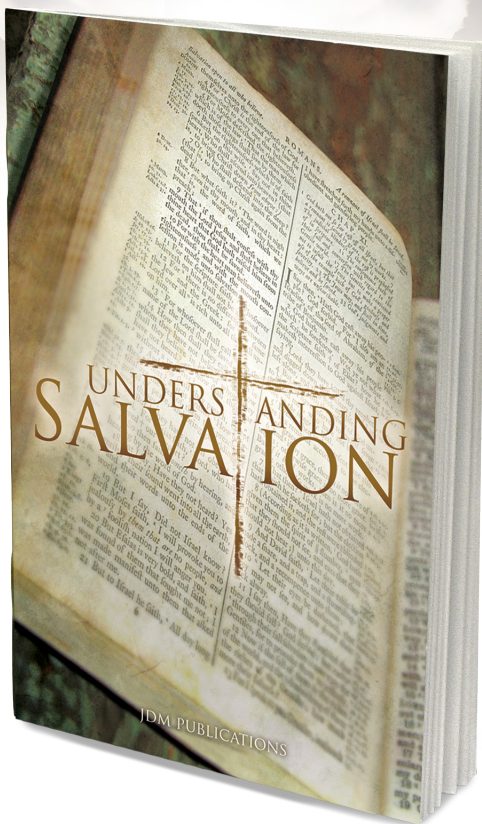

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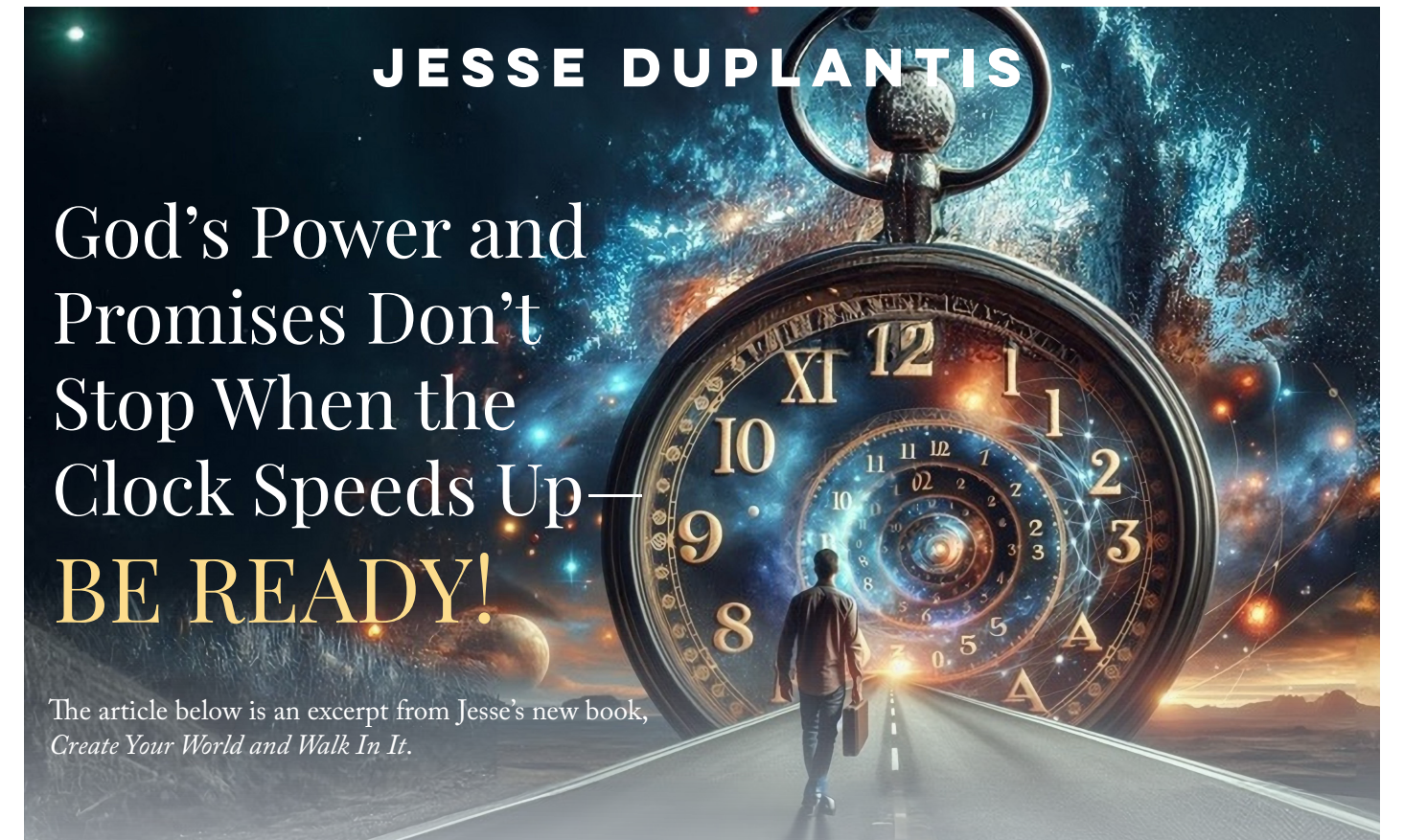

God's Power and Promises Don't Stop When the Clock Speeds Up— **BE READY!**

The article below is an excerpt from Jesse's new book, *Create Your World and Walk In It*.

People equate goals with pushing, but creating your world with the Word of God is about living, moving, and having your being in Him, like Acts 17:28 says—and that is a way of creating His good plan for your life with calmness and peace. While the world strives and wears themselves out, the believer lives by a different creed. Faith is not willpower. It takes our ability out of the equation. Believers embody the calm assurance that everything we are looking to achieve will come to us in the best way, “...*Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,*” says the *LORD of hosts*.” (Zechariah 4:6)

There is no point if we get what we want, but ruin our mind, will, and emotions in the process—no point if we can't give glory to the Lord for giving us the strength, ingenuity, and guidance to see things through. John 15:1-8 says it best, comparing how we live to a vineyard, where the Vine, the branches, and the Vinedresser work together. This relationship between the Father, our Lord Jesus, and us becomes how we live—and through that relationship, we grow strong, we bear the fruit of much success in what we're meant to do, and when needed, we allow Him to prune away what needs to go so that we can surge with new life and produce even more.

