil says you are either. Lies are everywhere and we're living in deceiving times. Don't let anybody convince you that you're not worth much or that you aren't important. It's just a tactic to keep you locked into a system designed to make you forget who you are: a person created in the image of God. That's what they don't want you to remember or accept. The breath of God is in you right now, and that breath is His Spirit. I like to call it God DNA.

God's image. Just think about it. Because being made in the image of God isn't talking just about your natural body. God is a Spirit, as John 4:23 says, and those who worship Him must worship Him in two ways: in spirit and in truth. You are His creation, and being made in His image is no small thing. You resemble Him in a way that even the angels do not. The enemies of God don't like this. That's why they spread so many lies to tear down the self-image of people. But who cares?

You've got breath in your lungs, the truth of God's Word, and a life to live—do you want to waste your limited time in this world talking about what the devil thinks about you, or just start living your life from your rightful spiritual position in Christ? If I were you, I'd pick the second one! Because a life focused on your identification with Christ—the Redeemer Who puts the focus back on your spirit that connects with God—that's where you're going to find peace, joy, abundance, and all the good things God promises in His Word.

In John 6:68, Peter answered Jesus after a teaching

that the disciples found very hard to hear—there are some spiritual concepts that fight with our mind until our mind is renewed to their meaning. Here, Jesus compared His body and blood to sustenance from Heaven and taught that to obtain eternal life, they would have to partake of His flesh and blood. The people were repulsed, and many walked away after hearing it, including His disciples. Jesus was talking about His origin in Heaven, the sacrifice He'd make on the cross, and their destiny in Him if they accepted Him. Many complained. Many walked away. But when Jesus asked His twelve disciples, *"Do you also want to go away?"* only one gave an answer recorded in the Bible: *"But Simon Peter answered Him, 'Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.'" (John 6:67-68)*

This life is a vapor. A lot of people spend most of their time on what builds their ego at the expense of their spirit. They might gather all kinds of information and make all sorts of advancements in life—but they aren't prospering at a soul-level because they have an earthly mindset. The apostle Paul understood this on a personal level. He was a scholar and spent his life doing all the things that looked like success in his culture. Admired, praised, and full of accomplishments and information, he came to realize that all those gains were really a loss compared to what he found when He found Christ. Philippians 3:2-8 records it, and the original word Paul used to describe all his knowledge and accomplishments is most accurately translated "dung"—and you know what that is! If your body works well, you do it when you sit on the throne every day!

Jesus gave us two important concepts in this verse that can totally revolutionize the way we look at our life when He said, *"It is the Spirit Who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life."* (John 6:63) God gives life. The Words that Jesus spoke are spirit—part of God—and they are life. What does that mean? It means your spirit is a gift from God. You're made in His image. It means the words Jesus spoke are two things. They're Spirit—they speak directly to your spirit. They are Life—they wake up your spirit to God, bring eternal life, and reveal how to really live the life you've been given. In other words, you can't live this life well without the Word, and you need to wake up and get born again to God's Spirit to understand it.

Some people hear all that and think that means this earthly life doesn't matter—that's wrong. You wouldn't even be here if this life didn't matter! God made this world, He gave you this life, and from the beginning,

everything He made He called good. That's what He wanted. That was His will. Good everywhere He looked! From the mountains to the streams to the animals to mankind—spirit, soul, and body—God wanted it good. That means good is the best word we have to describe His original design of everything.

Life was meant to be a blessing, not a curse. The Fall brought sin and the junk that spun off that curse, but Jesus was sent by God to bring us back to the good life we were always supposed to be enjoying. So, you just have to decide if you want that or not. And you have free will to make that choice. What will you believe? How will you decide to live? Or, how I like to say it: What world are you going to create for yourself? What world are you going to walk in? The good one that God made and Jesus came to give back? Or the one you see everywhere you look?

At the end of this life, what's going to matter more to you—that you learned how to really live and passed it on to your children, or that you stockpiled all the useless information and breaking news that came in front of your eyes? The Church can sometimes be just as guilty as the world when it comes to giving attention to what won't make their life any better. Their focus can be so much on what the devil is doing that he gets more of their awe, attention, and glory than God. It's a crying shame!