When we are living like this, there's no conflict in our heart when it comes to asking for our desires in faith. We know with certainty this principle from Jesus is true for us: “*If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. By this is My*

Father glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.” (John 15:7-8)

Obstacles get out of the way of a believer who is determined and believes—not because they force them out, but because God works it out! Believers know that if we want to be superior in overcoming situations and challenges, we must hold the thought of God's divine superiority in our endeavors. We know that we're not doing it all in our own strength. And that brings a level of peace to our life that the world just doesn't have. Even in unexplainable situations, God's covenant stands sure.

The Sword and the Name Are for God's Children.

Your authority is impossible apart from your association with Christ. He hears you, and the voice of authority is in the DNA of God that lives in you through the work of His creation and your salvation through Jesus Christ—isn't that wonderful? That's why you should speak and live with great authority.

Do me a favor. Listen to yourself speak. Put the Word of God in your mouth and listen to yourself speak it out. That's you and God working together, using the energy of His living, powerful, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing power! Let it build you up. Then, speak it some more! I promise you, you'll sound just like God in the world you created. You'll hear His authority coming out of your own mouth. It'll remind you that you have great

authority. Your future is in your mouth when you are using your faith voice, and it crushes the plans of the enemy in the spirit. It builds your confidence so that you can see when obstacles are from the enemy, and so that you don't accept them as "just part of life."

Some obstacles come to stop the plan of God in your life—to intimidate you, startle you, and push you into panic. When you are living a life where you abide in Him and His Words abide in you, you are a threat to the devil because your power is visible. Don't let that bother you one bit. You don't have anything to fear. In Christ, you are more than a conqueror! So don't let the devil or those who follow him intimidate you. The Word in your mouth is a masterpiece of God's creation—and the power in the truth is undeniable, regardless of what the enemies of God say!

Remember that Satan goes about as a roaring lion... he's not a lion. It's an act of defiance against God Almighty when he roars at God's children. It's not a display of greater power. Now, I know that a lot of people look at this dark world and shrink back—the darkness can get so dark that you think it's got all the power over everything. The reality is that the greater power is in us! The sword of His Spirit is a weapon of spiritual warfare, and it's for His children.

There is no higher power than the Lord! Remember that you have powerful tools Satan can't use. The power of attorney to use the name of Jesus is your right as a child of God—that's what the cross did for you, and it's why when you speak with faith and authority, the enemies of God recognize the power.

Jesus' name is above every name. Satan cannot use the name of Jesus. You must consistently remind yourself of the truth in 1 John 4:4 that says, *"Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world."*

You see, you may look like a little child in your own eyes. You may be up against an old angelic archenemy of God who has eons of time under his belt. But in Christ—because of the power that lives in you by the blood of the Lamb—you, little child, have the greater power.

Remind yourself that *"No weapon formed against you shall prosper..."* like Isaiah 54:17 says! It doesn't say that weapons won't be formed (which means battles in life come), but the Word says they won't prosper. The verse continues, *"... And every tongue which rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, And their righteousness is from Me," says the LORD.*" Glory!

Never forget that without Christ, you'd be at the mercy of this world—but with Christ, you are backed by divine authority. Satan doesn't like the bigness of God in you, but go ahead and be big anyway! Remember, the weapons of your warfare are not carnal. They're not of this world. They are spiritual and of God's world. Remember John 1:1 that, from the beginning, God refused to separate Himself from His Word.

God is One with His Word, and so it doesn't matter if you look small in the eyes of the devil and those who follow him. You're still more powerful than they are. As God's

child, the Greater One is within you. So, you can have what the Word says you can have. You can do what the Word says you can do. Again, the *"accuser of our brethren"* is how Satan is described in Revelation 12:10. So don't be surprised when he comes against you with accusations of what you can't do, even with God. It's bluffing. It's a lie meant to make you cower and drop your sword.

God's truth remains fixed no matter the deception or the accusation against His children. You can do all things through Christ Who strengthens you—because you aren't doing what you're doing alone! The devil knows that. Make sure you do, too.

Countering Satan's Subtlety with Truth and Authority.

It's not all fluffy and easy serving the Lord. Nobody wants to hear about how the devil fights us. But Christianity is divisive to the plans of the enemy, and the persecution for the Word's sake is real. If you're doing something for God, the devil will fight you. I must reiterate that he has no authority over you, but he fights God's people to render the Word powerless. He fights to exert dominance.

You already know that Jesus told us in John 10:10 that the devil's goal is to steal, kill, and destroy. Never is that more evident than his attempts to undermine God's children by using subtlety. The temptations, the dulling distractions, and the offers of exactly what you want—these tactics don't come in blazing; they come with subtle questions and subtle solutions. The devil will even use the Word of God, twisting it to move believers off course.

One way of recognizing that is to notice that when he twists the Word, he often uses the same tactics he used on Jesus. He will come when you're feeling weak. He might try to get you to perform even an act of God in a prideful spirit. He may tempt you to test the Lord by harming yourself in some way, putting a spiritual spin on something that would only hurt you. And, of course, he's famous for making offers that look great, would give you what you want, but with strings attached (of course) that involve some kind of worship of him.

Don't forget that Satan directly quoted the Word to Jesus during the temptation of Christ. That was a demonic attempt to twist God's truth in the hopes that Jesus would fall for it. Jesus didn't fall for the devil's lies, and you don't have to fall for them either. Jesus resisted the devil. How did He do it? He did it by speaking the Word in truth and with authority. In other words, He used His faith voice—and He did not elaborate! God's Word spoken with authority and in truth is enough. Jesus understood this. When you're feeling weak, don't be deep! Let the Word do the battle. Don't get into semantics. Don't let him confuse you with his twisting of the Word.

Jesus could not have resisted the devil with truth and authority if His thoughts weren't in line with God's. The divine thoughts of God are in His Word, and His truth is your inheritance. The truth belongs to you. It's yours. Think

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like it. Talk like it. Act like it. Remember that what you put into your mind will come out of your mouth, and to be *“instant in season and out”* like 2 Timothy 4:2 says, you’ve got to take ownership of the truth.

If the devil tried to exert dominance over Jesus, he’ll do the same to others like you and me. But whether it’s overt or subtle, all you have to do is stand your ground like Jesus did. Decide now that you’ll respond Christ’s way—by voicing the truth with divine authority and resisting every urge to elaborate on what God has already said. That’s what Jesus did, and He’s our example of how to speak with authority in this life. Jesus took ownership of God’s truth and spoke with the authority God gave Him, and you should, too.

The Rest and Contentment of a Responsible Spirit.

As I’ve said before, Psalm 119:105 says, *“Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.”* But verse 106 tells you how to do it: *“I have sworn and confirmed that I will keep Your righteous judgments.”*

You see, as believers, we don’t just have rights and privileges; we also have responsibilities. I like to call it having a “responsible spirit.” For every opportunity, there is a responsibility, and the opportunities are just like the responsibilities: they are blessings you receive as a child of God and not heavy burdens you carry alone. Faith is choosing to believe. It’s not choosing to strive in your own strength. Walking with Jesus at every level, no matter how much you grow, makes doing what God gives you to do much, much easier.

Over the years, ministers have asked me about the stresses of running my ministry. Some are living under so much stress and worry, and they don’t understand why it doesn’t seem like I’ve got any pressure. They think I’ve got some big answer to solve an unsolvable problem, but I tell them I’ve got the same thing they’ve got: I’ve got Jesus and the Word of God. I have faith that what God said He will do. That’s it. I learned long ago that this is His ministry. The vision is His vision. I’m creating my world with faith in what He said—and He is the

One Who called me to *“Go ye into all the world, and preach the Gospel to every creature.”* (Mark 16:15) All I have to do is obey. All I have to do is have faith. All I have to do is take the opportunities and be a “responsible spirit.” It’s called trust and work! I tell them what I’ll tell you: “It’s all very simple if you don’t complicate it!”

In Matthew 11:30, Jesus told us, *“For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”* It’s a description of what living for Him is like. It’s also a warning that if what He gave us to do feels too hard and too heavy, we need to make sure it’s from Him—and if so, have faith and turn to Him because we’re not meant to go at it alone. He says, *“Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.”* (Matthew 11:28)

Resting in the responsibility—that’s what a responsible spirit does. That doesn’t mean laying down on the job! It means not taking the stress when you can have faith in what God said instead. I don’t want to struggle, so if I feel that coming on, it’s time to pray and get it down to simple faith. I can think about the hows and whys, but I’m not going to overthink when God’s Word is so plain.

Don’t Take Your Focus for Granted: Live in Devotion.

You see, I’m devoted to Him, and it’s through that spirit of devotion that I find contentment. “Lord, what would you have me to do?” is a question I ask every day. It’s just part of my routine to always talk to the Lord. It’s what meditating on the Word is all about. Do you remember the Joshua method chapter? I don’t just write this stuff; I do it!

Keeping the Word first place isn’t running on autopilot. When you’re working on something and creating your world with faith, you must have a heightened sense of awareness of what you want and the Word you’re meditating upon for it. If you’re creating, you’re in transition. Habits form faster in times of transition. So, think of it like this: you are not where you are now—by faith you are already where you want to be. You’re in the “now” right now, so to speak.

Your focus can’t be taken for granted. When you’re creating your world, you should try to remove all the other distractions you can. You’re not dividing attention this way and that—in the Joshua way, that’s called not turning to the right or to the left. You still go about your day. You do whatever you have to do. But as you’re going, you speak the Word to yourself.

You start your day and end your day with the same focus that you keep during the day. That’s moving between your faith voice and whatever you have to do, back and forth. It’s a different way of thinking, and it’s not hard. You don’t get into any stress over it. You’re saying and you’re believing something God said and something He told you all at the same time, and that’s exciting because you know it’s coming. Faith in God is fun. The physicality part of moving while meditating on what God said engages your mind and body at the same time, which is good!

You’re not supposed to keep your faith in a closet—that

may be where you pray, but you should be using your faith voice outside of that closet! That's what abiding in Him and letting His Words abide in you means. It's practical, simple, and engaging for your spirit, mind, and body, and it works. It's living in devotion to the Lord that helps keep you on track, and that means every day and not just on Sunday.

The cultivation of a devoted life to God is the integration of your spirit with your mind as you walk through this world, and that happens in the day to day. In the same way, children can't really grow or thrive if they're only fed once a week, you can't grow as a child of God without regular nourishment. I don't know about you, but I like eating! Spiritually and physically, I don't want to starve, do you? Hahahaha!

God's Way Is the "Be Ye Holy for I Am Holy" Way.

I am responsible for what I do for God, and I see that as being in complete alignment with God Himself. That means having pure motives and godly values. That means living with no secret sin. That means endeavoring to have a heart that is filled with nothing but holiness. God sees the motives of the heart. He sees the values I live out day by day, and He sees the values you live out each day, too. It's good to keep your heart in the right place, and that's a daily practice. It's being the kind of person who prays Psalm 19:14 and means it: *"Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O LORD, my strength and my Redeemer."*

Some people think being holy is impossible, but it's not. Just like the power of God lives in us through the work of salvation, we must walk in our authority. The holiness of Christ lives in us too, and we must walk it out in faith. God said, *"Be holy; for I am holy"* and He wouldn't have told us to be that way if it was impossible for us to do it (Leviticus 11:44; 1 Peter 1:16). We can do ALL things through Christ Who gives us strength. Remember, it's not willpower; it's Christ in us, the hope of glory.

Let me tell you something. Holiness is not what people think it is. They think it's only about what you do, but to God, holiness is being like Him! Holy means set apart and distinct, and when the angels fly over God's throne and cry, *"Holy, Holy, Holy,"* they're describing Him as different than anyone else. So, when God asks you to be holy because He is holy, you could say that He's asking you to identify with Him as your Father—and He's saying, "Set yourself apart to Me because you're My child and I made you, and you are different from the world."