We were warned not to be ignorant of the devil's devices in 2 Corinthians 2:11—but we were never encouraged to fixate on what the devil is doing. Jesus talked about the Father and life more than He ever did about the devil. That is because His purpose was to give us a Way to disconnect from the curse of sin and death and reconnect with God and the blessing of life, and that more abundantly.

This life is a gift. Yes, there are challenges. It's a fallen world with a bunch of fallen people running it, and all sorts of voices filling the air with every negative thing you can think of. I'm here to tell you that what you give your attention to is going to frame your world. The truth is that you were created blessed, and in Jesus you can go back to that state. You were created to walk in divine goodness, and in Jesus you can go back to living that way. I know the world looks like the opposite, but what's inside of you—the real you—is a spirit that can connect and receive from God. Right here on Earth, you can learn to live from your spirit, and not just your flesh.

You can create your world the God way and start living good! But first? You have to get your mind right. You must start seeing yourself differently. Faith isn't a technique; it's a way of thinking and believing that acknowledges God and your position in Him through Christ Jesus. Your self-image can't be dictated by the world if you want success God's way.

Spiritually, physically, financially, or in any other area of your life, if you want it to be good, you must recognize your connection to God and start believing, speaking, and doing things His way. God is the Creator, Provider, Possessor, and Protector. He's the Healer, Deliverer, Sanctifier, and Peace-Giver—and if you let Him be the Shepherd of your soul, you're going to start thinking right. That'll lead you to start believing right. You'll start speaking right and acting right, and then? Your world will start looking right! So, let's get into it.

The World Wants to Tear You Down, God Wants to Lift You Up.

The world has been messed up for a long time. Whether it's coming from people in your life, the people on the streets, or the people on your screens, we live in a world that seems fixated on the exact opposite of what Jesus came to give us—life and that more abundantly, like John 10:10 says. From the time you're born, it seems like somebody is telling you directly or indirectly what you can't do or can't have, or why you shouldn't expect all that much of what's good.

Jesus' divine power has given us all things that pertain to life and godliness, according to 2 Peter 1:3, but this world is always trying to get you to focus on every different version of death and ungodliness. There are two systems at play, and you can't be effective in hearing from God and living His good way if you are consistently listening to everything the world says.

While this world wants to tear you down, I'm here to tell you that the same God Who created this world and

time itself lives in you...and you are not doomed to live the way the world lives. You're just not as limited as you may think. *Think*. That's the point. What you think and believe can totally change the way you perceive your life and what's possible for you and your family. The power of "can't" can sometimes override what you know to be true if you let it! It's time to look at yourself and let go of the image of yourself that limits you from walking in the image of God.

Sometimes you just have to remember Who made you and Who knows you—because the more you look at how He is, the more you'll see yourself in His eyes, and the more you'll find out how you were always meant to live. Acts 17:28 says, "*for in Him we live and move and have our being... For we are also His offspring.*" So, I don't care what others may have told you or done to you—it does not negate the power of God in your life or the capabilities He put down on the inside of you, because you are in Him.

You see, you have to get the "can't," the "I don't know about that," and the "Is that really for me?" junk out of your head when it comes to creating your world and walking in it. You have to find your own voice. And that voice—if you want to rise above, overcome, push back the darkness, and walk in the light of His wonderful ways of being—must be what I call your "faith voice."

Look In the Mirror. What Do You See? Do You See What God Said? If Not, Look Again.

To embrace the image of God you were created to be, to embrace the new creation in Christ that you became upon salvation, there are some old ways of thinking

that have to go. They need to fall like shackles off your body. Old ways of seeing yourself are just old patterns of thinking that were created in your past. Maybe some were passed down to you, maybe some were pushed on you, or maybe you just adopted some of them on your own—but if you are born again, you are a new creature in Christ Jesus. That means you are back to being made in the image of God.

So, those old ways of thinking about who you are, what you can and can't have, or what you can and can't do? They are probably a lot like some of those clothes in the back of your closet—worn-out and old, and five sizes too small to fit you! You've got to get rid of the shabby old thoughts because, while they may have helped you survive the world in the past, they don't fit who you really are now.

Look in the mirror. What do you see? If you see anything other than a child of the Living God, made in His image, and purchased by the blood of Jesus with all the rights and privileges restored to you by the grace of your Creator, then you need to look again. And maybe again, and again!