It's through your relationship with Him that you start to take on His characteristics that will change you, and that will give you a greater desire to change the way you live. That's how holiness comes. But you won't do that on your own either! Although it's wonderful to make a choice to live right before God, it's not about knuckling under and just trying to be perfect in following a set of rules all on your own. Holiness comes out of the relationship you daily create with God, because He'll change the way you see yourself. He'll affect how you see a lot of things!

God's Promises Don't Stop When the Clock Speeds Up!

You know, we are living at what I feel is the end of this age. Some say we're in the end times and believe that what we are seeing in the world today are clear signs that Jesus is coming soon. I believe this, and while I know that believers since the resurrection have longed to see Him, I believe that no matter God's timing, we should aim to live like He could come today.

Jesus told us, *"But as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of Man be."* (Matthew 24:37) From the fall of man to the flood, man became more corrupt and depraved. Left to their own devices and the dictates of their own conscience, mankind sunk low. Angels did, too. Without the boundaries of a holy God at work in the heart, people stray. With angelic intervention in the lives of people, monstrous beings come into play, too. But we see that in the days of Noah, the corruption of mankind hit an all-time low because hardly anybody loved and was following the Lord.

A deliberate mixing with those in opposition to God, man gave himself even further to the opposition of God and all that's good. They were corrupt in their soul through sin and corrupt in their body through the intermingling with the fallen, and this created a time marked by giant beings and great violence. Man slid so far into corruption that God tells us in Genesis 6:5 that the wickedness of man was so great that *"every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually."*

Today, we might have different customs and different clothes, but the heart of man isn't any different—we need God because without Him, we slip deeper into sin and all the destructive ways of living that come with it. Without God, man is easily deceived. Without God, the heart gets more depraved and lawless. The "freedom" the godless live by becomes the depravity, violence, and corruption society doesn't need. First Timothy 4:1-2 tells us that in the latter times, people will leave the faith and start following seducing

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spirits and practicing the doctrines of the devil; and they'll be deceived by hypocritical men with no conscience at all.

The world we're living in today needs Jesus. That's why I am still preaching and sharing the Word of the Lord! Matthew 24:14 lets us know that the end won't come until all nations hear the Gospel. *"And this Gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come."*

Notice that verse doesn't say they have to receive it—but we must witness to the nations so that they hear and have an opportunity to receive. So, that's what I'm doing! I believe that if you know Jesus, then you are, too. It's important that we give everyone an opportunity to find Jesus. The Gospel must be preached. Jesus' return depends on it.

To live in this dark world today and stay away from the corruption, we must stay close to the Lord. The Light of the world is Jesus, and He needs to be shining in and through us. The love of God that we have brings peace and joy, and blessings too. Spiritually, physically, and financially, we can build a wonderful and blessed life right in the middle of this corrupt world.

While God's enemies try so desperately to attain counterfeit power and prosperity, we can live pure lives for God, and we can follow His ways instead of the world's ways and create our world with joy and faith in His Word. We can spread the Gospel and let our light so shine! Because the promises of God don't stop working when the clock speeds up!

There's only one cure for the soul, and His name is Jesus Christ. *"I am the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty."* (Revelation 1:8) Jesus was there at the beginning, and He will be there at the end...and who knows when that day will be? We may see Him a whole lot sooner than anybody thinks!

Be Ready, and Let's Get Others Ready, Too!

Be ready. He's coming back for a Church that is *"a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish."* (Ephesians 5:27) Now you know why I had to talk about holiness earlier! Remember, it's separation unto God—it's righteousness through Jesus Christ. We don't have to be perfect, but there's only one Way to be clean before God, with no spot, no wrinkle, no blemish, or any such thing. It's by accepting God's Son, Jesus, for His work on the cross. He's the only One Who can wash sin away and make a person clean as snow (Isaiah 1:18), and when we accept Him, we are clean in the eyes of God—righteous and ready for the day when Jesus comes back for us.

God has led me to start talking about my Heaven experience more lately, and I believe this is for a reason. I really believe He's coming back, and sooner than we think! If He doesn't come get me, I'll go up to meet Him...but I really want to see Him come back. I really just want to take the ride! Don't you? Be ready.

Until then, push the Light. Invite others to the table. Separate yourself from darkness and don't play around with what isn't any good at all. Live for Christ. Share God's truth. Tell everyone you know! Remember that no matter how hard or messed up someone looks, God can touch their heart. He is so merciful and patient with people, and He will meet them right where they are. Second Peter 3:9 says, *"The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance."*

Jesus wants everyone, and it's up to believers like you and me to give them a chance to know that. That's why I'm in the ministry—it's why I encourage believers to share their faith, too. Romans 10:14-15 says, *"How then shall they call on Him in Whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: 'How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the Gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!'"*

Don't look at this world as hopeless. Look at them like Jesus did—like lost sheep in need of a Shepherd. I was once like that, and Jesus found me. He's found millions all over the world, too. So many of us are testimonies of Jesus' ability to completely turn a life around. So, let's do what Jesus said as we see this world shifting and changing, just groaning under the weight of sin, and *"Occupy till I come,"* as Luke 19:13 says. Spiritually, physically, and financially, let's aim for God's best right here on Earth, and use our faith voice for whatever He puts on our heart.

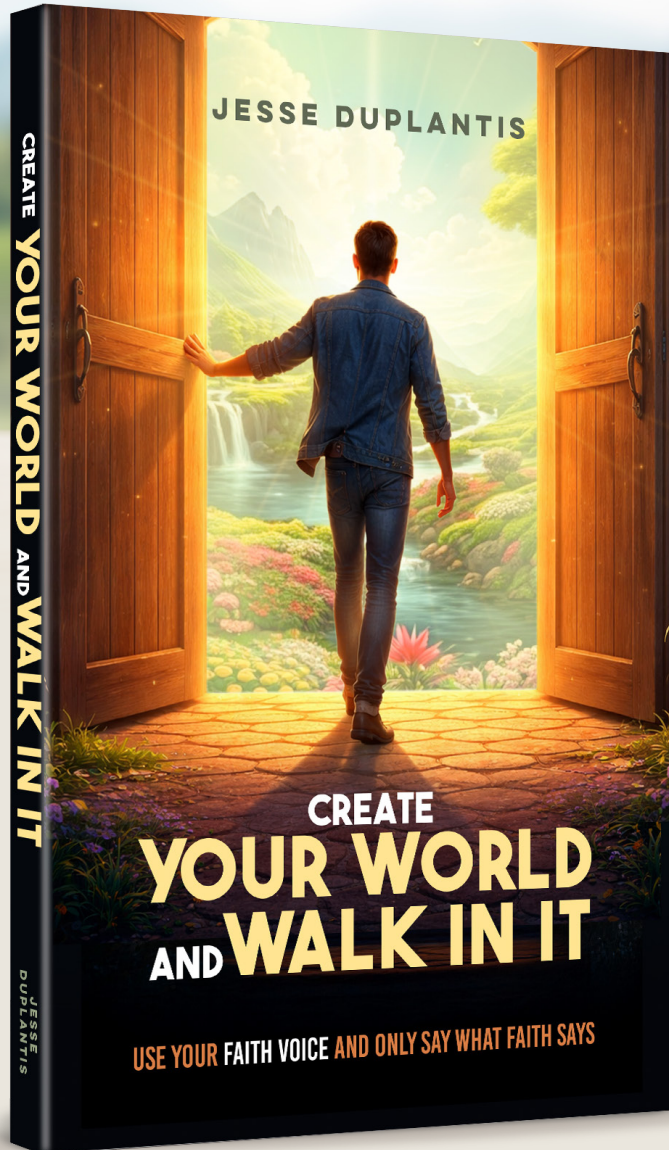
May His will be done *"in earth, as it is in Heaven."* (Matthew 6:10) May we be as wise as serpents (not ignorant of the devil's devices) but just as harmless doves (Matthew 10:16), because we can. We can do all things through Christ Who gives us strength! (Philippians 4:13) All things are possible for us! We're connected to our Father through Jesus, and His Spirit will be with us through thick and thin. He will guide us in all truth, just like John 16:13 says, and will show us things to come. Most of all, He'll encourage you to stretch and believe, to grow in Him and become all He created you to be. Because you're His child and He loves you, and He's a good Father Who wants only the best for you.

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GLORIOUS MOMENTS *with Cathy*

Every time I hear about the powerful impact of God's Word on His people, it always fills me with joy and thanks to the Father. May you be filled with joy, always thanking the Father. He has enabled you to share in the inheritance that belongs to His people, who live in the light"* (Colossians 1:11-12 NLT).

I love that promise! It is a model prayer that you can pray for yourself and for your loved ones that need to be strengthened with all His glorious power. It's part of your inheritance, and it belongs to you. Through Christ, you are blessed with all spiritual blessings, and you are joint heirs with Him (Ephesians 1:3; Romans 8:17). Get ready to be filled with joy and strengthened with all God's glorious power as you read the wonderful testimonies sent to us from real people, just like you and me!

Congratulations on 50 years in ministry!!! I am so grateful to be a Partner with your ministry. Your teachings have blessed me and my family immensely. Since I learned how to give God's way from your book *"Why Isn't My Giving Working?"* the blessings of God have been pouring into our lives. A few months ago, I asked your ministry for a prayer of agreement for a full-time position at the university where I teach. I had applied for a full-time teaching position, but was not given an opportunity to interview. Instead, they asked me to volunteer my time to help with a special assignment. My flesh was disappointed with their choice, and I wanted to say no, but the Holy Spirit told me to say yes. I decided to work as if I were getting paid and maintain a great attitude. One day while I was helping, a faculty member asked if I knew about a certain topic. I said yes, and explained that I had great professional and academic expertise in it. A week later, I heard from the Vice President of Academics, who wanted to meet with me to discuss it. I prayed and prepared for the meeting, and during that meeting, she offered me a full-time position with full benefits starting immediately—a position that I didn't even apply for! Praise the Lord! This new role allows me to make a university-wide impact. It pays three times more than my previous role, and on top of that, I am still able to teach courses at the university. What an amazing God we serve! The most exciting thing about this new position is that I now have more seed to sow each month. Woohoo! I deeply appreciate your monthly Partner letters and online teachings. The Glorious Conference was amazing, and I am excited for the Visionary Conference. Thank you so much for being so faithful and preaching the Gospel all over the world to bring in this end-time harvest. For every seed I sow into your ministry, I believe for two things: a 100-fold return in people saved and a 100-fold return financially. I fully believe it is coming to pass on every dollar I sow. I pray you will receive a deep revelation of how deeply you both are loved and appreciated.

Thank you for your ministry! I was standing in faith to double my salary. I applied for and got a new position in my company, and with new reimbursements and an increase in base salary, I now make double what I earned before! Praise God!

Brother Jesse recently released a powerful prophetic word: “This is going to be a blessing week.” He emphasized that this blessing would be spiritual, physical, and financial, and could even extend to a blessing year or a whole blessing life. The next day, the word manifested in my life. I received \$100, which was the exact, much-needed amount I needed for a COD package coming from Greece, plus enough for gas. Glory to God!

I wanted to take a moment to share a testimony of what God has done through your ministry. As I was preparing to write to you, the Lord reminded me of another miracle He performed years ago at one of your meetings. You came to Lorain, Ohio—I don’t remember the exact year, but it was at least 15 years ago. During that meeting, I laughed until my side hurt! However, when the offering came around, I had a bit of an attitude. I gave what I think was just two dollars and said, “Here, God. Show me what You can do” (meaning financially). Well, God certainly showed me! About a week later, I was at work when Human Resources called me down. The HR representative said, “There are people here looking to give you money.” Five or six years prior, I had paid \$430 to cover these people’s rent. They had suddenly come into some money and wanted to pay me back. God put \$430 into my hands in exchange for that two-dollar seed. To this day, I know that would not have happened if I hadn’t given that offering. What I loved most, though, was that God loved me right past my bad attitude. My more recent testimony is about a physical healing. I am 64 years young. A few weeks ago, out of nowhere, my joints started clicking and hurting. My shoulder hurt so badly that I felt the enemy was trying to cripple me. I prayed, and I felt God telling me to sow a \$3,000 seed into your ministry. I had total peace about it, so I sent it. After sowing that seed, my symptoms began to fade. Whenever I felt a symptom trying to return, I reminded myself that God remembers my seed to Jesse Duplantis Ministries. That act of giving gave me great faith. Four months have passed since then, and I am now completely pain free! I want to declare that I am healed. God told me not to speak about the pain and to work with the seed. Today, I can walk, move, and work with absolutely no pain!