To create your world and walk in it, you have to use your faith voice—but to use that voice, God's Word must move in where the old thoughts once were. Faith is simple. I don't know why people make it so hard. It doesn't have to be. It comes by repetitively hearing the Word of God—which is something you can easily do.

Faith is a new operating system. It shifts your mind, your will, and your emotions, and it starts to affect how you function in life. It takes your thoughts and changes them to God's thoughts. That is a process, but it begins with one single decision of humility. It begins the moment you decide for yourself that God is God, and if He's God, then what He has said is true—and not just true in general, but truer than anything else you may have thought, believed, or said was true in the past. Once you get that out of the way, you can start creating your world with His Words and His principles. It's a shift that changes everything.

So, right here and now, before we go any further, it's time to remind yourself of a few things, like: If God said you are loved and so valuable that He sent His Son to redeem you, then you're loved and worth the world to God Almighty. If He said you are forgiven of all sin and iniquity and are righteous in His sight now, then you are pure-as-snow clean in His eyes, and no sin is clinging to your soul. If He said you have been delivered and set free in Him, then you have. If He said He wants you to prosper and be in health, even

as your very soul prospers, then He does. If He said He's bestowed grace, favor, and glory on you, then He has! If He said His blessing is on you, then it is! If He said you have the mind of Christ, if He said you were healed by His stripes, if He said His joy is your strength, and you have peace in Him...well, you get where I'm going with this, right?

You have to stop letting the world (and even some of the religious world) tell you who you are and what you can have and do—because if you want start living like God created you to live, then it's time to make God's Word your word. No matter where you come from or what you've been led to believe, you're a lot more precious and powerful than others may have led you to believe. You can do a whole lot more than what this world may be trying to get you to believe.

This world has fallen. That's a fact. But even within this dark and crazy place, you can change your life from the inside out with the Word of the Living God. You don't have to accept what doesn't belong to you. You can lay aside the old and take up the new, and word by Word, create your own world and walk in it! Glory to God, I think I just stirred myself up with that preaching! Hahahaha!

In the Beginning...GOD. We Serve an Eternal Creator, and You Are a Creator, Too.

I love how the very first line of the Bible begins. I like to stop it short and just ponder on the magnitude of the first four words of Genesis 1:1: "*In the beginning God...*" In the beginning GOD. Just stop there for a second and remind yourself that God existed before this world was ever in existence. Pause and notice that there was a beginning. A beginning for the world, a beginning for you and me... every day, in fact, when you wake up, you begin again. A new day. A new opportunity to think, to believe, to move, and to take action in life. In other words, every day is a new day to follow the way of your Father and create.

What will you do with this particular day? What will you think? What will you say? This book is about choosing to create your inner world so that you can produce the life you want to live. It's about using what I call your faith voice, and only saying what faith says. In other words, it's about making a quality decision, and making it again and again until you get to the place that you're not just creating an inner world, but you're producing an outer world that is in line with the words of your mouth and the mediation of your heart.

This book is about choosing every day, like Joshua 24:15 says, "*whom you will serve*"—and it's responding in your mind with your words and in the actions of your life that, "*as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.*"

Because serving the Lord is about having faith in God and in His Word—it's about living a faith-centered life that sees life differently than the world. We are eternal beings made by an eternal God, and the promises God gives us in His Word are for us—and that is true whether the world is going crazy or not!

Faith can change the way you see yourself. It can make life simpler. It changes the way you live, giving you hope and joy that the world just doesn't have. When everybody's running around like a chicken with its head cut off, faith will give you peace that passes all understanding. Regardless of how the world tries to steal your focus or move you off track with its fear, faith in God and the promises and principles in His Word make you take a much longer view.

Like the eternal God, Who is your Father, faith can help you to be unshakeable in a world that's always trying to shake you up. When what God said becomes more valuable and truer to you than what the world says, you'll be able to pause when the world tries to get you to live in the mental chaos they live in and choose another way. God's way. When the deception gets thick, God can help you "*be not deceived*," like Jesus said in Luke 21:8. Leaning on the Holy Spirit within you, you'll be able to see straight through the world's junk, say "no" to the doom and gloom, and just go on living by the fruit of His Spirit.

Love is for you. Joy is for you. Peace and a patient nature are for you. Kindness is for you. Goodness is for you. Faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control in an out-of-control world are for you! The Bible is full of verses to encourage you in all these things, and more. There are promises in the Word about being blessed and living a prosperous life. There are promises about health and wholeness, too. There are also promises about having favor in life, being protected from harm, and being guided by the Holy Spirit to make the right decisions.

There are so many scriptures in the Word that you can put your faith on and create your world with that will help you to live free from the inside out. But do you know why faith in the Word can help you create a good life with all these things? How is it possible that a book can impart that much if you just believe it and do what it says? It's because the Word isn't just a book—it's a living and active Person. And if you are born again, it's the same Person Who not only came in to wash your sin away, but the One Who was also there when time on Earth began. 🌍

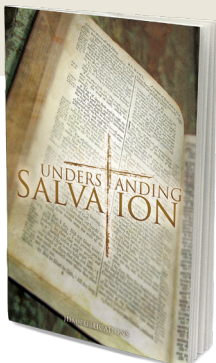

I want You in my life. Create in me a clean heart and renew a right spirit in me now, and help me to grow in my faith and in the principles of God's Word. I love You and am so grateful to know You love me, too. Thank You for coming into my heart. I am turning my life over to You, knowing that in You all things become new for me. I welcome the Holy Spirit into my life right now, and I make a heart-felt decision to allow You to lead and guide me into all truth. Thank You, Jesus, for saving me and helping me to grow in Your ways and to know You more every day of my life. I pray all this now in Your name. Amen!”

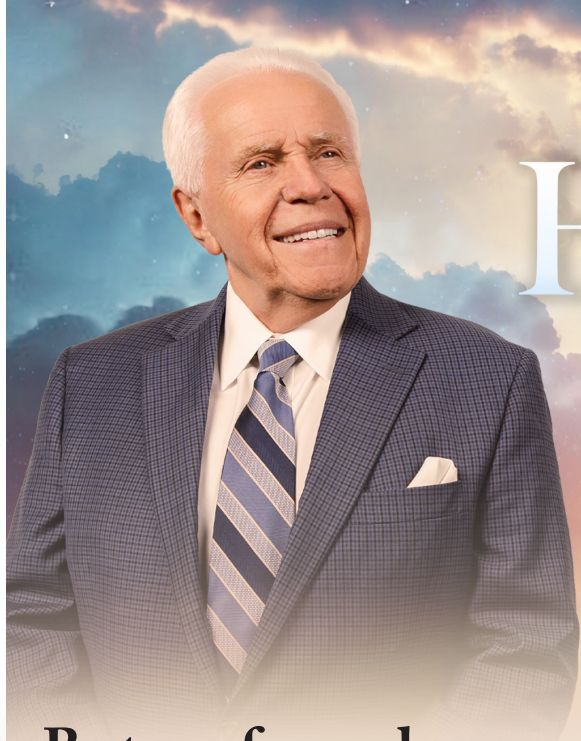

A few days ago, I called the ministry and requested prayer for my friend, as his body might have been rejecting his double lung transplant. Today, we received wonderful news—there is no rejection of the lungs! Praise Jesus for His healing and for answered prayers!

We attended your meeting in North Highlands, CA and have to share what happened. My husband and I have been praying for ways to increase our monthly income that would still allow me to be home with our children and maintain our small farm property. That night, we were blessed to hear Jesse speak and decided to make a donation to the ministry, as we have been so blessed by his teachings online. Afterwards, I had to pick my sister up from the airport. On the way back home, she said to me, "I wondered if you might be interested in a part-time job working for me—10 hours a week?" **Below is an excerpt from Jesse Duplantis' July letter to JDM Covenant Partners. Partners are those who support the ministry's vision of world evangelism with donations and/or product orders, and they receive a letter each month from Brother Jesse sharing what God has put on his heart. We hope you enjoy reading a portion of this month's letter and will consider becoming a Partner in JDM's vision of world evangelism.*

Dear Partner,

To all Americans, this is a very important month. We're celebrating 250 years of being a nation. It started way back on July 4th in the year 1776—on that day, we declared our independence as a nation. While we had to fight a war to obtain our independence, we believed that our freedom was worth fighting for. Well, Partner, 2,000 years ago, a much greater freedom was born out of love for humanity and paid for by the great sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross, and it's inclusive to all.