A few years ago, I watched Jesse Duplantis’ Boardroom Chat “The Financial Plan of God, Part One.” Brother Jesse mentioned that the Lord was quickening him to have people sow a seed in faith and talked about the hundredfold harvest. So, I donated \$50, which was not a particularly sacrificial or trivial amount for me. Even though I usually don’t respond to such things, because you’re not supposed to give “grudgingly or of necessity” (2 Corinthians 9:7). However, if there’s any preacher I’ll believe when they say God told them to ask, it’s Jesse Duplantis. So I did, and I actually went to bed mad at myself for doing it because of my personal rule against it. I eventually calmed myself down, knowing Brother Jesse is only trying to help people. That night, I had a dream that I was riding in a car with the mayor of my city and his wife, who were going to the airport to fly to Washington, D.C. In the dream, I checked my bank app on my phone and saw a surprise \$1,500 in my account alongside a picture of a white Corvette. I took this to mean that I would one day go to Washington, D.C. on a trip and have enough money to rent a white Corvette when I did, as a result of the seed I had sown. Fast forward a couple of months: a brand-new Camaro I had ordered from Chevy was cancelled due to supply chain issues, and I had to look for something else. While searching online, I found a white Corvette for sale for significantly less than what my Camaro was going to cost. This made me recall my dream, and I wondered if it possibly could have meant to buy *this* one now. I checked my bank account to start crunching some numbers, and lo and behold, I had an unexpected \$1,500 in there from something that I thought would still be sometime in the future! I knew then that this was it. That money, plus the down payment that had been intended for my Camaro, gave me enough to make the purchase. A Corvette has always been my dream car, and while I’ve had a feeling I would get one someday, this happened way earlier than I thought it would. Glory be to God! And fun fact, the day I went to pick up my car, the mayor and his wife (from my dream) were actually at the airport to fly to... Washington D.C.!

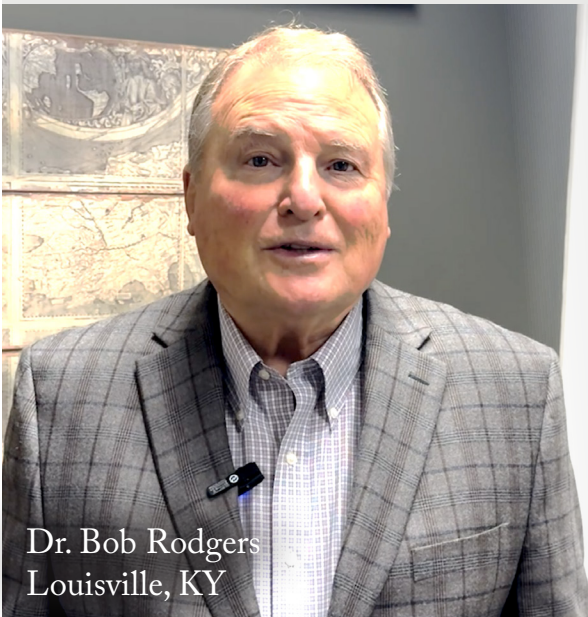

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STAY FOCUSED, STAY IN CHRIST, AND USE YOUR FAITH VOICE

**Below is an excerpt from Jesse Duplantis' September letter to JDM Covenant Partners. Partners are those who support the ministry's vision of world evangelism with donations and/or product orders, and they receive a letter each month from Brother Jesse sharing what God has put on his heart. We hope you enjoy reading a portion of this month's letter and will consider becoming a Partner in JDM's vision of world evangelism.*

Dear Partner,

The original faith voice belongs to God. Romans 4:17 tells us God speaks life and He speaks the end result when it says, "...even God, Who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were." Abraham followed God's example when he called those things which were not as though they were in dealing with the promise God gave him of a miracle son—his faith was in believing and saying what God said before He saw what God said would happen. Partner, we must do the same. Glory! Whatever promise we are standing on, we must use our faith voice, and we have to stand true to it even when the temptation to give up comes.

Temptation—Stay Focused and Use Your Faith Voice

In each Partner letter this year, I've been using examples in the Bible where people used their faith voice, and this month I want to do the same. Go with me to Genesis 39 and let's look at when Joseph used his faith voice to battle temptation—a tactic of the enemy to steal, kill, and destroy his life. You may know the story. Joseph was taken to Egypt by the Ishmaelites and found himself under an Egyptian master named Potiphar, who noticed that God's hand was on him. How did Potiphar come to that conclusion? He recognized God's blessing on Joseph when he saw that no matter what Joseph did, he seemed to succeed and prosper. That's all the world can do—they just go by what they see. Joseph was a man who was moved by his inner faith in God. Joseph went by what he believed, and that's why he was successful in the first place.

Genesis 39:1-4 tells us that the Lord was with Joseph, and this made him a successful man who prospered at whatever he was given to do. Because of that, Potiphar promoted him to the position of overseer over all his house and lands. In verse five, it tells us that the Lord blessed Potiphar's whole household "for Joseph's sake." I want you to notice that those around you can be blessed simply by your association as a faith-filled believer. But I also want you to notice that the devil isn't pleased when you succeed God's way, and he will influence others to try and steer you away from what God has for you.

Potiphar's wife also noticed Joseph. Genesis 39:6-9 tells us that she noticed that Joseph was handsome and began casting "longing eyes" at him. And before he knew it, that woman started trying to make Joseph an offer he couldn't refuse—but she didn't know what kind of man Joseph really was. Potiphar's wife tried to tempt Joseph to have sex with her. Notice how he responds to her

in verse nine: "There is no one greater in this house than I, nor has he kept back anything from me but you, because you are his wife. How then can I do this great wickedness, and sin against God?" What was Joseph doing in that moment? He was leaning on his faith in God—and using his voice to tell that woman "no."

Joseph spoke clearly and let Potiphar's wife know 1.) his position of authority, 2.) that it was given to him by her husband, excluding her, and 3.) to sleep with her would be a great sin against God because that is Who he is subject to above it all. Partner, no matter how strong the temptation might be, I want you to notice that when your heart is concentrated on what God wants, your faith will stop wickedness in its tracks.

The point is this: **To say what faith says must not be a theory, but a practice founded on a personal relationship with the Lord—this is what makes character strong, obedience to God the only good choice, and blessings not only come but stay.** Partner, many people lose their life over bad decisions that they could have easily avoided. They lose focus. They get their eyes off the reality that God is always with them, always watching, and the devil is a thief who comes with temptation to move God's people off course.

Be Holy—Staying Holy Is Possible Because God Said It's Doable

I wish some preachers of this day would use faith against sin like Joseph did, don't you? I can tell you this. In my life and this ministry, there is no secret sin—Cathy and I live a life of holiness, and do you know how we do it? We do it by caring more about what God wants than what we want and what other people want. It's not hard to live holy. God said, "*Be ye holy; for I am holy,*" which means we are capable of being holy, and His command is good enough for me!

To live well, blessed, and holy, your life must be lived *in Christ*. It doesn't matter how much you know *about* Christ. Do you know Christ personally, and are you keeping it personal? Partner, your focus on being in daily relationship with the Lord will affect your daily decisions. Now, we know that Joseph lived in Old Testament times, but his faith voice had the same power as if he was living in the New Testament. If he could say no to the devil's attempt to steal, kill, and destroy his life through wronging his boss and wronging God, then, can't we? We definitely can!

Partner, your faith voice has more power in it because you have the power of attorney to use the name of Jesus. Joseph didn't have that, yet he defeated the devil anyway. You see, spiritual forces make you competent to deal with spiritual and physical issues. So, don't neglect your own spirituality, because you are responsible for it. Your character depends upon it, and out of your good character you'll make good decisions.

In John 8:1-11 when Jesus encounters a woman about to be stoned to death for sin, He didn't just tell the others not to judge her—Jesus gave her mercy, but then commanded her to go sin no more. When Jesus said that, He meant it! That was Jesus' faith

voice talking, and it was giving the woman instruction on how to live a good life. Partner, to understand the Kingdom of God, you must be *in* the Kingdom of God, not on the outskirts! The point is this: **We must put God's Word in our heart, and we must always be intently listening to the divine voice within us, too. This is how we will be able to faithfully perform God's divine will in life.**

Always keep strict watch over yourself. Recognize that the devil goes about as a roaring lion looking for who he can devour—don't let him even get a nibble! Always be on guard and do not neglect the gift of your faith voice. Call those things that be not as though they were. Speak the Word to yourself so that when temptation comes, the Word will come up to give you wisdom. Stay inside the Kingdom by keeping up with your spirituality, because who you are is created by Who you love, Who you serve, and Who you believe—so stay true to God. Your relationship with God and study of the Word will give you the power to read human nature and the boldness to not be steered away from who you are in Christ. Use your faith voice every day. I promise you, you will be pleasing to God. Glory!

SEPTEMBER CONFESSIONS OF FAITH

- I choose to follow after God and call those things that be not as though they were.
- I speak life, I speak the end result, and I stay true to what I believe no matter what!
- I don't just know *about* Christ, I *know* Christ—I live my life in relationship with Jesus.
- The devil goes about looking for who he can devour—he will not get a nibble off of me!
- I know my authority is in Christ, my blessings are from God, and I will not sin against God.
- Temptation may come, but I'm staying focused and using my faith voice to stay true.
- God said to be holy because He is holy, and that means I can live pure every day.
- I put the Word in my heart and listen intently to His Voice within me—God's will is my will.
- I know Who I love, Who I serve, and Who I believe—I keep my mind and eyes on the Lord!

We all know people that fly through life by the seat of their pants, never giving a single thought about eternity. They spend more time preparing for a day at the beach than they do planning for their eternal destination.

I used to be that way. It was not unusual for me to lay awake for hours thinking about how to rearrange the living room furniture or what sewing project I wanted to start next. Jesse used to get aggravated at me for keeping him awake at night describing the details of a dress pattern I'd found that day. I would just rattle on and on about the design of the collar, or type of fabric that would accentuate the cut of the sleeve, before I noticed that he had fallen asleep from boredom.

Back then, I would get caught up with what I considered important, overlooking the one thing that was necessary. I was like Martha in Luke chapter ten:

*Now as they were traveling along,
He entered a certain village; and a
woman named Martha welcomed Him
into her home.*

*And she had a sister called Mary,
who moreover was listening to the
Lord's Word, seated at His feet.*

*But Martha was distracted with
all her preparations; and she came up
to Him, and said, Lord, do You not care
that my sister has left me to do all the
serving alone? Then tell her to help me.*

*But the Lord answered and said
to her, Martha, Martha, you are so
worried and bothered about so many
things;*

*But only a few things are necessary,
really only one, for Mary has chosen
the good part, which shall not be taken
away from her.*

Luke 10:38-42 NASB1995

Martha wanted everything to be perfect for

Jesus, but she forgot one very important thing: the condition of her heart. She was resentful of Mary and wanted everyone, including Jesus, to know it. Mary, on the other hand, was so hungry for Jesus' Words; she couldn't care less about what was on the stove. She had discovered the only thing that was necessary: sitting at Jesus' feet.

Don't live like Martha. Don't get caught up in what seems to be the need of the moment and never take time to hear the Words of Jesus. He has clear directions to help you find abundant life on earth and eternal life in Heaven. Take the time to hear about the awesome destination that Jesus has prepared for you and everyone that believes in Him!

TICKETS PLEASE!

You wouldn't think of getting on a plane to Paris, France without a ticket. It's laughable to think that anyone would try that one. But, each day, we see people that think that they are going to Heaven after they die, even though they have never made the proper arrangements.