No nation, no specific people, and no other group who sees themselves as united can boast of the freedom purchased by Jesus for the salvation of the world. To God, the freedom of each human soul (past, present, and future) was worth the cost of sending His only Son to the cross for our sin and separation from Him. *“For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life”* (John 3:16).

The greatest freedom ever given to man was paid for in pure and holy blood. It was a sacrifice born in divine love—and it was given as a free gift to us all, because our Heavenly Father decided that our personal freedom was *worth* the price. He wanted us close again. He wanted us to have a way out of satanic deception, fear, and confusion. God wanted us to come home to Him, right here on Earth as well as in Heaven when we pass. That freedom is worth celebrating every day. And how do we celebrate it? By believing His Word as dear children, and walking out our faith with the power given to us through Christ Jesus.

This year's theme is: **“Only Say What Faith Says. Only Use Your Faith Voice”**—and we can do that today by voicing our freedom, because *“If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed”* (John 8:36). Let's get into more teaching on our theme now. As you may remember, our founding scripture is Romans 4:17: *“...even God, Who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.”* I can't tell you how much I love that verse. It speaks volumes to me. Now go with me to Romans 12:2: *“And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind...”* This is the key to living by faith.

How do we renew our mind? We allow the truth of the Word to penetrate our heart—it begins when we read the truth, accept it, and start speaking and acting on it. You see, we believe what we say more than what anybody else says! So, it's best to say what God says about us and what He wants for us—spiritually, physically, and financially. In every area, God has truth to guide us. When we say what *He* says

over ourselves and the situations of life, that's using our faith voice. That's saying what faith says. This practice is how we transform from the inside out. Renewing our mind is about recognizing the love of God shown to us. It's why He sent Jesus and gave us the wisdom of His Word.

Point one today is this: **God does not compel discipleship; He governs by the constraint of love.** The best anyone can do is to let God have control over oneself—notice that word *let*. **We cannot run away from what we carry with us.** Your faith voice—saying what faith in God's Word says—should be the controlling factor of your whole life, because it's rooted in God's great love for you. He doesn't ask you to give up anything that makes your mind, heart, or life better. His will is for you to walk in freedom from the inside out and in the blessings of a life lived the best way, which is His way. Hebrews 12:1 wisely tells us to, *“...lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us.”* This is for our great benefit, because when we lay aside the weight and the sins that try to get us off course, we run the race of life with way more ease.

Jesus told us a wonderful truth in Matthew 11:30 when He said, *“For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.”* This means the weightiness of the world is not for our shoulders. The heaviness of sin is not for us either. With Jesus, there is lightness—but it's up to us to put down the weighty things and to realize that He isn't called the Light of the World for nothing! He shines the light on our path—that's guidance. He brings the light to our soul—that's freedom. He helps us run our race with patience and peace, and He will never ask us to carry a heavy yoke or burden. That's how you know if you're carrying too much. Is it too heavy? Is it too hard? If so, it's not for you. In Jesus you find ease and lightness of spirit. He never meant for us to walk through life alone. That's why He came! He came to bring us back into right standing with our Father so that we could boldly go to His throne of grace and get what we need to live this life well. It's an inside job. It's a renewal of the mind. It's a freedom that comes when we lay down what we were never meant to carry, and when we pick up the truth with ease and faith.

Saying what faith says is very easy if you *hear* what the Lord says—so open your Bible, remind yourself of your position in Christ, and lay down the weights. I'm a stickler for what the Word says—it's changed my life. God's Word *is* my faith voice. I've made it personal because it is personal! It's for all of us who love God and believe. That's why I don't conform to the world. **No person who has surrendered himself to God can conform to the world.** We're either going God's way or the world's way. We're either letting His truth guide us or we're letting the world's lies deceive us. Surrendering is the only good way to go to me!

Point two today: **There is no flaw in divine purpose—it is a circle complete in itself.** Your faith voice makes you renounce your

will for God's will. That's why faith is so important in your daily life. The will of God is the guiding purpose for our lives in its method of working and in its results. Everything God guides us to do will lead us right back to Him. Jesus is the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end! So, we should always be doing what Hebrews 12:2 says, "Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith..." He is our Source of faith, and so we can put ourselves in this verse, too: "Being confident of this very thing, that He which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ" (Philippians 1:6). Notice those words "looking" and "being"—those are what I call *now* words! Focus on *now*. Look to Jesus *now*. Be confident *now*. Your faith is in Jesus, and He's going to keep doing a good work in you until He comes back.

Well, I've got to go now. I hope this letter will help you today to keep saying what faith says and only use your faith voice. Until next time, keep the faith!

EXPAND

Your Vision

CATHY DUPLANTIS

Instead of looking at where you've been or even where you are, why not allow God to expand your vision of where you can go? That is exactly what Abraham did many thousands of years ago. The Bible tells us that when he was seventy-five years old, God told him,

...Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:

And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:

And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Genesis 12:1-3

What was so special about this man? Out of all the people that had been born into the earth since the creation, why did God choose to use him? While researching this question, I discovered that Abraham was born twenty generations from Adam, in the 1948th year after creation.

Hebrew commentaries call the first two thousand years from creation "The Era of Desolation" because it was during this time period that Adam fell, Abel was murdered, ten generations were washed away in the flood, and ten more rebellious generations failed to seek and serve God. Then, in the 2000th year after creation, four years after the Dispersion of Babel and six years before the death of Noah, Abraham started to serve God and ushered in what has been called "The Dispensation of Promise."

God had finally found someone on the earth that would obey Him and walk by faith. When Abraham left his country, kindred, and the security of his father's house, he didn't know where he was going. He was trusting God to direct him every step of the way. However, Abraham made the mistake of bringing his nephew on the journey, and it wasn't long before strife broke out between the two groups of herdsmen. The conflict was resolved when Abraham and Lot separated. It was at this point that Abraham was at a place where he could again hear from God and get

clear directions for his future. It was time to expand his vision.

And the LORD said unto Abram, after that Lot was separated from him, Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward:

For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed for ever.

And I will make thy seed as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, then shall thy seed also be numbered.

Arise, walk through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it unto thee.

Genesis 13:14-17

Basically, God was telling him, 'If you can see it, you can have it.' As Abraham lifted up his eyes to look at all of the land to the north, south, east and west, he expanded his vision. The word *expand* means "to increase the size, volume, quantity, or scope of; enlarge."

When Abraham walked the length and breadth of the land, he was increasing the size of his vision. Each dusty step must have reminded him of God's amazing promise to make his seed as the dust of the earth. There is no way that Abraham could count all the hairs on his own head, let alone the dust of the earth! God was telling him that there are no limits when you walk in obedience to Him. He was experiencing expansion.

Keep Pushing Your Limits

This reminds me of a military recruiting commercial I once saw. The commercial showed images of young men and women going through a series of very strenuous exercises. In scene after scene, the soldiers were continually pushing themselves beyond what seemed humanly possible. A voice on the commercial said, "If you keep pushing your limits, you won't have any."

The military gets it. They know that with the proper training, discipline, and dedication, *anyone* can push their limits until there aren't any boundaries—only challenges. Instead of stopping at obstacles, a soldier focuses on overcoming them. Failure is never

an option. They know that every battle is another opportunity for victory.

The only limits we have are the ones that we place upon ourselves. Mark 9:23 says, *“Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.”* Faith in God’s Word opened the Red Sea, shut lions’ mouths, and opened prison doors. Never underestimate the power of belief. There is no limit to those that put their trust in God.

A Multi-Generational Vision

When God spoke to Abraham, He wasn’t just thinking about him. God had a plan to bless all the families of the earth through the seed of Abraham. God’s vision is always multi-generational and global. The key ingredient to seeing this come to pass is clear in the following verse of scripture:

For I have known (chosen, acknowledged) him [as My own], so that he may teach and command his children and the sons of his house after him to keep the way of the Lord and to do what is just and righteous, so that the Lord may bring Abraham what He has promised him.

Genesis 18:19 (AMPC)

Notice that the promise is conditional. Each generation after Abraham must keep (guard, protect, attend to) the way of the Lord so that all the families of the earth can be blessed. God chose Abraham on purpose for His purpose because He knew that

Abraham would be diligent to teach and command his children to keep the way of the Lord so that His blessing promise could continue in the earth.