In the third chapter of John's Gospel, we are told about a conversation between Jesus and a well-known Pharisee that was a member of the Sanhedrin named Nicodemus. John 3:2 (AMPC) tells us what he said: *"Who came to Jesus at night and said to Him, Rabbi, we know and are certain that You have come from God [as] a Teacher; for no one can do these signs (these wonderworks, these miracles—and produce the proofs) that You do unless God is with him."*

This statement seems impressive at first, because most of the religious leaders rejected Jesus and resented His popularity with the people. Nicodemus was different. He recognized that Jesus' miracles were proof that He came from God. However, Jesus wanted this very religious man to understand that knowing about God is not enough—he needed to know God personally by being born again.

John 3:3 (AMPC) tells us: *"Jesus answered him,*

*I assure you, most solemnly I tell you, that unless a person is born again (anew, from above), he cannot ever see (know, be acquainted with, and experience) the kingdom of God. This word “born again” is a translation of the Greek word *gennethe* and it means “be begotten from above.” It literally means there must be a transformation from God and a renewal in righteousness and true holiness to be saved.*

Jesus came to sacrifice His life, to give every person the opportunity to be born again and receive eternal life in Heaven by believing in Him. In John 3:16 (AMPC), Jesus told Nicodemus: “*For God so greatly loved and dearly prized the world that He [even] gave up His only begotten (unique) Son, so that whoever believes in (trusts in, clings to, relies on) Him shall not perish (come to destruction, be lost) but have eternal (everlasting) life.*”

The only way to know God and secure your eternal destination is to be born again. The price of the ticket to Heaven is much too exorbitant for any of us to pay on our own. It could only be purchased with the precious blood of Jesus shed on the cross of Calvary, and it is free to all that call upon His name.

ALL ABOARD!

I made my reservation for my heavenly home the moment that I asked Jesus to come into my life and forgive my sins. He handed me that precious ticket and told me to stay ready. In Mark chapter thirteen, Jesus taught us how to be ready for the moment that we would board the heavenly train for glory.

But of that day or that hour not a [single] person knows, not even the angels in Heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

Be on your guard [constantly alert], and watch and pray; for you do not know when the time will come.

It is like a man [already] going on a journey; when he leaves home, he puts his servants in charge, each with his particular task, and he gives orders to the doorkeeper to be constantly alert and on the watch.

Therefore watch (give strict attention, be cautious and alert), for you do not know when the Master of the house is coming—in the evening, or at midnight, or at cockcrow, or in the morning—

[Watch, I say] lest He come suddenly and unexpectedly and find you asleep.

And what I say to you I say to everybody: Watch (give strict attention, be cautious, active, and alert)!

Mark 13:32-37 AMPC

It’s our responsibility to be ready for Jesus when He comes. In the 260 chapters in the New Testament, over 300 references to the coming of Jesus reveal that His appearance shall be:

Certain: *“And when (if) I go and make ready a place for you, I will come back*

again and will take you to Myself, that where I am you may be also.” (John 14:3).

Personal: “For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a loud cry of summons, with the shout of an archangel, and with the blast of the trumpet of God...” (1 Thessalonians 4:16)

Sudden: “[Watch, I say] lest He come suddenly and unexpectedly and find you asleep.” (Mark 13:36).

Visible: “...Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing into heaven? This same Jesus, Who was caught away and lifted up from among you into heaven, will return in [just] the same way in which you saw Him go into heaven.” (Acts 1:11).

Nothing this world has to offer will keep me from making that long-awaited trip to Heaven my eternal destination. I’ve got my bags packed, and I’m ready for that trumpet sound!

For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a loud cry of summons, with the shout of an archangel, and with the blast of the trumpet of God. And those who have departed this life in Christ will rise first. Then we, the living ones who

remain [on earth], shall simultaneously be caught up along with [the resurrected dead] in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air; and so always (through the eternity of the eternities) we shall be with the Lord!

Therefore comfort and encourage one another with these words.

1 Thessalonians 4:16-18 AMPC

John 14:1-2 AMPC

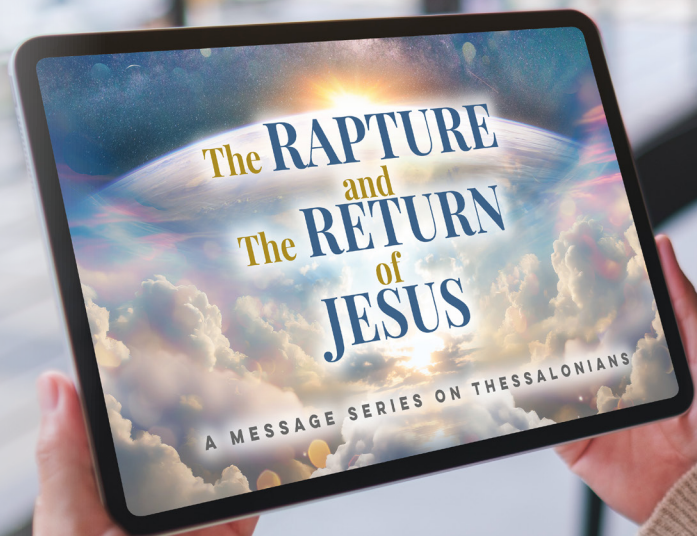

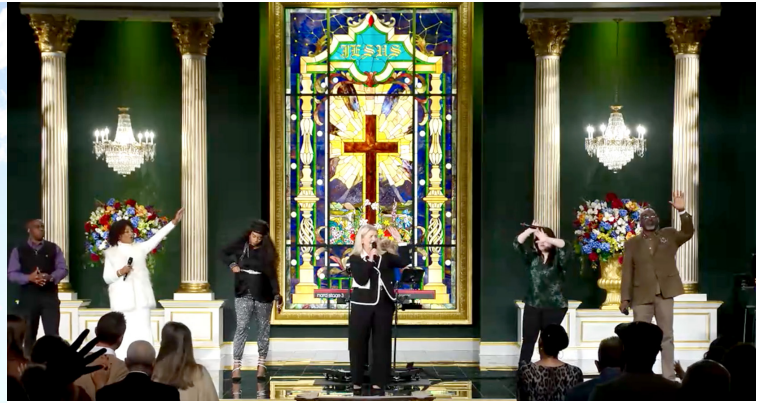