Abraham was faithful to teach his children the value of training each generation after them. Even in famine, his son Isaac prospered and received one hundredfold increase in the same year that he sowed in the land (Genesis 26:12). Isaac, Jacob, and their children continued the family tradition and walked in the blessing of God. All of Abraham’s children watched him operate in faith and follow the example that he learned firsthand from his God.

(As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before Him Whom he believed, even God, Who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.

Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.

And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sarah’s womb:

He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;

And being fully persuaded that, what He had promised, He was able also to perform.

And therefore it was imputed [credited] to him for righteousness [justified by God].

Romans 4:17-22

Abraham learned everything that he knew about faith from God. Since God *“called those things which be not as though they were”* in order to create the world by faith, then Abraham had to apply the same principle to become the father of many nations. He expanded his vision and trained his children because he understood the multi-generational vision of God.

A Child Needs Training

I heard an old story about a child who was amazed by something on his grandmother’s mantle. On the

mantle stood a glass bottle with a very small neck... and a full-grown red apple sitting at the bottom of the bottle. The boy examined the bottle to see if it had a removable bottom or a seam in the back, but there was neither. He couldn't figure out how that big apple got inside of that bottle. Then one day, while walking in the garden, he saw a tree with a bottle attached to the end of a branch. Upon closer examination, he recognized a tiny apple growing inside the bottle. Mystery solved.

Do you want to know how to put God into your children? Surround them with His Word when they are small and they will keep it when they grow old. Children thrive in an atmosphere of love and consistent godly living. Deuteronomy 6:6-7 says, *"And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up."*

That just about covers every activity of life. So, when you sit down for a family meal, tell your child about God's vision to bless all the families and nations of the earth. Then, while walking with your child, you can share Bible stories and what it means to walk by faith. Always teach them about His love, kindness, and peace when putting them down to sleep. And each time they rise up, impart your enthusiasm for God and the opportunities of a new day.

Increase of God's Word = Increase of Vision

The apostle Paul was greatly used by God to heal the sick, raise the dead, and spread the Gospel throughout the known world. He experienced a vision when he encountered Jesus on the Damascus road, but that was just the beginning of his journey.

In Acts 26:19-20, he proclaimed the he was *"...not disobedient unto the heavenly vision: but shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance."*

He continued to grow in God by reading the scriptures and walking in obedience every single day. Increase of vision is always the result of a consistent increase of God's Word.

Have you ever eaten at an "All-You-Can-Eat" restaurant? If you have and are like most people, each time you visit that place, you're able to eat more and more. After a while, you notice that your bulging body needs bigger clothes. It didn't happen on the first few trips to the 100-item food bar, but daily visits were destined to produce certain results. Increase is coming. Expansion is inevitable.

The same is true with the vision that God has for your glorious life. God doesn't want you in the dark about His great plan. It will take time to get revelation of the great vision of all that He has planned, but keep up those daily visits and feast upon His Word. Take "All-You-Can-Get" from His Word and experience the fullness of His blessings. Push your limits and experience your unlimited God. Expansion is inevitable! 🌐

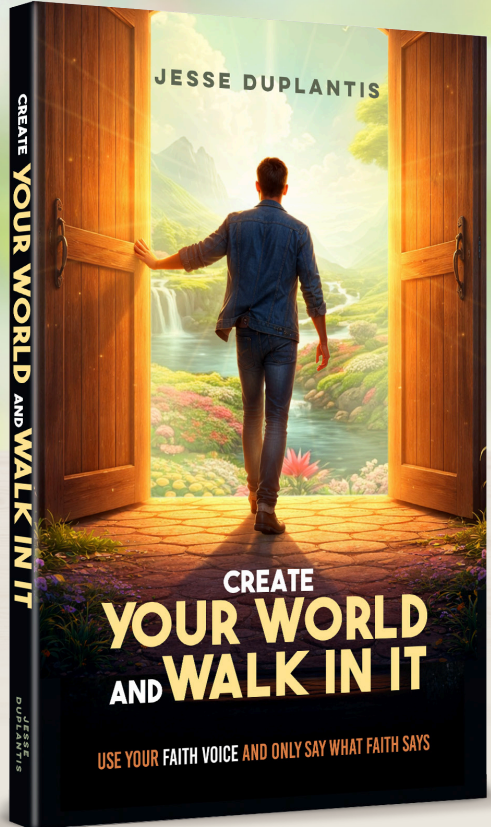
